## Introduction

We present this book before you, as a record of various crimes perpetrated by the Israeli occupation forces in the Gaza Strip, the West Bank, and occupied Al-Quds, covering the period from the start of Israeli aggression on 7 October 2023 to 17 March 2025.

This book serves as one of the media tools developed by the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) Media Observatory on Israeli Crimes against Palestinians. It was created in accordance with Article 10 of the Final Communiqué issued by the Joint Arab-Islamic Summit held in Riyadh, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, on 11 November 2023, which called for the establishment of a media monitoring unit to document all crimes committed by the occupation authorities against the Palestinian people and to use digital platforms in exposing these illegitimate and inhumane practices.

This publication complements the OIC Media Observatory on Israeli Crimes' website, which promotes multimedia content and operates alongside a dedicated Observatory's mobile application, and the OIC's official platforms, including its website, and social media platforms on X (formerly Twitter), Facebook, Instagram, YouTube, and WhatsApp.

Included in this book are the weekly reports issued during the referenced period, each documenting crimes committed in the Gaza Strip, the West Bank, and occupied Al-Quds.

The OIC Media Observatory has played a vital role in exposing these crimes to a global audience. Its content has reached hundreds of millions of people across the globe, in Arabic, English, and French. This book also represents a year and a half of rigorous effort to monitor and document Israeli crimes against the Palestinian people, acts that form part of an ongoing unparalleled and unprecedented atrocity in modern history against a defenseless people subjected to the occupation army's starvation, murder, bombardment, siege, and forced displacement tactics.

The book irrefutably proves and documents the crimes of genocide, ethnic cleansing, forced migration, and all crimes and violations of international humanitarian law, through which the occupation forces have specifically targeted women, children, the elderly, medical staff, hospitals, civilian homes, journalists, essential services, and the entire education sector in the Gaza Strip.

At the time of publication, the occupation forces relentlessly and unabatedly continue to commit their crimes against the Palestinian people in the Gaza Strip, imposing siege, starvation, and daily massacres on its population, facts to which this book bears witness.

The book covers the systematic crimes committed by the Israeli occupation across all Palestinian territories. It documents the various crimes and violations in the cities, towns, and villages of the West Bank and the occupied Al-Quds. It also highlights the major crimes against the holy Al-Aqsa Mosque, including the daily incursions and the desecration of its courtyards, squares and sanctities.

## October 7, 2023 – January 22, 2024: One Hundred Days of the Most Barbaric Assault

The initial quarter following the onset of Israeli military operations against the Gaza Strip, the West Bank, and Al-Quds represents the most critical phase discussed in this volume. Data indicate that from October 7, 2023, to January 2024, Israeli military actions resulted in the deaths of 23,843 Palestinians in the Gaza Strip, which included more than 7,000 women and over 10,300 children. Additionally, approximately 60,317 Palestinians sustained injuries, with around 8,000 individuals reportedly trapped under debris.

During this aggressive period, the toll included over 112 journalists, 373 health professionals, 148 United Nations staff members, 4,257 students, and 227 educators and administrators who lost their lives.

According to the Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics, approximately 290,000 housing units in the Gaza Strip sustained damage because of the Israeli land, air, and maritime bombardment within the first three months of this barbaric attack.

The bombing resulted in the rendering of approximately 65,000 housing units uninhabitable and led to the complete destruction of around 25,010 structures. In addition, 145 mosques and three churches were demolished. The healthcare infrastructure suffered significantly, with 30 hospitals rendered inoperable and an additional 26 sustaining various levels of damage. Furthermore, the attack resulted in the destruction of 121 ambulances, thus incapacitating them for emergency response.

The Israeli occupation's airstrikes resulted in the destruction of 95 educational institutions, encompassing both school and university buildings. Additionally, 295 institutions sustained varying degrees of partial damage. Notably, 130 facilities under the management of the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA), which include educational establishments, were directly targeted by the Israeli military bombardment.

As reported by the Palestinian Ministry of Public Works, the Israeli aggression has resulted in the destruction of over 250,000 housing units to varying extents. Approximately 35% of urban territories have sustained significant damage, with more than 40% of critical infrastructure rendered completely inoperable. This destruction encompasses essential systems, including transportation networks, water and sewage infrastructure, electrical distribution lines, and communication systems.

The ongoing Israeli aggression has led to the displacement of approximately 1.93 million Palestinians, constituting 85% of Gaza's overall population. This displacement often involves multiple relocations as individuals seek safety. Currently, around 1.4 million internally displaced people (IDPs) are documented within 155 UNRWA facilities. The Rafah Governorate has emerged as the primary refuge for these IDPs, accommodating over one million individuals in a highly congested urban landscape.

According to UNRWA, the IDPs sheltered in its 156 facilities across the Gaza Strip have reached an estimated 914,000. This population includes approximately 5,000 pregnant women and over 2,000 individuals with disabilities, as well as a significant number of children, infants, and those suffering from chronic or serious health conditions.

Notably, October 2023 saw the highest incidence of arrests, with a recorded total of 2,070, coinciding with the escalation of Israeli aggression and humanitarian crises in Gaza.

The OIC Media Observatory for Israeli Crimes against Palestinians conducted an extensive documentation of violations in the West Bank, Al-Quds, and the Gaza Strip during the period from October 7, 2023, to January 22, 2024. The report indicates that a total of 25,696 individuals were recorded as martyrs across the Palestinian territories, alongside 65,028 documented injuries sustained by civilians and combatants alike. This data highlights the significant impact of ongoing hostilities in the region.

In the West Bank and Al-Quds, there were a total of 5,933 arrests, coupled with 716 incidents of settler violence. Additionally, the data indicates 48 instances of settlement expansion activities, the issuance of 15 decisions regarding land confiscation by Israeli authorities, and 283 reported confiscations along with incidents of arson and destruction of Palestinian property. This includes 173 demolitions of residential structures, 191 assaults on agricultural land, and the dismantling of 24 commercial entities.

The Observatory further recorded 92 attacks on the Al-Aqsa Mosque, 34 on the Ibrahimi Mosque in Hebron, and 12 assaults on mosques across various towns and villages in the West Bank.

On January 11, 2024, a historic legal milestone occurred as Israel, the occupying power, made its inaugural appearance before the International Court of Justice in The Hague. This session arose from a lawsuit initiated by South Africa, which alleges that Israel is guilty of perpetrating acts of "genocide" against the Palestinian population in the Gaza Strip.



## 1,348 Murdered, 204 detainees, and 4,217 total Israeli violations against Palestinians in a Week

Based on Article No. (10) of the final Communiqué adopted by the Joint Arab Islamic Summit, held in Riyadh, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, November 11, 2023, which stipulates the establishment of a media monitoring unit to document all crimes of the occupation authorities against the Palestinian people, alongside digital media platforms to publish and expose their illegitimate and inhuman practices, the General Secretariat of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) issues the first weekly bulletin on the crimes and massacres committed by Israel, the occupying authority, against the Palestinian people in the Gaza Strip, the cities of the West Bank, and the Holy City of Al-Quds.

**OCHA: Israel has placed 87% of Gaza as part of 66 forcible relocation orders, covering 150 neighbourhoods and 80% of Gaza remains under such orders.**

The number of martyrs during the period between January 23 and 29, 2024 was (1,348) martyrs, all of whom were killed in the Gaza Strip as a result of aerial and artillery bombardment against the cities of Gaza, Rafah, and Khan Yunis, with the exception of six martyrs who were killed in West Bank cities, while the number of wounded in the Gaza Strip and some West Bank cities reached to (2413).

In addition, the Blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque was subjected to daily incursions by extremists, and Israel, the occupying power, imposed restrictions on worshipers last Friday, January 26, 2024. The occupation forces continued the wave of arrests over the past week, reaching (204) arrests, primarily in the cities of Al-Khalil (Hebron), Ramallah, Jenin, and Qalqilya in the West Bank.

The cities of the West Bank were also frequently attacked by settlers, as most of these attacks were carried out in the cities of Nablus, Al-Khalil (Hebron), Bethlehem, and Ariha (Jericho), and the number of these attacks reached 23. According to the Observatory's statistics, the total number of Israeli violations against the Palestinian people over the aforementioned period amounted to about (4,217) violations, ranging from killing, wounding, and arresting Palestinian citizens, attacks on places of worship, demolition of property, incursions, closure of crossings, and construction of roadblocks and checkpoints on the roads leading to Palestinian villages, towns and cities, attacks by settlers, in addition to the confiscation of Palestinian lands, shooting, and the establishment of settlement outposts.

## **100,000 Palestinians killed, wounded or missing” since last October 7 – 3,331 violations in a week in the Gaza Strip and the West Bank**

The number of martyrs who fell as a result of the continued Israeli crimes, raids and aerial and artillery bombardment against the Palestinians reached (847), of whom (843) were in the Gaza Strip alone, while four martyrs fell in murder operations inside the cities of the West Bank. On 30/1/2024, the number of wounded reached (1,477) as a result of (96) massacres committed by the occupation forces over the period of time monitored by the OIC Observatory

The total number of violations committed by the occupation forces in various Palestinian cities reached (3,331), ranging from killing, wounding, arresting, demolishing property, assaulting mosques, erecting checkpoints, closing roads and crossings, shooting, confiscating land, building settlement units, and settler attacks on Palestinian cities and towns.

According to international reports, UN agencies observed the displacement of hundreds of thousands of Palestinians to the southern Gaza Strip to escape the Israeli bombing, with the ongoing displacement operations adding to the stifling humanitarian crisis in the city of Rafah. Reports indicated that there are currently 1.9 million displaced people in various areas of the Gaza Strip. Reports issued on 2/2/2024 indicated that there were one hundred thousand Palestinians “killed, wounded or missing” because of the Israeli aggression.

Reports also indicated a stifling food crisis, as well as the loss of drinking water, fuel, safe havens, tents, and other minimum requirements for a decent living.

The OIC Observatory pointed out that in the West Bank, the number of arrests carried out by the occupation forces among Palestinians for the period of time monitored amounted to 219 detainees in the cities of Ramallah, Bethlehem, Ariha, Al-Quds, Salfit, Jenin, Nablus, Tulkarm, Qalqilya, Al-Khaleel, and the town of Tubas. The Israeli settlers’ attacks reached their peak this week with (25) attacks targeting the cities of Al-Khaleel, Nablus, Ramallah, Ariha and others, while 708 new settlement units were built in the West Bank.

Jewish extremists continued to storm the blessed Aqsa Mosque from 30/1 through 5/2/2024, with the exception of 4/2/2024 when the occupation forces legalized the entry of worshipers and imposed restrictions on them when performing Friday prayers in the Holy Mosque, bringing the number of worshipers down to only 13 thousand worshipers after denying worshipers from the cities of the West Bank access to the blessed Aqsa Mosque.

### **Weekly Report of the OIC Observatory on Israel’s Crimes against Palestinians**

In the period from 13 to 19 February 2024 covered by the OIC Observatory on Israel’s Crimes against Palestinians, 753 persons were killed in the Gaza Strip, 2 in the West Bank, while 1069 were injured. Most of the martyrs in the Gaza Strip died from the bombardment of various parts of the Strip by the Israeli occupation forces. This includes Rafah which has been described by the United Nations Children’s Fund (UNICEF) as “the world’s most densely populated area,” holding 1.5 million people, almost half of the population of the Gaza Strip. UNICEF called for the protection of civilians in Rafah amid Israel’s unrelenting bombardment of civilians and threats to continue its military aggression during the month of Ramadan, heightening the chances to commit unprecedented massacre and worsen the humanitarian disaster in the Gaza Strip.

The Nasser Medical Complex in Khan Younes, south of the Gaza Strip, witnessed numerous atrocities, having been completely taken over by the occupation forces after many days of blockade. The Palestinian Ministry of Health in the Strip last Friday announced the death of 3 patients at the intensive care unit of the complex due to power outage and lack of oxygen, warning that 9 more are likely to die for the same reasons. Earlier last week, a Palestinian youth arrested by the occupation forces was forced to wear a medical isolation gown and blindfolded. He was asked to relay the threats of the occupation forces to evacuate the complex. When he returned, the occupation shot him three times. Eye witnesses also caught on camera the dead body of a child who attempted to leave the complex and was killed by an Israeli sniper. His corpse was left at the complex entrance while all those who attempted to collect the body were targeted.

Between 23 January and 19 February 2024, the people killed number 3851. Since 7 October 2023 till the date of filing this report, 29092 have been killed. In the West Bank, detainees number 169 in the period from 13 to 19 February 2024 after the occupation forces stormed cities and towns in the West Bank and occupied Al-Quds (Jerusalem). The blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque is also infiltrated on a daily basis by Jewish extremists under the protection of the occupation army.



The number of attacks by Israeli settlers on Palestinian towns and villages reached 34 in the same period. The occupation forces demolished 5 houses in Al-Quds and Jericho and confiscated lands in Ramallah and Salfit. This is in addition to shootings, erection of barriers and confiscation of properties. The total number of violations and crimes committed by Israel, the occupying authority in one week reached 2747.

## **OIC Observatory for Israel's crimes against the Palestinians joins voices calling for preventing its targeting and restriction of journalists**

In preparation for the Extraordinary Session of the Islamic Conference of Information Ministers scheduled to be held in Istanbul, Republic of Türkiye, on 24 February 2024, the OIC Observatory for Israeli Crimes and Violations against Palestinians stressed the need to address the ongoing Israeli disinformation campaign as well as the continuing aggression of Israel, the occupying power, against Palestinian and foreign journalists and media in Palestine, especially in the Gaza Strip, as a means of concealing the truth about the crimes committed by Israel in the Gaza Strip and the West Bank.

The Observatory explained that the special Istanbul session, attended by the ministers responsible for information and communication in the OIC Member States, will discuss joint efforts to confront disinformation campaigns carried out by Israel, the occupying power, against journalists in Palestine.

The OIC Observatory noted that journalists continue to face killings, harassment, and violence by the occupation forces while covering the ongoing Israeli genocide in the Gaza Strip and the entire occupied territory.

According to Palestinian media rights groups and Palestinian journalists, an increase in disinformation targeting reality has been observed in occupied Palestine, where Israel is actively spreading false information and propaganda to undermine the credibility and influence of Palestinian and other journalists. These tactics include spreading misleading narratives and fabricated stories and using social media platforms to amplify anti-Palestinian messages.

It is noteworthy that journalists wearing press identity cards were deliberately targeted and killed on dozens of occasions in the Gaza Strip and the West Bank by Israeli soldiers. In addition, the Israeli occupation destroys media offices and facilities, resulting in casualties among workers in this sector and civilians.

The Israeli occupation authorities have also launched propaganda and smear campaigns against Palestinian journalists and media outlets, using charges of incitement or belonging to armed groups as pretexts to justify their crimes against them or limit the movement of Palestinian journalists.

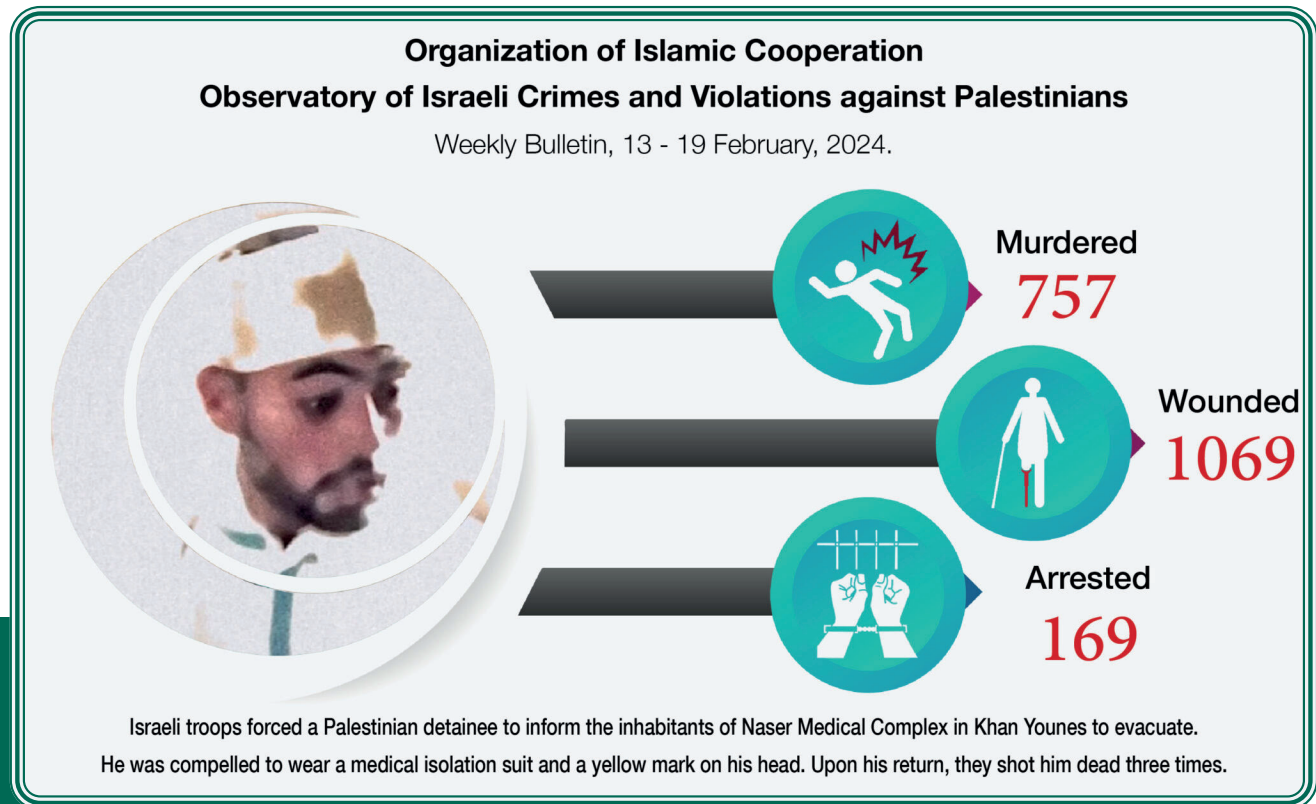
In addition, Palestinian journalists and media outlets face cyberattacks and surveillance carried out by Israeli intelligence services.

Therefore, the OIC Observatory expressed its joining with others in calling on social and digital media platforms to put an end to the misinformation, dehumanization of Palestinians, and the silencing of their voices on their platforms.

During more than four months of Israeli aggression, more than 100 journalists were killed in Gaza. The journalists who survived these events over the period live in inhumane conditions and suffer from a lack of subsistence requirements, like other residents of the Gaza Strip.

Considering this painful reality, Palestinian correspondents in Gaza show indescribable courage in continuing to report on the genocidal war waged by the Israeli occupation against the Palestinian people, many of whom lost their loved ones in bombing operations, and others live in tents without electricity, and with scarcity of food and water. Meanwhile, injured journalists do not receive adequate medical care to barely bandage their wounds.

## Killings and starvation claimed the lives of (698) Palestinians on February 20-26 70% of the victims of the Israeli bombing are women and children in Gaza



The city of Deir al-Balah was subjected to violent Israeli bombing during the past few days, which claimed the lives of many Palestinians, most of whom were displaced people who fled the bombing of the areas in the northern Gaza Strip, while the Israeli starvation policy against the people of the Gaza Strip reached its peak recently, especially in the areas of the northern and central Gaza Strip.

According to the Organization of Islamic Cooperation Observatory for Israel's crimes against the Palestinians for the period between February 20-26, 2024, the number of martyrs in the Gaza Strip reached about (690) in (64) massacres, while the number of those killed in the West Bank in the same period reached about (8) martyrs. The number of people injured by Israeli occupation forces in the Gaza Strip and the West Bank reached about (1,057).

On the other hand, the number of Palestinian martyrs from October 07, 2023, until February 25, 2024, reached about (29,700). The Palestinian Ministry of Health stated in a report, a copy of which was obtained by the OIC's observatory, that 70% of the martyrs during that period were women and children, with a total of (7,950) women, while the number of children who died in the bombing reached (12,500). During the same period, about (69,800) people were injured because of air, artillery, and naval bombardment and shooting operations in populated civilian areas.

The areas of the Gaza Strip are suffering under the weight of death and starvation due to the prevention of the entry of aid convoys by the occupation forces and the scarcity of goods in various cities there. In addition to the suffering of the people of the Gaza Strip from killing, malnutrition that almost reaches the point of famine, and disease, the displaced people are crowded together in the city of Rafah – south of the Gaza Strip. They fear an imminent Israeli military invasion amid international warnings that this may lead to dozens of massacres against Palestinian civilians, most of whom are sleeping on the ground without shelter or food.

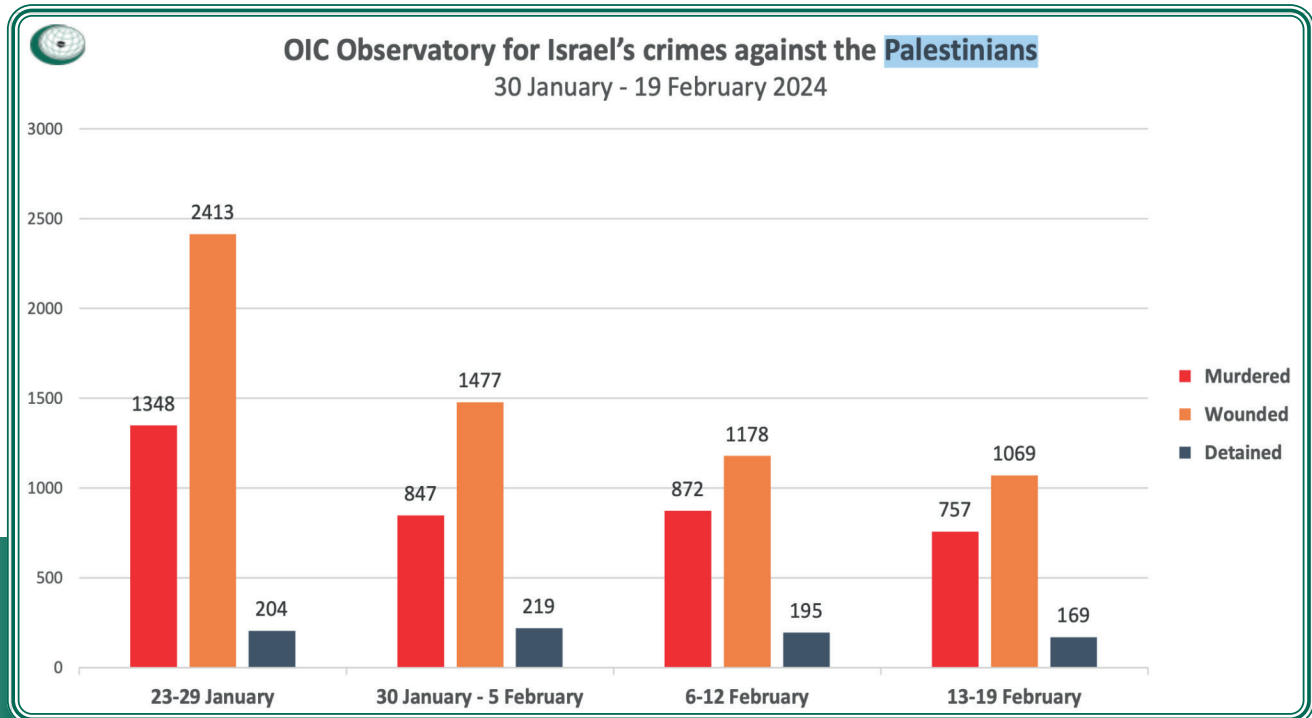
On the other hand, during the period February 20-26, the Blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque witnessed almost daily raids by Jewish extremists under the protection of the Israeli occupation forces, which last Friday tightened restrictions on the entry of Palestinian worshipers into the mosque from cities and villages in the West Bank. In the West Bank as well, the number of attacks by Israeli settlers against Palestinian villages and towns during the same period reached its peak in weeks, with (40) attacks amid the continuation of settlement activities, especially in Bethlehem, the demolition of three homes in both Al-Quds, Bethlehem, and Jenin, bulldozing agricultural lands, cutting 40 trees in Salfit, and demolishing property and infrastructure.



## Israel Sets a “Hunger Trap” in the Roundabouts of “Nabulsi” and “Kuwait”

the Number of People Killed from 7 October 2023 up to Date Exceeds 30000

The number of Palestinians murdered since 7 October 2023 up to this date has exceeded thirty thousand martyrs for the weekly monitoring period of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation’s Observatory of Israel’s crimes against the Palestinians, from 27 February to 4 March 2024.



Killings in the Gaza Strip also have reached a record high as Israeli occupying forces have carried out so-called “flour massacres” as part of its hunger trap, particularly in areas north of the Gaza Strip. 118 people were killed in the massacre of 29 February 2024, at Nabulsi roundabout in Northern Gaza. In addition to that, Israeli forces committed another massacre at the “Kuwait roundabout” on 3 March in which ninety Palestinians were shot dead when they gathered with others seeking flour bags, which were rarely distributed in areas of northern Gaza, as well as, targeting a humanitarian convoy in Deir al-Balah, which led to the fall of 8 Palestinians.

During the period from 27 February to 4 March 2024, the OIC’s Observatory recorded (755) martyrs in the Gaza Strip, along with 10 others in the West Bank, bringing the total number of Palestinian victims to (765) martyrs and (1894) wounded. Israeli occupying forces also arrested around (169) people in the West Bank, and the number of settler attacks on Palestinian villages reached around (37) attacks for the mentioned period.

In this context, Israeli occupying forces demolished four houses in Jerusalem, Bethlehem, Jericho, and Nablus. They also demolished commercial facilities in Jenin, confiscated land in Jerusalem and Salfit, and bulldozed streets in Tubas, Jenin, and Tulkarem. The number of violations in general amounted to approximately (3,593) violations over the past seven days, which included killings, injuries, arrests, demolitions of facilities, land confiscations, raids, shootings, road closures, and attacks on places of worship. The blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque has also been subject to daily raids by Israeli extremists in recent weeks, and the OIC Observatory has monitored it, indicating that Israel is adopting a systematic policy of assault on Al-Aqsa mosque.

## **Ramadan in Gaza with Famine-Ravaged Residents; Israel Restricts Al-Aqsa Mosque Worshipers; and 3274 Violations against the Mosque in February**

The blessed month of Ramadan began on 11 March 2024, this week amid worsening plight exemplified by serious shortage of food items inside the Strip, reaching famine level in the northern and central areas of the Strip. This is in addition to the restrictions imposed by Israel, the occupying power, on worshipers below the age of 40 from accessing the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque for Isha and Taraweeh prayers as well as the Friday prayers on 8 March 2024.

The tallies recorded by the OIC Observatory on Israel's Crimes against Palestinians in the period from 5 to 11 March 2024 are as follows: 583 Palestinians martyred, most of them in the Gaza Strip. 5 were killed in the West Bank. Massacres against civilians totaled 61. In the same period, 864 were wounded while 182 were arrested in various towns and villages of the West Bank.

The cities of the Gaza Strip welcomed Ramadan amidst worsening food crisis resulting from the deliberate Israeli blockade and the continuous targeting of humanitarian caravans, and particularly from the crimes committed by the occupation forces in the north of the Strip that has become isolated from the world. This situation is getting worse with the frantic Israeli attempts to reoccupy Gaza permanently by isolating the eastern part of the city from its western part through the so-called Natsarim crossing.

In the West Bank, attacks by settlers on Palestinian towns and villages totaled 39, most of them concentrated on the villages of Hebron, Ramallah, Nablus, Tulkaram, Salfit, Betlehem and Jericho. Four (4) houses were demolished by the occupation authorities in Al-Quds, Jenin, Ramallah and Nablus, with an additional 3 in Jericho. The total number of Israeli violations in the period from 5 to 11 March 2024 is 2361, including the Israeli approval of the plan to build 3500 settlements in the Ma'ale Adumim, Erfat and Kedar Settlements in Al-Quds. Streets and farmlands were excavated in Betlehm and Tulkaram; settlement hubs were established in Toubas. Properties and commercial real estates were destroyed while cities were invaded, streets closed and gunshots fired.

A report prepared by the OIC Representative Office mentioned that Israeli violations in Al-Quds last February claimed 8 lives, with Israeli incursions into the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque totaling 3274. According to the report, the occupation forces arrested 251 Palestinians, including 10 children and 9 women, while the bodies of 40 Palestinian martyrs are held in the occupation mortuaries.

## **Israel Puts Pressure on the Palestinians through Starvation and Systematically Kills Civilians**

### **The Second Massacre in the "Kuwait Roundabout" and Israel Targets the Largest UNRWA Warehouse in Gaza**

The Israeli occupation forces continue to pressure the Palestinians by starving them and systematically killing them in the Gaza Strip. This was done through bombing and sniping at crowds waiting for aid, and through the slow death of Gaza residents after targeting food warehouses, as happened recently in Rafah.

In Rafah, 5 Palestinians were killed in a deliberate Israeli bombing of the largest warehouse belonging to the UN Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) on March 13, 2024.

The number of those killed during the period monitored by the OIC Observatory for Israel's crimes against the Palestinians between March 12-18, 2024 reached (614) martyrs and (1,049) wounded, one hundred of whom were killed and two hundred wounded in the second massacre at the Kuwait Roundabout on March 14, 2024, and dozens were killed in the Shifa Hospital massacre on March 18, 2024. The number of Palestinian martyrs after 165 days of Israeli aggression on the Gaza Strip reached about (32,161) martyrs, in addition to two million displaced people in Rafah and adjacent areas, and (63,000) housing units were damaged. In the cities and villages of the West Bank, (10) people were killed, while the Israeli occupation forces arrested (126) people. The number of settler attacks on Palestinian villages reached (34), including Hebron, Nablus, Ramallah, Salfit, Jenin, Tulkarm, and Jerusalem. The occupation forces demolished a restaurant in Jericho and 4 barracks in Jenin. In Bethlehem, the occupation forces confiscated a vehicle and destroyed property in Nablus, Hebron, and Jerusalem, and carried out settlement activities that included constructing roads and erecting fences for settlement outposts in Salfit and Nablus.

The blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque was subjected to restrictions on the first Friday of the holy month of Ramadan. The Israeli occupation forces prevented young men from performing prayers in the mosque and prevented medical teams from entering its courtyards. The occupation forces also placed barbed wire at Asbat Gate on March 12, 2024. The number of those who stormed the courtyards of Al-Aqsa during the period from



March 10 to 13, 2024 was about (1,741) people, including settlers and other so-called “tourist groups,” in addition to an American delegation last Friday.

40 settlers stormed the “Bab al-Rahma” cemetery, adjacent to the eastern wall of Al-Aqsa, and destroyed a number of tombstones and restoration materials for the cemetery. They trampled on the graves and wandered around the cemetery.

## **The Israeli Forces Expel the Remaining Displaced People in Al-Shifa after a Massacre that Killed 50 People Accompanied by Atrocities**

### **Israel Targets the Commercial Interests of Palestinian Individuals in the West Bank**

The Israeli occupation forces increased their attacks in the Gaza Strip, especially on March 20 and 21, 2024, as they killed 606 Palestinians and injured 922 others, during the week monitored by the Organization of Islamic Cooperation Observatory on Israel’s crimes against Palestinians, spanning from March 19 to March 25, 2024. In the Gaza Strip, dozens were killed by the Israeli bombing in the Nuseirat and Jabalia camps last Wednesday, March 20, in addition to the killing of 23 others as a result of the bombing of tribal committees working on the distribution of aid at the Kuwait Roundabout near Al-Rashid Street in the Gaza Strip.

The number of massacres committed against the civilians in the Gaza Strip during the period monitored by the observatory reached (0000). In light of these developments, the Secretary-General of the UN, António Guterres, confirmed that more than one million Palestinians in the Gaza Strip are facing catastrophic famine.

In Al-Shifa Medical Complex in central Gaza, the Israeli occupation forces stormed Al-Shifa for the second time after a previous one on November 18, 2023, and assassinated (50) people. The occupation forces also arrested (200) Palestinians, and continued to invade the hospital until the writing of this report and most of those sheltering there fled as a result of the continuous Israeli bombing of the hospital. After hundreds of people were displaced from the hospital, the media received horrific testimonies from fleeing Palestinians revealing atrocities committed by the Israeli forces after taking control of Al-Shifa.

In the West Bank, March 21, 2024, was considered a bloody day, as the number of killings reached 9 out of 16 others killed during the period from 19-25 March 2024. The occupation forces arrested 154 people during that period, while 21 settler attacks on towns and villages in the West Bank were recorded, the most prominent of which was the stabbing by settlers of a Palestinian driver in Jerusalem.

Israel confiscated 8000 square meters of the Yafit in Jericho last week, and the OIC Observatory also documented many Israeli violations against Palestinians in the West Bank targeting the economic interests of citizens there. For example, the occupation forces confiscated two bulldozers in Jenin and Qalqilya, demolished commercial and service facilities in Hebron and Jerusalem, uprooted 150 olive trees, and bulldozed agricultural land in Bethlehem, in addition to confiscating many properties. Thus, the total number of Israeli violations against Palestinians during the past week reached about (2,366) violations, including road closures, erecting checkpoints, and shootings.

Regarding the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque, approximately 3,274 settlers stormed the mosque via the Mughrabi Gate, during the month of February, to pray for the Israeli prisoners and dead soldiers.

## **Israel Kills 7 Members of the “WCK” in Continuation of the Policy of Starvation and Exclusion of International Organizations after Targeting “UNRWA” Increased Violations of Al-Aqsa During Ramadan and Confiscation of 8159 Dunum in Nablus**

512 Palestinians were killed in one week by the Israeli occupation forces in the Gaza Strip, and the number of wounded reached 736. The number of killings among Palestinians in Gaza from October 7, 2023 until March 31, 2024 is about (33,237) dead. Meanwhile, Israel, the occupying power, intends to invade the city of Rafah despite the overpopulation and the gathering of displaced people, under extremely difficult humanitarian conditions that amount to famine.

During the week monitored by the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) Observatory on Israel’s crimes against the Palestinians, March 26 – April 1, 2024, the Israeli occupation forces committed (51) massacres against the Palestinians in the Gaza Strip. The most prominent of which was the horrific crime that targeted the World Central Kitchen (WCK) Team, consisting of 7 Individuals. The WCK said in a statement issued on its website that it was devastated to confirm 7 members of WCK team had been killed in an IDF strike in Gaza. The WCK added that its team was traveling in a deconflicted zone in two armored cars branded with the WCK logo and a soft skin vehicle. The WCK also clarified that despite coordinating

movements with the IDF, the convoy was hit as it was leaving the Deir al-Balah warehouse, where the team had unloaded more than 100 tons of humanitarian food aid.

This massacre sends a clear Israeli message to the world that everyone is threatened with death in the Gaza Strip, amid deliberate starvation and indirect expulsion of international organizations, a policy that began with the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) and continues to intimidate all those working to provide food to the residents of Gaza.

The occupation forces increased their incursions into the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque to reach 8 weekly incursions, in light of the Palestinians' performance of the Taraweeh prayer in the holy month of Ramadan. This occurred amid the Temple Group's announcement of its intention to hold a preparatory press conference to "slaughter the Red Cow" in Al-Quds. The number of settlers who stormed the Blessed Al-Aqsa reached 1,452 extremists in a week between March 24-30, 2024. This period included the Jews' celebration of the Jewish "Purim" holiday, which was accompanied by extremist incursions into Al-Aqsa's compound. In the West Bank, five people were killed in the city of Jenin, and the occupation forces arrested 153 Palestinians in various cities in the West Bank. Last week coincided with the Palestinians' commemoration of Land Day since 1967 until now. The number of settler attacks on Palestinian villages and towns reached about 26 attacks. The occupation forces confiscated 8,159 Dunum of land from the village of Aqraba in Nablus in order to build settlement units on them. They also confiscated 4 private vehicles in Jericho, Salfit, and Nablus, and demolished a garbage dump in Salfit and property in Jericho, in addition to demolishing commercial stores in the city of Al-Quds, and leveling lands in Nablus. The occupation forces also prevented worshipers from performing their prayers in a mosque in the Husan area of Hebron, and attacked medical teams and ambulances in the town of Tubas. This brings the number of Israeli violations in general to 2,095 violations in a week, including the Gaza Strip, the West Bank, and Al-Quds.

## Settler Attacks on the West Bank Reach 123 in Two Weeks, Mass Graves Discovered in Khan Yunis, and Occupation Forces Killed 34,262 Since October 7

Israeli settlers' attacks on West Bank villages doubled during the period between April 2 and 15, 2024, reaching 123 attacks, which reached their peak after the killing of an Israeli settler near the village of Al-Mughayir in Ramallah. The settlers attacked Palestinian properties and engaged in clashes with them.

According to the Organization of Islamic Cooperation Observatory on Israel's crimes against the Palestinians for the aforementioned period, the Israeli occupation forces arrested 377 Palestinians in the cities and villages of the West Bank, and 8 people were killed there by the bullets of the occupation forces. The occupation forces demolished three homes, including one in al-Quds, and destroyed rooms and shops in al-Quds, Jericho and Bethlehem. Additionally, the occupation forces confiscated 170 dunums of land in Bethlehem, along with the confiscation of 6 vehicles in various Palestinian villages.

During this period, Israeli forces continued their aggression by attacking mosques, schools, and medical personnel. The total number of Israeli violations during this period reached 4,059, including killings, injuries, arrests, confiscation of property, demolition of homes, bulldozing lands, streets, and infrastructure, erecting barriers, closing roads, shooting, and attacks on various educational and health sectors, and mosques.

In the Gaza Strip, the number of Palestinians killed since October 7, 2023, until the date of this report has risen to 34,262 people, while 953 people were killed in the Gaza Strip during the period from the end of the holy month of Ramadan to the entirety of the Eid al-Fitr period. Additionally, approximately 1163 individuals were wounded during this period.

The Israeli occupation forces withdrew from Khan Yunis on April 7, 2024, leaving behind widespread destruction in the city, revealing numerous mass graves. At the Al-Shifa Medical Complex, Palestinian Civil Defence personnel and medical staff discovered mass graves containing the bodies of individuals executed in their underwear in the hospital courtyard. The search continues for victims among civilians and hospital residents killed by occupation forces.

The Palestinians in the Gaza Strip are living in difficult circumstances in light of the massive destruction inflicted upon them, while the occupation forces committed 31 massacres between April 2-8, 2024, during which 362 people were killed.

## **Israel Intensifies its Aggression against West Bank Cities and Prepares to Invade Rafah; 34,582 Palestinians Murdered**

The Israeli occupation forces intensified their attacks on West Bank cities. Additionally, they continue their aggression against the Gaza Strip.

According to the Organization of Islamic Cooperation's media observatory for Israel's crimes against the Palestinians during the period 16 – 22 April 2024, 378 Palestinians were murdered, including 24 people in West Bank, and about 675 Palestinians were wounded, most of them, in the Gaza Strip. The number of Palestinians killed from October 7, 2023, until April 21, 2024, reached about 34,582.

The occupation forces have expanded their military aggression against the Gaza Strip over the past week, and they are preparing for a large-scale military operation expected in the crowded city of Rafah. Israel is clearly ignoring all international warnings of the consequences of a major humanitarian catastrophe in the city if Israel insists on its preparations to invade the city.

In the city of Khan Yunis, reports documented the discovery of mass graves in the courtyard of the Nasser Medical Complex in the south of the Gaza Strip, indicating that hundreds of displaced, wounded, sick, and medical staff were subjected to torture and abuse before they were executed and buried en masse.

On the other hand, the United Nations reported that, 6 months after the start of the Israeli aggression on the Gaza Strip, more than 10 thousand Palestinian women were murdered, including 6 thousand mothers, leaving behind about 19 thousand orphaned children.

In Al-Quds Al-Sharif, Jewish extremists, under the protection of the occupation forces, stormed the Al-Aqsa Mosque on an almost daily basis. The occupation forces also attacked a Palestinian journalist while she was performing her work in the city, and a house there was demolished.

In the West Bank, the occupation forces stormed Nour Shams camp in the city of Tulkarm during the past days, and 18 people murdered were victims of this aggression. Palestinians announced a comprehensive strike in the cities, towns, and villages of the West Bank, including suspending school for one day, in protest against the Israeli aggression on the Gaza Strip and the Nour Shams camp.

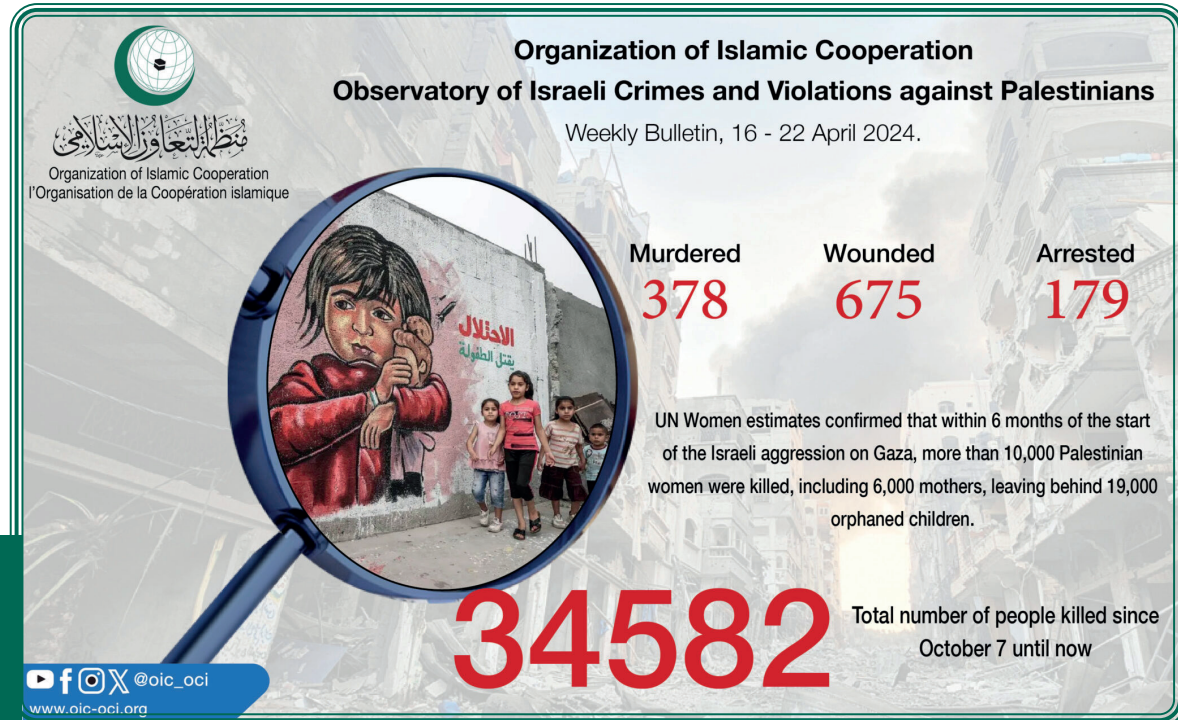
The total number of Israeli violations over the period of time monitored by the OIC Observatory amounted to 1,931 violations, the most prominent of which included the confiscation of agricultural areas in the villages of Hebron, including 64 dunums in the village of Al-Buwayra, the establishment of settlement

outposts in the northern Jordan Valley, the construction of a settlement road in Tulkarm, and the expansion of the entrance to “Refafa” settlement near Salfit. The occupation forces confiscated two agricultural tractors and two bulldozers and destroyed cars in Jenin, Tulkarm, and Al-Bireh. They also demolished a house in Hebron, bulldozed agricultural lands in Qalqilya, Tubas, and Deir Istiya, in addition to uprooting many perennial olive trees, destroyed and confiscated property in Nour Shams camp, and beat up citizens in Bethlehem, and attacked medical teams, in addition to raiding a mosque in Tulkarm.

Finally, the number of settler attacks on towns and villages in the West Bank reached 31 attacks over the course of one week, which included shooting at Palestinian citizens in the village of Burqa in the city of Ramallah, during which 6 Palestinians were wounded.

## 34,897 Murdered since October 7 and expectations are that the announced murdered toll is much lower than reality

## Gaza is facing famine within 6 weeks and violations against “Al-Aqsa and Al-Ibrahimi” during “Passover”



The Organization of Islamic Cooperation Media Observatory for Israel’s Crimes against the Palestinians recorded 343 murders between April 23 and 29, 2024. Five of the dead were murdered in the West Bank, and the rest in the Gaza Strip. The Observatory also documented 576 injuries among Palestinians in Gaza and the West Bank. The total number of murders since October 7, 2023, has now reached approximately 34,879.

“The Wall Street Journal” reported that the number announced by the Palestinian Ministry of Health regarding the Palestinians murdered in the Israeli aggression on Gaza is considered significantly much lower than the actual number due to the inability of the health authorities to count all the murdered, while hospitals and emergency departments are barely functioning.

On April 23, the World Food Program confirmed that famine will hit the Gaza Strip within six weeks, as half of the Strip’s population is suffering from hunger, amid the continued Israeli threat to invade the city of Rafah, which is crowded with displaced people.

On the other hand, Per Lodhamar, former head of the United Nations Mine Action Agency in Iraq, stated that the Israeli aggression on Gaza has resulted in “37 million tons of rubble,” and confirmed that 65% of the demolished buildings in the Strip were residential. Lodhamar added that “removing the resulting debris could take 14 years to complete.”

Al-Aqsa Mosque was subjected to daily raids, amid clear violations during the “Jewish Passover,” when 15 Jewish rabbis asked the Israeli government to allow them to slaughter sacrifices inside the mosque. Palestinian youths prevented extremist Jews from bringing goats into the courtyard of the mosque to



slaughter them as sacrifices to celebrate this occasion. In the city of Hebron, the occupation authorities closed the Ibrahimi Mosque to Palestinians and prevented them from praying there for two days under the pretext of enabling settlers to perform Talmudic rituals inside the Mosque on the occasion of “Passover” for the Jews.

On the other hand, the occupation authorities carried out an arrest campaign in the cities and towns of the West Bank throughout the period between 23 and 29 April of this year, resulting in 104 detainees, while the number of settler attacks on Palestinian towns and villages amounted to about 39 attacks, amid land leveling in both Jenin and Nablus and the confiscation of 3 bulldozers and a motorcycle in Salfit and Tulkarm, in addition to many other violations amounting during the aforementioned week to about 1,701 violations.

## Israel invades Rafah and kills 253 Palestinians in a week Gaza needs \$40 billion and 16 years to rebuild

The Israeli occupation forces practically began the military operation against the city of Rafah, despite clear international rejection, and the progress that has been made to stop the Israeli aggression on the Gaza Strip, and amid numerous international warnings of the consequences of a massive human massacre and unprecedented famine in the city.

The occupation forces also killed (253) Palestinians in (26) massacres in different areas, according to the OIC Media Observatory for Israel's Crimes against the Palestinians, during the period between April 30 – May 6, 2024. The occupation forces wounded (476) Palestinians during the same period. On the other hand, 35,233 Palestinians were murdered since October 7, 2023 until now.

In the Gaza Strip, Israeli settlers attacked two Jordanian aid convoys, the first at the Beit Hanoun crossing, which included (31) trucks, and the second on the Kerem Shalom crossing road, which consisted of (48) trucks carrying humanitarian aid, which included food and flour.

The United Nations Development Program and the UN Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia stated in a joint report that the Israeli war on the Gaza Strip will push about 1.74 million Palestinians into poverty, representing 58% of the Strip's population. The report said that the Israeli bombing over a period of (7) months destroyed a (44) year development effort that had begun in 1980 in the fields of health and education in the Gaza Strip. The report estimated the cost of rebuilding Gaza at approximately (40) billion dollars, which may take (16) years in a reconstruction process ends at 2040 at best. The report confirmed that the Israeli war completely destroyed (79) thousand homes, and partially destroyed 370 thousand.

Regarding the attacks on the Blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque, the OIC Observatory recorded (4) incursions into the courtyards of the Holy Mosque during the past 7 days. The cities and towns of the West Bank were subjected to a wave of arrests during the same period that included (127) Palestinians, and the occupation forces demolished (9) buildings that included residential homes and commercial stores in al Quds, Ramallah, Tulkarm, and Hebron, and confiscated (3) bulldozers, two agricultural tractors, and a truck in the villages of each of them. Hebron, Ramallah, and Nablus, along with the bulldozing of agricultural lands and infrastructure in Nablus, Hebron, and Tulkarm.

## **Israel Ends the Assumption of Safe Zones in the Gaza Strip and Kills 35,589 Palestinians in 7 Months**

### **2,000 Israeli Crimes in Palestinian Cities within a Week**

The Organization of Islamic Cooperation's Media Observatory for Israel's Crimes against the Palestinians recorded a new toll of civilian casualties. These developments coincide with the start of the Israeli occupation army's invasion of the city of Rafah at the beginning of the observation period, May 7-13, 2024.

The OIC Observatory followed this period and counted 358 murdered and 754 wounded, most of them victims of Israeli attacks on the Gaza Strip and the city of Rafah in particular, among 42 massacre.

These massacres have catastrophically compounded the humanitarian situation throughout the Gaza Strip. This development completely denies Israeli claims about safe havens for displaced Palestinians, with the number of Palestinian murders reaching 35,589, since October 7, 2023, until now.

On the humanitarian level, United Nations spokesman Stephane Dujarric confirmed on May 8 that no goods for humanitarian operations entered Gaza through the main crossings. The UN World Health Organization (WHO) warned that the fuel stock available in the Gaza Strip "will not be sufficient to provide health care for only 3 more days," along with the evacuation of the Muhammad Youssef Al-Najjar Hospital by Israeli forces. Israeli crimes against the Gaza Strip have remarkably spread to the occupied city of al-Quds when a group of settlers closed the main entrance to the village of Al-Issawiya to prevent aid from reaching the Gaza Strip, and another set fire to the trees surrounding the headquarters of the UN Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees, (UNRWA) in the Sheikh Jarrah in al-Quds.

Regarding Palestinian detainees, the Israeli occupation forces arrested 182 Palestinians in the cities of the West Bank and al-Quds, at a time when the American channel CNN presented a report revealing Israeli crimes against detainees who are tied naked to beds and prevented from moving throughout the period of their detention as a result of torture.

In terms of violations in general, the OIC Observatory recorded 2,000 Israeli violations within a week, ranging from murdering, wounding, arresting, assaulting, confiscation of property, levelling of land, and settlement activities in various Palestinian cities. The Observatory also recorded daily raids on the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque, in addition to the demolition of 13 homes in Hebron, Qalqilya, and Jericho, as well as the demolition of 8 other agricultural and commercial facilities in al-Quds, Jericho, and Hebron.

Israeli settlers increased their attacks on West Bank villages, where 30 crimes were monitored during which settlers physically assaulted Palestinian citizens, vandalized and assaulted their property, and carried out settlement activities that may lead to the construction of settlement outposts on Palestinian land. The occupation forces also closed the doors of the old building of the Hebron City Municipality in the Ain Al-Askar area, in preparation for seizing it and handing it over to Israeli settlers.

## **Statistics of the genocidal war by the Israeli occupation forces Against the Gaza Strip for (220) days since October 07, 2023**

The Organization of Islamic Cooperation Media Observatory for Israel's crimes against the Palestinians documented 3,123 massacres committed by the Israeli occupation forces over 220 days following the Israeli aggression on the Gaza Strip. These massacres resulted in the murder (missing) of 45,091 individuals.

The data show that the number of missing individuals has surpassed 10,000. Additionally, 35,091 fatalities have been reported at hospitals in the Gaza Strip, with 78,827 individuals sustaining injuries.

The report indicated that 15,103 children were murdered, and 31 Palestinians died from famine.

Statistics showed that the number of women murdered during the Israeli aggression reached 9,961. Israeli forces have also killed 492 medical personnel, 69 civil defense personnel, and 143 journalists, let alone the discovery of 7 mass graves inside hospitals, out of which 520 corpses were exhumed.

The Israeli aggression resulted in a concerning statistic: 72% of the total victims were children and women. 17,000 children were orphaned as a result of Israeli killings.

The OIC Observatory has documented the following health sector statistics in Gaza: 11,000 patients in need of surgery outside the Gaza Strip, 10,000 cancer patients in urgent need of treatment, 1,095,000 people suffering from infectious diseases due to forced displacement, 20,000 cases of viral hepatitis infection as a result of forced displacement, 60,000 pregnant women at risk due to limited access to healthcare, and 350,000 chronic patients at risk due to restricted access to essential medications.

The OIC Observatory documented 310 cases of health personnel being arrested, along with Israel's actions that led to 33 hospitals and 55 health centers being disabled. Additionally, 160 health institutions and 126 ambulances were targeted.

Israeli forces arrested 5,000 Palestinians from the Gaza Strip during the genocidal war, with 20 confirmed cases of journalists.

Israel's military operations resulted in the complete demolition of 186 government headquarters and 103 schools and universities. Additionally, 311 schools and universities were partially destroyed, along with 86,000 housing units that were permanently demolished. Furthermore, 294,000 housing units were partially destroyed as well.

The Israeli occupation forces demolished 247 mosques and partially demolished 326 ones, as well as targeting and destroying three churches along with destroying 206 archaeological and heritage sites.

It was reported that the Israeli occupation forces have so far dropped 75,000 tons of explosives on the Gaza Strip, with an estimated direct initial loss of this barbaric war of extermination on the Gaza Strip of about \$33 billion.

## **Israeli Fire Targets the UN and Settlers Blocking Humanitarian Aids in The West Bank to Gaza**

### **Settlers Storm Al-Aqsa and Al-Ibrahimi Mosques**

471 Palestinians were murdered in the Gaza Strip within one week since the start of the Israeli military attacks on the city of Rafah. The number of massacres has reached about 480, with 857 others wounded by Israeli fire from May 14 – 20, 2024, according to the Organization of Islamic Cooperation Media Observatory for Israel's Crimes against the Palestinians.

It is worth noting that 35,960 were murdered from October 7, 2023 until today, with 84,426 wounded and two million displaced people.

Israeli attacks on the United Nations and aid convoys were the most prominent headlines this week. Six Palestinians were murdered in an Israeli bombing that targeted a school belonging to the UN Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) in the Nuseirat camp in central Gaza, which the Israeli occupation forces admitted to. It also murdered a Palestinian driver working for the UN World Health Organization, (WHO) and wounded a Jordanian employee after Israel targeted their car east of Rafah city. Settlers also attacked the UNRWA headquarters in Sheikh Jarrah in al-Quds for the third time in a week,



and attempts were also made to intercept aid convoys near the Tarqumiya crossing, where they tried twice to prevent aid trucks by spoiling part of their contents or throwing them on the ground. Other settlers, near one of the crossings in the town of Beit Awa, set fire to a truck loaded with humanitarian food supplies that was on its way to Gaza, after the Israeli troops forced about seven trucks to head to the town area following a settler attack on them near the Tarqumiya crossing.

In the West Bank, settlers near the town of Aqraba blocked a Jordanian aid truck loaded with barley grains for the Nablus Agriculture Directorate, and emptying about 50 bags from the truck.

On the ground, nine people were murdered in Tulkarm, Bethlehem, Jenin, Nablus, Jerusalem, and Ramallah. The occupation forces arrested 129 people from various Palestinian cities and villages, while the number of settler attacks on Palestinian towns and villages reached 58, as they assaulted and burned agricultural crops. The occupation forces demolished four houses in Hebron and Bethlehem, confiscated eight heavy equipment, including trucks, agricultural tractors, and others, and raided money exchange shops, in addition to storming the Ibrahimi Mosque in the city of Hebron.

In occupied al-Quds, 2,251 Jewish extremists stormed the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque five times over the past week, one of the days coinciding with the celebrations of the so-called “Independence Day”; and “Palestinian Nakba Commemoration”, where the occupation forces prevented Palestinians from entering Al-Aqsa Mosque in order to secure the extremists present in the Holy Mosque. The total number of Israeli violations against Palestinians over the past week amounted to about 2,216, ranging from murdering, wounding, arrests, demolition of homes, confiscations, assaults on properties, closure of crossings, settler attacks, desecration of mosques, and more.

## **2,693 Israeli Crimes, 1,914 Murdered and Wounded Palestinian in 7 days Israeli Settlers Steal and Destroy the Property of the West Bank’s Residents**

The Organization of Islamic Cooperation Media Observatory for Israel’s Crimes against the Palestinians recorded, during the period May 21 – 27, 2024, one of the highest numbers of crimes and violations throughout the periods it has monitored over the past months.

The total number of Israeli crimes of various types reached 2693 ranging from murder to erecting checkpoints and closing roads.

The Observatory highlighted the Rafah camp massacre on 25 May 2024, as the most prominent and heinous of these crimes where more than 45 people were murdered, in addition to dozens of wounded, as a result of the Israeli bombing of a camp for the displaced people northwest of Rafah.

During the same period, the number of massacres in Gaza reached 40.

Earlier, Israel bombed more than ten displacement centers affiliated with the UN Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) which were designated by Israel as safe havens for displaced Palestinians.

Meanwhile, the Israeli occupation forces forced residents of Kamal Adwan Hospital in the northern Gaza Strip to evacuate under bombardment and direct targeting of the hospital and the vicinity of Beit Lahia, exacerbating the deterioration of the health situation in the Gaza Strip.

The OIC Observatory noted the murder of 489 Palestinians in the Gaza Strip and 12 others in the West Bank. The total number of people killed reached 501 over the course of only a week. The Observatory also recorded 1,413 wounded in various Palestinian cities, bringing the number of Palestinians murdered since October 7 to 36,569.

In the occupied al-Quds, groups of Israeli settlers, led by the extremist Israeli Minister of Security, Itamar Ben Gvir, and under the protection of the occupation police, stormed the courtyards of the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque and conducted provocative tours there.

In the West Bank, the occupation forces invaded the city of Jenin and murdered eight people. They also attacked medical teams, demolished a house, and destroyed a car wash in Nablus, and two commercial stores in Jerusalem. They also confiscated areas of land in Bethlehem, and two bulldozers in Tulkarm.

Settler groups in the West Bank carried out 48 attacks during the past week, which included stealing agricultural crops, burning and cutting down olive trees, destroying livestock barns, and seizing agricultural tractors in the villages of Hebron, Bethlehem, and Tubas.

The OIC Observatory also recorded the arrest of 142 Palestinians by the occupation forces in various Palestinian cities in the West Bank. It noted that after settlers had become accustomed to intercepting and preventing aid trucks heading to the Gaza Strip through the West Bank, a group of settlers, in the vicinity of the Zaatara Junction checkpoint, intercepted a truck loaded with packaged sugar for a juice company

in the city of Salfit in the West Bank, destroyed its contents and threw them on the ground. This attack indicates that settlers have been given the green light to attack Palestinian trucks, regardless of their cargo or destination.

## **Famine Looms over Northern Gaza, Extending Southward; 432 Palestinians Murdered in One Week**

### **10456 Settlers Storm Al-Aqsa in a Month, Demolish 8 buildings in the West Bank and al-Quds, and Burn Agricultural Lands**

Israel murdered 432 Palestinians from May 28 to June 3, 2024, as monitored by the Organization of Islamic Cooperation Media Observatory for Israel's crimes against the Palestinians. The Israeli occupation forces also murdered 429 Palestinians in the Gaza Strip in 34 massacres and 3 others in the West Bank, with the number of wounded during the same period reaching 1,779 wounded.

In the broader toll, the number of Palestinian martyrs since October 7, 2023 up to now has reached 36,899 martyrs, while the number of wounded has reached 87,407.

In the Gaza Strip, the Israeli occupation forces' total closure of the Strip and their military operation in the city of Rafah led to the expansion of the famine from northern to southern areas. The World Food Program confirmed that the people of the northern Gaza Strip are experiencing an actual famine that is expanding to the south. The Palestinian Ministry of Health recorded the death of 31 children due to malnutrition.

In occupied al-Quds, the Blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque was subjected to almost daily raids, while the number of raiders throughout May 2024 reached about 10,456. The occupation forces demolished three buildings in the city, in addition to demolishing a car wash and a printing press.

As for the West Bank, the occupation forces arrested 139 Palestinians over a period of seven days from various Palestinian cities, towns, and villages. They demolished three houses in the city of Jericho and two houses in the city of Bethlehem. The Israeli Forces caused the burning of 100 shops in a commercial market and the vegetable market in Ramallah after they stormed the city and confiscated 4 heavy equipment. The Jewish settlers uprooted many trees and set fire to agricultural lands in the cities of Nablus and Hebron.

The number of settlers attacks on West Bank towns reached about 66 attacks, during which they closed roads, burned Palestinian lands, stormed their homes, and assaulted them.

On the other hand, the number of Israeli violations against Palestinians over the aforementioned period, which were documented by the OIC's observatory, amounted to about 3,134 violations.

## **Israel Kills 2,000 Palestinians Every Month**

### **27,306 Were Killed in the First Four Months of the War on Gaza**

The Organization of Islamic Cooperation Media Observatory for Israel's Crimes Against Palestinians recorded a consistent pattern of systematic killings against Palestinians in the Gaza Strip since October 7, 2023, especially in the months of February, March, April, and May of 2024.

The rate of killings ranged between two thousand murders per month, as the OIC Observatory documented the murdering of 3163 Palestinians in February, 2790 in March, 1788 in April, and 1780 in May. This reflects a consistent goal of increasing pressure on the Palestinians, in addition to withholding the greatest possible amount of humanitarian aid and targeting the health sector.

The OIC Observatory noted that killings peaked in October at 8,635 murdered, and 6,619 murdered in November, while the number of murdered in December reached 7,021, and 5,031 in January, all of whom were murdered during the Israeli military operation that adopted a scorched-earth policy in preparation for the entry of ground forces in the first four months of the Israeli aggression.

On the other hand, the OIC Observatory observed Israeli crimes in the Gaza Strip from 4 to 9 June 2024, where it noted 605 murders and 1,765 injuries. The largest number of casualties appeared in the Nuseirat Camp massacre, in which 283 people were murdered and 816 wounded, amid massive destruction due to air, sea, and land bombardment of the Camp. The Observatory recorded 37,333 Palestinian murdered since October 7, 2023 until the writing of this report.

Israel admitted to killing at least 30 Palestinians in the bombing of a school affiliated with the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) that was housing displaced people in the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip, after more than 100 people were murdered in raids on the

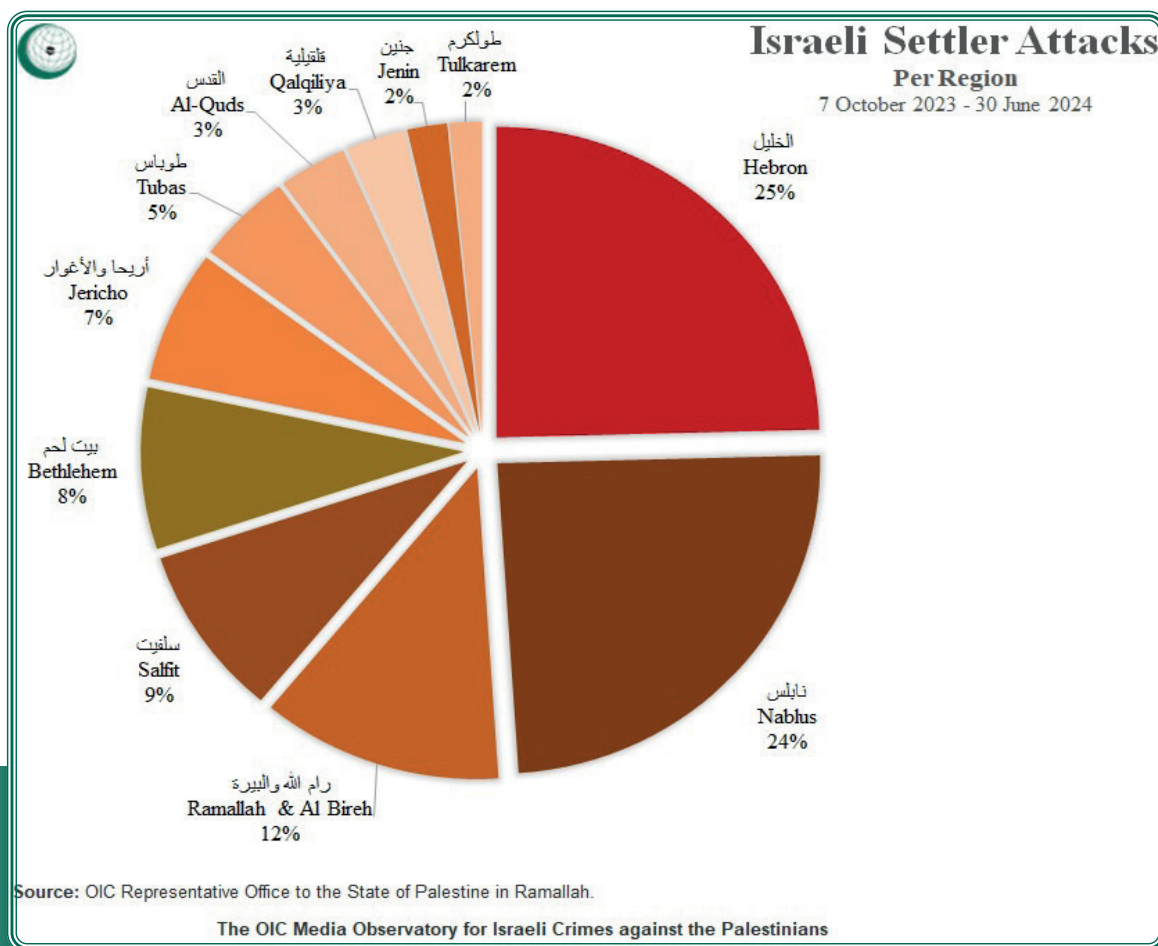


central region of the Gaza Strip within 24 hours.

In the humanitarian context, the United Nations Children’s Fund (UNICEF) said that 9 out of 10 children in Gaza cannot consume sufficient nutrients to ensure their healthy growth and development.

In occupied al-Quds, the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque was subjected to daily raids, while the Israeli occupation forces launched a massive wave of arrests against Palestinians in parallel with the flag march led by Israeli Security Minister Ben Gvir with a number of extremist Israeli ministers in the Bab al-Amoud and Bab al-Khalil areas, passing through the neighborhoods of the Old City of al-Quds. They reached Al-Buraq Square, adjacent to Al-Aqsa Mosque, and attacked a number of Palestinians and journalists, and chanted inflammatory slogans calling for the killing of Arabs and the burning of Palestinian towns. In the West Bank, the Israeli occupation forces murdered 10 Palestinians, most of them in the city of Jenin, while they arrested 166 Palestinians, and demolished 13 houses in Hebron, al-Quds, and Jenin, in addition to a three-story building in the city of al-Quds. They also demolished 24 commercial facilities, barns, and agricultural rooms in various areas of the West Bank. Settler attacks increased, reaching 38 attacks this week, during which they set fire to agricultural lands owned by Palestinians in Hebron, Tulkarm, and Ramallah, and stole 120 sheep in al-Quds. The total violations over this period amounted to about 3,080 violations, including all categories of daily crimes committed by Israeli forces against the Palestinian people in the West Bank, Gaza Strip, and occupied al-Quds.

## The Israeli War turns Gaza into a Cemetery along with Slow Death Settlers Burn Palestinian Lands in the West Bank



The successive humanitarian crises in the Gaza Strip over a period of eight months turned it into an open Israeli military target, making it a cemetery to which its residents cannot find a safe place to move. This situation continues amid international warnings of the return of the famine, especially northern Gaza, which is isolated from the world.

The report of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation Media Observatory on Israel’s Crimes against the Palestinians for the period from 10 – 17 June 2024 revealed that the situation in the Gaza Strip has become catastrophic with the Israeli ground invasion of all its areas, while Israeli forces murdered (279)

Palestinians, and wounded (923). The number of Palestinians who were murdered through the period from October 7, 2023 until June 12 2024 reached (37,746).

The United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA), said that (193) of its employees were murdered since the start of the war, which is the highest toll in the history of the UN. “The Gaza Strip is the most dangerous place in the world for aid workers.” UNRWA said.

Other reports indicated to a reverse displacement of Palestinians from the city of Rafah to the central areas of the Gaza Strip after the continuous Israeli bombing and open ground invasion.

The World Health Organization, (WHO) reports that famine is more imminent than ever in northern Gaza. The International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies warned of the widespread destruction of health services in northern Gaza and that the health system is on the verge of collapse there.

A UN report confirmed that the unprecedented toll of Israeli violations against Palestinian children is greater than anywhere in the world. The UN has added Israel’s military for the first time to its list of offenders for violating children’s rights.

In the West Bank, the Israeli occupation forces murdered (16) Palestinians, and confiscated and destroyed, along with Israeli settlers, (10) vehicles, including (4) bulldozers, (4) private vehicles, a truck, and an agricultural tractor. Israeli forces destroyed 20 sheep barns in Nablus and Jericho, and bulldozed agricultural land, while Israeli settlers cut down (200) olive trees in Hebron and burned olive and almond trees in Nablus, Bethlehem, and Ramallah. they also destroyed property and infrastructure in Nablus and Jenin, amid attempts by Settlers to confiscate lands in Nablus and Hebron, while their attacks on Palestinian villages throughout the aforementioned period amounted to (36) attacks, and the OIC Observatory counted (1,802) Israeli crimes in both Gaza and the West Bank over the period June 10 – 17, 2024

## **The OIC Observatory warns: Gaza Enters the Most Critical Humanitarian Phase Since October 7**

### **Israel Seeks to Make the Murdering Part of a Harsher Collective Punishment of Gazans**

The Organization of Islamic Cooperation’s media observatory for Israel’s crimes against the Palestinians warned that the Gaza Strip has already entered, since mid-June 2024, a very critical stage that is considered the worst compared to previous months. The OIC Observatory relied on 3 main elements, the first of which is the continued aggression of the Israeli forces against the Gaza Strip through complete control over it and targeting all its areas, and the refusal to stop military operations there, while the second element represents the destruction of approximately 70% of Gaza’s urban infrastructure, especially water networks., sanitation, and roads, as well as the destruction of most of the health sector, making most areas of Gaza unviable. The entry of limited quantities of humanitarian aid, fuel, and water is the third element that prevents the sector from recovering, even if in a limited way, and multiplies its humanitarian crises and increases their devastating effects more than ever before.

Also, it became clear from the daily statistics of the numbers of murdered and wounded and the targeting areas that Israel seeks to turn this hell into a daily reality in the Gaza Strip that does not foretell an imminent end to it, and that direct murdering constitutes part of a harsher collective punishment.

The United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs said that 67% of the water and sanitation facilities and infrastructure in the Gaza Strip were destroyed after about 9 months of continuous war, which led to the spread of infectious diseases, especially with the high temperatures in the summer and the pollution of drinking water. The Khan Yunis municipality also confirmed that 170-200 kilometers of water networks have already been destroyed.

The problem of drinking water in Gaza coincides with the starvation of its population by preventing the entry of goods and humanitarian aid, while Palestinians warned that 3,500 children were at risk of starvation, in light of the lack of regular vaccinations and medicines, along with the statement of “Save the Children”, which confirmed the loss of 21,000 children because of Israeli military operations.

The OIC Media Observatory monitored for the period between June 18 and 24, 2024, the murdering of (265) Palestinians and the injury of (680) others. While the number of people murdered from October 7, 2023 to June 23, 2024 reached (38,151) murdered, and (91,232) Palestinians were injured.

In the West Bank, five Palestinians were murdered by Israeli forces which also arrested (212) Palestinians, while the number of attacks by Israeli settlers on cities, towns and villages in the West Bank reached (33), including raids on two mosques in Jericho and Hebron, in addition to raids on the Blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque in occupied AL-Quds.



The settlers carried out settlement activities in repeated attempts to establish settlement outposts in Hebron and Nablus, in addition to grazing their sheep on Palestinian agricultural lands, burning other lands, and attacking agricultural greenhouses in Nablus, Salfit, Tulkarm, and Hebron, and stealing sheep from Palestinian barns, in addition to trying to obstruct aid convoys coming from Jordan to Gaza Strip. While the total Israeli crimes against Palestinians during the aforementioned period reached (1,576) crimes and violations of various categories.

### **1606 Attacks by Settlers in the West Bank from October 7 until June 2024**

The number of settler attacks on the cities and villages of the West Bank from October 7, 2023, to June 2024 reached 1606 attacks, reaching its peak in October with 343 attacks. Subsequent months saw 172 attacks in November and 127 in December. The number decreased in January to 99 attacks. The attacks rose again in February, reaching 136 attacks, in March 149, and in April 200 attacks, and the attacks in May reached its peak since October with 225 attacks, and in June, the attacks reached 155.

These attacks included killing and beating Palestinians, seizing their lands and properties, shooting and intimidating them, burning their crops, trees, and homes, breaking the branches of fruit trees and stealing their fruits, preventing Palestinians from harvesting their crops, destroying water pipes and electricity generators, performing Talmudic rituals in Mosques, writing racist phrases on Palestinian homes, throwing stones at them, and closing roads. The settlers were also stealing chickens and livestock, smashing car windows, and damaging their wheels, which reflects extremely degenerate criminal behavior.

The Organization of Islamic Cooperation's Media Observatory documented various crimes by Israel against the Palestinians, ranging from brutality to despicable acts.

On November 24, 2023, a settler's car ran over a young Palestinian man with special needs, East of the town of Yatta in Hebron, killing him. On June 8, 2024, settlers burned the wheat crop and trees and olive trees in the village of Beit Dajan, then they threw stones at Civil Defense personnel to prevent them from extinguishing the fire. The guard of the Yitzhar settlement, called Yaqoub, also sneaked into an area between the villages of Madama and Asira al-Qibliya in Nablus to steal a scooter in front of a house, and other settlers stole a teapot in Deir Abu Mishal.

The villages of Hebron were the most vulnerable to settler attacks, as they accounted for 25% of the total attacks mentioned with 395 attacks, while the villages of Nablus were exposed to 24%, with 391 attacks.

On the other hand, the OIC's Observatory recorded for the period between June 25 and July 1, 2024, the murdering of 246 Palestinians and 782 injuries, most of them in the Gaza Strip. It also noted the murdering of 38,431 Palestinians from October 7, 2023, until June 30, 2024.

In the humanitarian field, the Norwegian Refugee Council warned of a famine in the central and Southern Gaza Strip, similar to the North, while the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) said, "Waste and sewage are still accumulating throughout Gaza, as high temperatures and a lack of clean water contribute to accelerating the spread of diseases."

In the West Bank and al-Quds, the OIC's Observatory noted that the same category of crimes was repeated several times by the Israeli forces, which confirms that they were committed systematically and according to timetables, as they demolished 14 houses and 11 residential tents in Jericho, while they seized the vegetable market in the old town of the city of Hebron. Israel also confiscated and burned 8 vehicles, including a truck, two bulldozers, a cement mixer, a private car, and others.

The settlers burned many agricultural lands in Nablus and uprooted the stands of 200 grape trees. Their attacks last week amounted to 30 attacks among the total violations, which amounted to 1,649 violations over a period of 7 days.

## Israel is Destroying Gaza, and the Hospitals in the Health Sector are Collapsing One After Another

### The Israeli Forces Demolish 16 Houses, and Settlers Raid West Bank Villages 64 Times in a Week

*The criminal behavior of Israeli settlers in the West Bank is going on under Israeli military protection according to a timetable, with the aim of creating a continuing threat that turns the near villages into a dangerous environment that is not viable for Palestinians.*

- Killing and beating up farmers
- Shooting at villagers
- Land seizure
- Raids on villages to intimidate residents
- Lootings and plundering of homes at gunpoint
- Burning of agricultural crops, trees and homes
- Breaking the branches of fruit trees and stealing fruits
- Preventing Palestinians from harvesting their crops
- Damaging water pipes and destroying power generators
- Performing Talmudic rituals in mosques
- Writing racist Hebrew phrases on Palestinian homes
- Hurling stones at Palestinians
- Stealing chickens and livestock theft
- Breaking cars' windows and puncturing their wheels

The suffering of the Palestinians in the Gaza Strip is worsening as they depend on the remaining infrastructure of their destroyed cities because of the Israeli war. The health sector has almost collapsed after the closure of the “European” hospital in Khan Yunis and the warnings that the “Nasser Medical Complex” will follow suit, and the evacuation of the “al-Ahli-al-Arabi” hospital in central Gaza.

Meanwhile, the genocide process continues in the Gaza Strip, where the Israeli occupation forces killed 20 Palestinians last week in the Nuseirat camp massacre and wounded 75 others, at a school belonging to the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Refugees (UNRWA). The UNRWA school was sheltering displaced people in central Gaza City and it was targeted for the third time.

The weekly report of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation Media Observatory on Israel's Crimes against the Palestinians, covering 2 – 8 July 2024, documented the murdering of 235 Palestinians in the Gaza Strip, in addition to 17 Palestinians in the West Bank, and the injury of 729 Palestinians, bringing the total murdered since October 7, 2023, until July 8, 2024, to 38,763 Palestinians.

Meanwhile, the Regional Office for Arab States of the U.N. Development Programme, said that the cost of rebuilding the Gaza Strip amounts to 50 billion dollars, while Abdullah Al-Dardari, Assistant Secretary-General of the U.N., stated on May 3, 2024, that the cost may reach 40 billion dollars, reflecting an increase of \$10 billion in just three months due to extensive destruction.

In occupied al-Quds, Jewish extremists stormed the Blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque on a daily basis, while attacks by herds of settlers in the towns and villages of the West Bank reached 64 attacks, one of which included burning aid that was heading to the Gaza Strip, burning barns, bulldozing agricultural lands, and uprooting olive trees on agricultural lands belonging to Palestinians in the villages of Ramallah, Jenin, Nablus, Hebron, Jericho, and Bethlehem.

The settlers also stole 10 cows in the villages of Jenin and 80 sheep in Hebron, burned Palestinian vehicles, and carried out activities aimed at building settlement outposts in each of the areas. A priest was appointed to expand the “Sidi Bozaid” settlement and build a road in the area of a church in the village of Husan in



Bethlehem, and other various settlement activities.

The Israeli occupation forces also demolished 16 homes in al-Quds, Tulkarm, Jericho, Nablus, and Bethlehem, while settlers burned two homes in Hebron. The Israeli forces also demolished a café and two sheep barns in Nablus and Hebron, and confiscated a truck transporting building materials in Jericho, along with two bulldozers and a truck in Jenin.

These actions bring the total number of Israeli violations and crimes against Palestinians over the aforementioned period to 1,755, violations ranging from murdering Palestinians to closing roads leading to their villages.

## **Israel Makes the Catastrophic Conditions in Gaza a “De Facto Policy” Israeli Occupation Forces Demolish 23 Homes and 4 Shops in the West Bank**

Israel is working to make the catastrophic situation in the Gaza Strip a “de facto policy” engaging in a regular, coordinated daily act that it imposes with regular brutality that has increased with its military aggression against the Gaza Strip. The Israeli occupation forces are also committing the same crimes more than once, periodically and simultaneously, under many pretexts to apply continuous pressure on cities and villages of the West Bank. Measuring daily crimes over the past period shows a special, agreed-upon arrangement, taking place with clear cooperation and coordination between the Israeli forces and Israeli settlers. During the period from 9 to 15 July 2024, the Organization of Islamic Cooperation Media Observatory documented 23 massacres, the most prominent of which was in a camp for displaced people in the Al-Mawasi area, the Abu Oreiban School in Nuseirat in central Gaza, and a prayer hall in the al-Shatee refugee camp, west of Gaza, in addition to those killed in the Shujaiya neighborhood. The toll of murdered and wounded during this period marked the highest during the month of July 2024, which reflects a steady pace of deliberate mass killings since the start of the Israeli war, which affects the displaced people in places that Israel described as safe. The number of murdered for this week reached 474 and 1,287 wounded. From October 7, 2023, to July 14, 2024, the total number of murdered reached 39,158.

Palestinian sources reported that Israeli forces destroyed more than 85% of the residential buildings in the Shujaiya neighborhood, which had become a disaster area unfit for habitation.

Along with the direct genocide, United Nations human rights experts noted that famine spread throughout the Gaza Strip, with widespread deaths among children due to chronic malnutrition.

In occupied al-Quds, what was initially an exceptional and isolated incident—the storming of the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque—has now become routine and daily behavior for extremists and the Israeli occupation forces. The toll of crimes also increases by category at specific times and concurrently across multiple villages and cities in the West Bank.

Over the aforementioned period, the settlers burned agricultural lands and trees owned by Palestinians in the villages of Hebron, Ramallah, Jenin, Nablus, and Tubas. The occupation forces and settlers also bulldozed agricultural lands and fruit trees in the villages of Jericho, Salfit, Nablus, Ramallah, and Tulkarm, in addition to burning and destroying 7 farmsteads, rooms, and agricultural barns in both Hebron and Ramallah, as well as, uprooting 120 fruit trees in Hebron and bulldozing dozens of dunams bearing fruit trees.

The Israeli forces simultaneously confiscated chemical fertilizers from commercial stores in Ramallah, Tulkarm, Qalqilya, Salfit, Jericho, and Hebron.

In the hot summer, when the need for water increases, settlers damaged water valves supplying villages west of Nablus, and a water line supplying the village of “Umm Al-Khair” in Hebron. The Israeli forces also confiscated a well rig and destroyed an artesian well in Tubas.

In terms of direct commercial damage, the Israeli occupation forces destroyed a building materials store and a car lubricant shop in Bethlehem, demolished a horse stable in Jericho, and a school in Hebron, and confiscated a lathe in the same city. They burned a bulldozer and confiscated others in Nablus.

The number of settler attacks during July 9-15, 2024 reached 44 attacks that included various cities in the West Bank, in addition to multiple settlement activities, the most prominent of which was the confiscation of 65 dunums to build a settlement outpost in Nablus, and the confiscation of 1.7 dunums in Salfit in order to supply water to the “Novim” settlement close to the Palestinian village of “Deir Istiya”. The Israelis also bulldozed cultivated lands to extend sewage pipes to the “Ammanuel” settlement and erected 5 caravans, a settlement room, and a tent on the land of the “Irtas” village and the villages of Hebron and “Jaba’at” to establish settlement outposts.

The occupation forces also closed the only open roof in the Ibrahimi Mosque in the city of Hebron in order

to restrict worshippers.

The Israeli occupation forces demolished 23 houses in al-Quds, Bethlehem, Tulkarm, Nablus, Qalqilya, Jericho, and Hebron. They also forcibly seized two houses in the Old City of Hebron, while the number of Israeli violations and crimes during the period documented by the OIC's Observatory reached 2542 crimes in one week, from various categories, ranging from blocking roads to acts of genocide.

## **Israel Defies the UN and Bombs Displaced People in Schools in Daily Massacres and Confiscating, Destroying and Burning (372) Vehicles and (199) Shops in the West Bank**

The number of Palestinians murdered between 16 and 22 July 2024 reached (345) people, while (733) others were injured. The murdered toll from 7 October 2023 to 21 July 2024 reached (39,561) murdered people while the Israeli occupation forces continue to commit massacres in the Gaza Strip in order to turn it into a daily hell, especially with their targeting of schools where the displaced in the Gaza Strip are sheltering. The number of Israeli massacres in Gaza, according to the Organization of Islamic Cooperation Media Observatory of Israel's Crimes against the Palestinians in the aforementioned period, reached (23) and dozens were murdered in 4 massacres committed last week which targeted schools, most of which belong to the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA). UNRWA Commissioner, Felipe Lazzarini, revealed that Israel bombed at least 8 schools in Gaza in 10 days, 6 of which belong to UNRWA, and also targeted 70% of the total UNRWA schools in Gaza, at a time when the Israeli Knesset approved considering UNRWA a "terrorist organization" and withdrew the immunity granted to it. This action is not only a restriction on UN agencies, but also a deprivation of Palestinian refugees of their educational, health, and living rights.

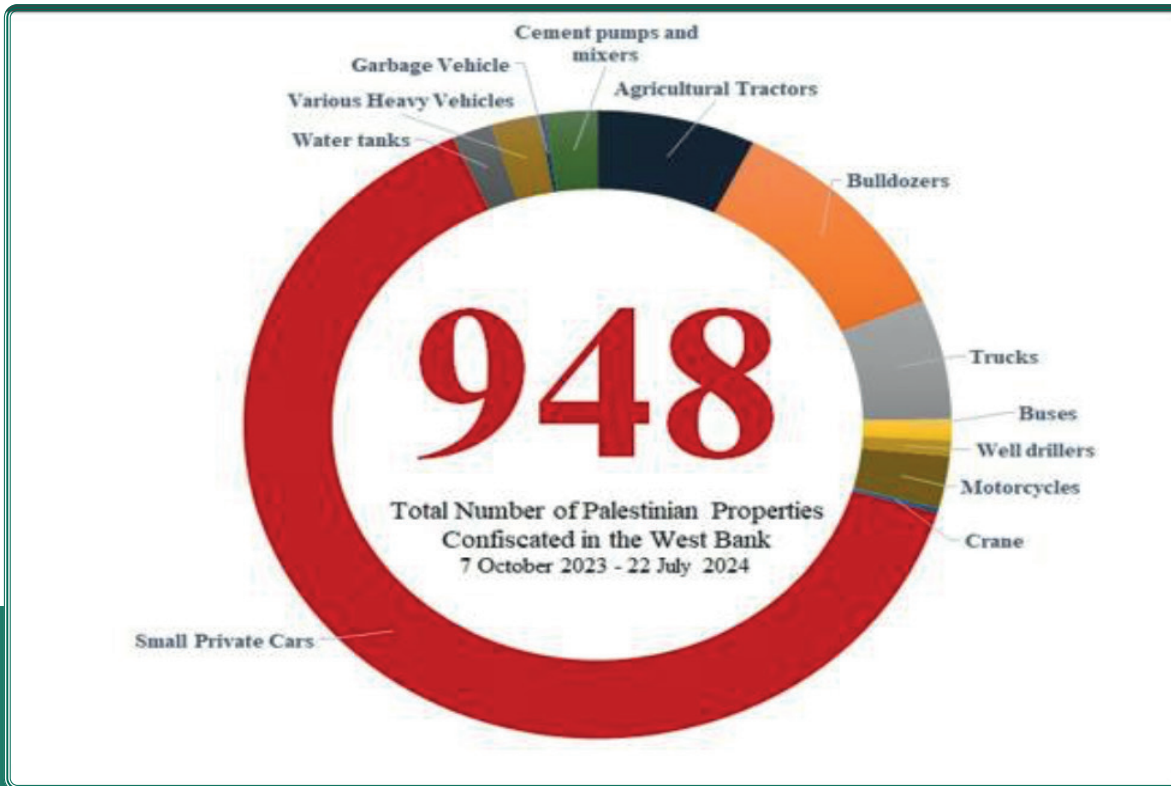
The Israeli occupation forces demolished 8 homes in addition to a 3-story building in al-Quds, Nablus, and Hebron. Settlers also seized a house in al-Quds and expelled its residents. Israel confiscated 441 dunums in the villages of Ramallah in favor of building settlements, while settlers set up mobile homes and tents to seize lands near the village of Kafr al-Dik to expand the Beduel settlement, and others placed a fence around land they had previously seized in the town of Bani Naim in Hebron.

During the aforementioned period Israeli forces detained (118) Palestinians in the West Bank, while Jewish extremists carried out almost daily raids on the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque, and the total number of extremists who stormed the mosque during this period reached (1,347) people. Settlers also attacked Palestinian towns and villages in Salfit, al-Quds, Nablus, Hebron, Ramallah and Tubas more than 35 times, during which they burned and bulldozed Palestinian agricultural lands and carried out other attacks. The Israeli policy of thirsting the villages of the West Bank continues, as the occupation forces destroyed a water well in the village of Birin in Hebron, a water collection well west of Hebron too, and an artesian well in Jericho, while the settlers tried to seize a water canal in the Auja Spring in Jericho to prevent the Palestinians from supplying water, and occupation forces confiscated water tanker in Ramallah.

In terms of commercial harm to the Palestinian individual, both the Israeli forces and settlers attacked (984) times Palestinian properties, either by burning, confiscating, or destroying it, including confiscating, burning, or destroying (372) light and heavy vehicles in various cities in the West Bank and al-Quds, starting on 7 October 2023 until 22 July 2034. They also demolished and confiscated (199) commercial facilities. The number of private vehicles that were destroyed or confiscated reached (237) cars during the mentioned period, in addition to (42) bulldozers, (27) agricultural tractors, (23) trucks, and a number of various heavy vehicles. The total number of Israeli violations and crimes last week reached (1,583) crimes and violations in various Palestinian areas.



## Israel is Waging a Double War on Gaza and International Organizations The Occupation Forces Demolish Dozens of Homes and Facilities in the West Bank



Israel is waging a war on international organizations in parallel with its war on Gaza, which completed its ninth month at the end of July 2024. A list can be drawn up of settler attacks on aid convoys for the people of Gaza and the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA)'s headquarters in al-Quds, in addition to the Israeli Knesset's decision to consider the (UNRWA) a terrorist organization. The Executive Director of UNICEF indicated that at least 278 relief workers were murdered in the Gaza Strip, others were injured, and other workers were prevented from performing their work.

During the period running from 23 to 29 July 2024, (24) massacres were committed, the most severe cases of which was (30) murdered and more than (100) others were injured in the bombing of the Khadija School in Deir al-Balah, which is considered the most crowded school with displaced people.

The OIC's media observatory for Israel's crimes against the Palestinians recorded (371) murdered Palestinians during the aforementioned period, and (1,159) others were injured, while the murdered toll from 7 October 2023 until 29 July amounted to (39,324).

Israel has not only been committing daily crimes of genocide, but has also deliberately exhausted Palestinian civilians and pushed them to move from one area to another, constantly on the run. The UN Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA) reported that 9% of the population of the Gaza Strip were displaced during the past week alone due to the orders of the occupation forces, while the Commissioner-General of UNRWA, Philippe Lazzarini, said that 86% of the people of the Gaza Strip are frequently subjected to Israeli evacuation orders.

This miserable situation has worsened with the Palestinian Ministry of Health announcing that the Gaza Strip has become an area infected with polio.

In the West Bank and al-Quds, 14 Palestinians were murdered in the last quarter of July, and Jewish extremists stormed the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque on an almost daily basis, while herds of settlers attacked Palestinian villages and towns 41 times in one week. The occupation forces arrested (164) Palestinians during the same period.

During this period, the Israeli occupation forces demolished (22) Palestinian homes in neighborhoods in occupied al-Quds, Bethlehem, Tulkarm, Hebron, and Jericho. A wedding hall, two commercial offices, and a livestock barn were also demolished in al-Quds, in addition to barns and other commercial facilities in Jericho. Settlers also burned two vehicle sheds in Nablus and Hebron, and a number of barracks, while commercial shops in the Ain al-Loza neighborhood in the town of Silwan in al-Quds are at risk of demolition under the pretext of lack of licenses.

The occupation forces bulldozed streets in the Nour Shams camp in Tulkarm, Qalqilya, and Salfit, and agricultural lands in Bethlehem. The settlers also burned agricultural lands in Nablus and Ramallah, uprooted grape trees, and stole 45 heads of cows from Palestinian shepherds in Tubas, while (6) vehicles were seized including a bulldozer, a roller, two special vehicles and other equipment.

In terms of land confiscation and illegal settlement activities, the Israeli forces confiscated 1.3 dunams in the village of Sebastia in Nablus to establish a military facility, built a settlement road in Wadi Salman in al-Quds, and settlers established a settlement outpost in Ramallah. While the total number of Israeli crimes and violations during the last week of July reached (2,354) crimes of various types in various Palestinian areas.

## 40,229 Palestinians were Murdered in 300 days

### Demolition of 22 Homes, Commercial Facilities, and Barns, Bulldozing and Burning of Agricultural Lands in the West Bank



According to statistics from the Organization of Islamic Cooperation Media Observatory for the Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians, the number of murdered Palestinians by the Israeli occupation forces during the period July 30 – August 05, 2024, reached 273 people, while 587 Palestinians were injured during the past week.

The number of massacres committed by the Israeli occupation forces, as part of the ongoing crimes of genocide in the Gaza Strip reached 16. These attacks have repeatedly targeted schools, as their shells hit the Malaysian School in the Nuseirat Camp, Hamama School in Gaza City, and Hassan Salama School in Sheikh Radwan neighborhood, bringing the number of schools that have been targeted to 152 since the beginning of the Israeli aggression on October 7, 2023. In addition to targeting schools, hospitals have also been targeted, with occupation forces bombarding the vicinity of Shuhada'a Al-Aqsa Hospital. The total number of Palestinians murdered by the fire of the Israeli occupation forces has exceeded 40,000 since that date until August 5, 2024, reaching 40,229 across the Gaza Strip, the West Bank, and occupied al-Quds over nearly 300 days.

In the West Bank, the Israeli occupation forces murdered 13 Palestinians and arrested 161 others. The number of raids on the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque in occupied al-Quds reached 5 raids, involving 2,253 Jewish extremists who roamed the courtyards of Al-Aqsa Mosque during the mentioned period. The occupation forces demolished 10 homes in al-Quds, Hebron, Ramallah, and Jericho, in addition to 8 commercial establishments in al-Quds, Hebron, and Salfit. They also destroyed a water well in Nablus, and 3 barns and agricultural rooms in Nablus and al-Quds, while settlers burned residential tents in Ramallah.

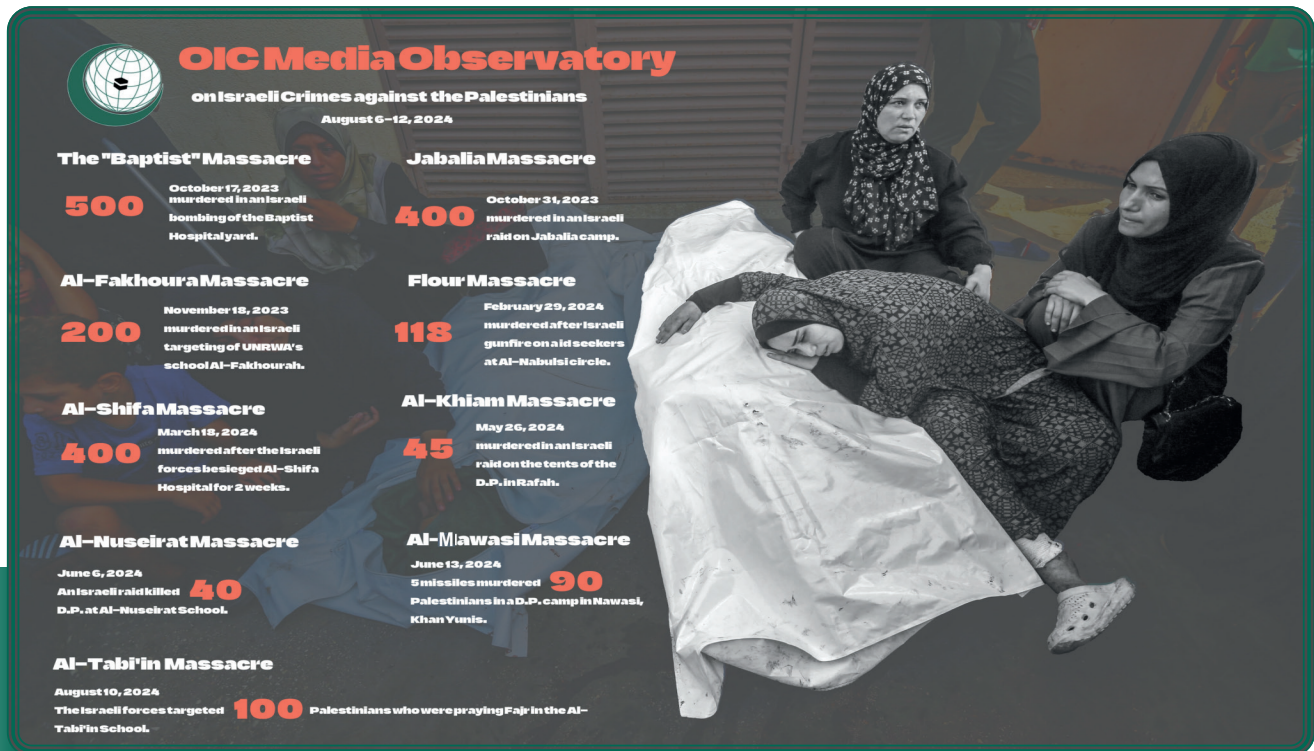
The Israeli occupation forces bulldozed agricultural lands in Beit Safafa in occupied al-Quds for settlement purposes and further bulldozed agricultural lands and trees in Hebron. Settlers also burned agricultural lands and trees in Ramallah, Qalqilya, and Nablus. The occupation forces and settlers also uprooted and



burned more than 215 olive and fig trees in Salfit and Hebron, and confiscated and burned 4 cars in Jenin, Ramallah, and Hebron. The total number of attacks committed by settler gangs in the Palestinian villages and towns in the West Bank has reached about 29 attacks, which included closing roads, assaulting Palestinians, and shooting and throwing stones at them. The occupation forces confiscated about 8,000 square meters of land in the village of Iskaka in Salfit in order to build the settlement of “Tofim Hanya”. The number of crimes and violations committed by the Israeli occupation forces and settlers reached 628 crimes over the past week.

## From Jabalia to Al-Tabi'in: 9 Major Massacres Kill 40,519 Palestinians in the Midst of the Aggression

### The Israeli Army and Settlers Demolish Homes, Burn Lands, and Steal Property in the West Bank



The Israeli occupation army committed one of the bloodiest massacres in the Gaza Strip, killing more than 100 Palestinians and wounding over 150 others in a direct bombardment targeting Al-Tabi'in School in the Al-Daraj neighborhood of central Gaza. The bombing occurred while the displaced individuals were performing the Fajr prayer in the school's prayer hall.

Accordingly, UNICEF confirmed that more than half of the schools used as shelters for the displaced in the Gaza Strip had been targeted.

It is noteworthy that Israel had committed numerous massacres, including at the Baptist Hospital on October 17, 2023, where 500 people were murdered, and in a residential neighborhood in Jabalia Camp on October 31, 2023, where 400 were murdered, in addition to 200 murdered in the Al-Fakhoura School affiliated with UNRWA on November 18, 2023. The ugliness of the Israeli genocide crimes was evident in the “flour” massacres that murdered 118 people in the Nabulsi circle on November 29, 2024, as well as, the Al-Shifa Hospital massacre on March 18, 2024, the burning of the displaced people's tents in the city of Rafah, which murdered 45 displaced people on May 26, 2024, and Al-Nuseirat School Camp massacre on June 6, 2024, which murdered 40 displaced people, along with the Al-Nawasi Camp massacre for displaced people in Khan Yunis on June 13, 2024, which was subjected to 5 Israeli missiles that murdered 90 Palestinians. According to the OIC Media Observatory for Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians for the period between August 6-12, 2024, the number of Palestinians murdered by Israeli fire during the past week reached 290, while 735 others were wounded. The total number of murdered by Israeli fire from October 7, 2023, until August 12, 2024, in the Gaza Strip, the West Bank, and occupied al-Quds, reached about 40,519. Meanwhile, the UN has reported that about two-thirds of the buildings in the Gaza Strip have been either completely destroyed or damaged since the start of the Israeli aggression on Gaza, according to satellite images.

In the West Bank, the Israeli occupation forces murdered 16 Palestinians and arrested 153 others during the past seven days, while they demolished 7 homes in Jenin, al-Quds, Bethlehem, and Hebron. The blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque was subjected to almost daily incursions, the number of perpetrators of which reached (2090) Israeli extremists.

Settler gangs raided villages and towns in the West Bank about 51 times, during which they burned agricultural lands in the towns of Ramallah, Nablus, and Bethlehem, and grazed their sheep, and destroyed Palestinian crops and trees in the villages of Bethlehem. Settlers stole solar cells, an electricity complex, and the contents of homes in Tubas. They also bulldozed an area of 6,000 square meters of agricultural land between the villages of Yasuf and Iskaka in Salfit and uprooted 100 olive trees in order to expand the Israeli settlement of “Novi Hamaya” and set up their tents there. The Israeli forces also bulldozed agricultural lands in order to pave an agricultural road to the same settlement. Settlers in the Al-Hayman area near the Palestinian town of Yatta placed a fence around a plot of land in order to seize it. The occupation forces bulldozed the lands surrounding the “Rahalim” settlement with the aim of expanding it, while the Israeli occupation forces also bulldozed 3 circles, streets, a water network, fences for Palestinians and vehicles in Jenin and destroyed public property and commercial stalls. They demolished 2 water wells and destroyed a vehicle in Hebron, confiscated a bulldozer, and destroyed 2 commercial facilities in al-Quds. Overall, the number of Israeli crimes and violations reached 1880 crimes in 7 days, ranging in severity and distributed across the Gaza Strip, the West Bank, and al-Quds.

## **Israel's settlement activity in the West Bank doubled by 11 times in a week Israel's occupation forces kill and injure (894) Palestinian Civilians in Gaza in 7 days**

During August 13-19, 2024, the Israeli occupation forces systematically bombed civilian areas, particularly those populated by the displaced, killing 257 Palestinians, mostly women and children, and injuring 637 in the Gaza Strip and the West Bank. This raised the total number of fatalities since the beginning of the Israeli aggression on the Gaza Strip until August 17, 2024, to 40,707 Palestinians. Last week, the Israeli occupation forces conducted airstrikes in Deir al-Balah, wiping out entire families and homes in the Nuseirat and Maghazi refugee camps, as well as in Az-Zawayda and other areas where the displaced took refuge.

In recent developments, there have been numerous instances of settlement activities in the West Bank and the occupied city of Al-Quds, including the construction of a settlement road between the villages of Yasuf and Iskaka in Salfit, excavation work for a new settlement outpost in Jericho, and the expansion of the Rahalim settlement in the villages of Nablus through the bulldozing of agricultural lands. Additionally, settlers have erected tents and mobile homes in the Jamjoum area, Al-Minya village in Bethlehem, and Tubas villages with the intention of establishing settlement outposts. In the village of Qaryut in Nablus, lands were bulldozed to expand the settlements of Eli and Shilo. Moreover, settlers have closed and fenced off a dirt road in Nab' Al-Ghazal in the northern Jordan Valley and restored the ancient Ma'in water well east of Yatta in Hebron, where Talmudic rituals were performed to signify its seizure.

The occupation forces have also confiscated 338 dunums of land in Beit Jala and Battir for the expansion of the Nahal Heletz settlement and another 18 dunums of land each in the villages of Bani Hassan and Haris in Salfit.

In the occupied Al-Quds, the occupying forces demolished structures, including barns, a gas station, commercial stores, a horse stable, a shed, and a car wash to make way for the construction of a settlement road in the area. Settlers also seized a building of five apartments in the Silwan neighborhood, claiming that it was built on “Jewish” land. The occupation forces also demolished 14 houses in Al-Quds, Ramallah, Hebron, and Nablus, while settlers burned 4 houses in the villages of Qalqilya.

During the past week, the occupation forces killed 13 Palestinians in the West Bank, arrested 140, demolished livestock pens in Beit Dajan in Nablus and Jenin, and commercial facilities, caravans, tents, water tanks, solar energy units, and water networks in Yatta, a solar energy room in the Arab Al-Malihah community in Jericho, bulldozed a building materials store, and confiscated a private vehicle and two cement mixers in Salfit and Jenin, and sums of money and gold jewelry in Qalqilya and Ramallah.




There were a total of 44 attacks by settlers, including the theft of sheep in Tubas and a water tank in Bethlehem, as well as the destruction of six vehicles in the villages of Qalqilya. Additionally, water sources in the village of Al-Auja in Jericho were targeted, and there were incidents of arson on agricultural lands and pastures and deliberate uprooting of fruit trees in the villages of Tulkarm, Tubas, Bethlehem, Salfit, and Hebron.



On the other hand, the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque witnessed 5 consecutive incursions during the same period, the most prominent of which was a group of extremist settlers led by Itamar Ben-Gvir, the extremist Israeli Minister of National Security, and the Yitzhak Wasserlauf, Minister for the Development of the Periphery, the Negev, and the Galilee. They stormed the blessed Al-Aqsa under the protection of the occupation police, performed Talmudic rituals, and made provocative tours in the courtyards of the mosque. The number of crimes and violations from August 13-19, 2024, totaled 1728 in the Gaza Strip, the West Bank, and occupied Al-Quds. These incidents included killings, injuries, arrests, demolitions, and raids.


## 296 Murdered in Gaza in 7 Days and a Total of 41081 Since October 7 Critical Escalation at the Al-Aqsa Mosque and Increased Pace of Settlement Activities in the West Bank August 27, 2024

The number of Palestinians murdered by the fire of the Israeli occupation forces in the past week reached 306, 296 of whom were murdered in the Gaza Strip, and 10 in the West Bank. Since October 7, 2023, the total number of Palestinians murdered has reached 41081.

According to statistics from the Organization of Islamic Cooperation Media Observatory for the Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians for the period between 20-26 August 2024, 922 Palestinians were wounded in Gaza and the West Bank, while 129 Palestinians were detained in the West Bank and al-Quds. On the other hand, 60 media and human rights organizations, including Reporters without Borders, have urged the European Union to suspend its cooperation agreement with Israel and impose sanctions on it, due to its continued murdering of journalists in the Gaza Strip.

With regard to developments in the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque, the mosque has been subjected to almost daily raids, at a time when Israel has announced its intention to make these raids regular. The official Israeli Broadcasting Authority revealed that the Israeli government will finance the Jewish settlers' raids on Al-Aqsa Mosque with 545,000 US dollars, amidst ongoing condemnation of the extremist Israeli Minister Itamar Ben Gvir, who has threatened to build a Jewish synagogue in the courtyards of the mosque. With regard to the demolitions of homes and facilities in the West Bank and al-Quds, the Israeli occupation forces demolished 10 homes in Wadi al-Joz and the town of Anata in al-Quds, in Bethlehem, Tulkarm camp, and the village of Khirbat al-Misbah in Ramallah, and in Nablus. Settlers burned a house in the Birin area in Hebron. The occupation forces also demolished infrastructure and streets in Tubas, Tulkarm camp, and Balata camp in Nablus. They also removed a gymnasium club, a car repair shop, and a commercial store in the Wadi al-Joz neighborhood in al-Quds, a supermarket in Tulkarm camp, and a mall in Balata camp in Nablus, in addition to demolishing a number of barns and sheds in Ramallah. The occupation forces also

confiscated two bulldozers in Hebron and Jenin, a cement mixer in Jenin, and confiscated a car and bombed another in Tulkarm. Settlers also seized a bulldozer in Beit Dajan in Nablus and an agricultural tractor in the town of Yatta in Hebron. Settlers burned and bulldozed agricultural lands in the villages of Salfit, Bethlehem, and Hebron. They attacked Palestinian vehicles and smashed their windows in the Old City of Hebron, the town of Beit Kahil, the village of Susya near the city itself, and the village of Rojeib in Nablus. They also stole water from the village of Al-Auja in Jericho by diverting the course of the village spring. Over the past week, settlers raided Palestinian villages 39 times. There were six settlement activities in the West Bank, represented by settlers placing a fence around the land in Wadi Al-Maleh in the northern Jordan Valley with the intention of seizing it, while the occupation forces bulldozed agricultural lands near a settlement outpost north of the village of Deir Istiya. Settlers set up settlement tents in the village of Al-Minya in Bethlehem in an attempt to seize Palestinian lands. Others tried to build a settlement outpost in Beit Furik in Nablus, and settlers set up tents near Mount Qarnatal in Jericho in an attempt to build a settlement outpost as well. The occupation forces also bulldozed land with the aim of paving and expanding a dirt settlement road in the area. Finally, the number of crimes and violations committed by the occupation forces and settlers during the mentioned period amounted to 1936.

## **Israel Targets Shelters for the Displaced Persons in Gaza and Murders 351 Palestinians in 7 Days**

### **The Israeli Forces Launch a Military Operation in the West Bank, Murdering and Wounding 111 People**

**September 3, 2024**

The Gaza Strip and the West Bank witnessed a major Israeli escalation, as noted in the Media Observatory of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation on Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians noted in its weekly report from August 27 to September 2, 2024. The report indicates that 388 people were murdered, and 757 were injured in 19 massacres concentrated in Deir al-Balah, al-Zeitoun neighborhood, al-Qastal neighborhood, and al-Maghazi camp. The number of murdered since October 7, 2023 has reached 41,081.

The Israeli military machine intensified its bombing operations, which mainly targeted areas and shelters for the displaced persons in the Gaza Strip. It bombed a school housing displaced people in Deir al-Balah, the Baptist Hospital in Gaza City, Safad School in the Zeitoun neighborhood, and a factory housing displaced people in Khan Yunis, in addition to areas in the Bureij camp. Additionally, journalist Mohammed Abd Rabbo was murdered in Deir al-Balah as a result of an Israeli raid, bringing the number of journalists murdered by the fire of the occupation forces to 172. The Israeli forces forced Palestinian families and civilians, numbering 250,000 to leave Deir al-Balah in the central Gaza Strip as part of large displacement campaigns, while 25 shelters went out of service after Israel expanded the Netzarim corridor that splits the Gaza Strip into two. Residents of three neighborhoods in Deir al-Balah were shocked to find their homes completely destroyed after the occupation forces allowed them to return.

On the other hand, the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) called for a humanitarian truce to facilitate a polio vaccination campaign in Gaza, while 160,000 children received vaccines amid very poor conditions.

On another level, the cities and towns of the West Bank witnessed an unprecedented Israeli escalation since October 7, 2023. An Israeli military campaign has begun concentrating in the Palestinian camps, during which 36 Palestinians were murdered and 75 others were injured.

The occupation forces bombed homes and vehicles in the Nour Shams camp in Tulkarm, the village of Seir in Jenin, the Far'a camp, and Tubas. They also bulldozed and demolished streets and infrastructure in addition to 37 homes and facilities.

Over the past week, Israel demolished three homes in Al-Quds, four in Jenin, one in Jericho, and one in Tulkarm in addition to burning four homes in Tulkarm. The occupation forces destroyed a car wash and a car showroom in Wadi al-Joz in Al-Quds, a building materials store in the village of Husan in Bethlehem, car repair shops in the Nour Shams camp in Tulkarm and barns in Jericho, Hebron, and Tubas.

The Israeli forces also confiscated a cement pump, a private vehicle, an excavator, and a truck in the villages of Hebron, and bulldozed agricultural lands in Kharbatha al-Misbah in Ramallah. The West Bank and Al-Quds witnessed seven settlement activities, as settlers established a settlement outpost in the Khan al-Ahmar area in Al-Quds, and the occupation forces paved roads on Palestinian lands in the KHALLET THABET area in Bethlehem for settlement purposes. Settlers set up a tent on a plot of land east of Burin village, in



preparation for its seizure. Settlers also seized an area estimated at 150 dunums of agricultural land owned by Palestinians in the Khirbet al-Farisiya area in the northern Jordan Valley. Settlers near the “Karmeit Tsur” settlement north of the town of Halhul in Hebron seized an area of citizens’ land and prevented its owners from accessing it. In addition, the settlers east of the town of Beit Furik in Nablus expelled Palestinians in an attempt to seize their land. The settlers also bulldozed an area of Palestinian land in the Khirbet al-Qat area located adjacent to the “Karmeit Tsur” settlement in Hebron, where settlers carried out 54 raids during the past seven days. These crimes ranged from killing and wounding Palestinians, demolishing mobile homes and water tanks, and stealing 550 heads of sheep in the town of Sa’ir in Hebron and the town of Aqraba in Nablus, in addition to dismantling and burning of six pens in the village of Bani Na’im in Hebron, uprooting olive trees and vegetable seedlings, and destroying an irrigation network in the town of Nahalin in Bethlehem. The settlers also grazed their livestock on Palestinian agricultural lands, with the intention of destroying them. The number of Israeli crimes at various levels during the period documented by the OIC’s Observatory amounts to 2,143 crimes and violations across the Gaza Strip, the West Bank, and Al-Quds.

## 2046 attacks by settlers on West Bank villages since October 7, and foreign activists on the list of victims Ramallah, September 8, 2024

Israeli violations target Palestinians and foreign activists who show solidarity with them, and the latter are subjected to harassment by the Israeli occupation forces that amount to crimes. The Media Observatory of Israeli Crimes against Palestinians of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC), documented several violations, the most prominent of which was the killing of the American-Turkish activist Aysinur Ece.

On September 6, 2024, the occupation forces murdered the activist Aysinur with a direct bullet to the head, which led to her immediate death, while she was participating in a peaceful march against settler attacks in the village of Beita in Nablus.

On September 5, 2024, a number of settlers also attacked a foreign activist by spraying pepper gas in his face, causing him to suffocate, while he was confronting settlers who had attacked a Palestinian family in the Al-Faw area in the northern Jordan Valley in Tubas.

On August 22, 2024, settlers attacked three foreign activists, including a French journalist, while they were participating in a peaceful march in Beit Jala against settler raids on Palestinian villages.

A foreign journalist named Brendan Raines was also beaten by settlers in the town of Al-Auja in the Jericho and Jordan Valley Governorate while documenting settlers’ attacks on water sources in the town.

It is worth noting that the murder of Aysenor is not the first crime committed by the occupation forces, as

activist Rachel Corrie was also murdered under the wheels of an Israeli bulldozer when she confronted the demolition of a Palestinian family's home in the city of Rafah in the Gaza Strip on March 6, 2003, during the outbreak of the Second Intifada.

These Israeli crimes come in succession to basically prevent journalists from carrying out the tasks of documenting the crimes of the occupation, limiting the wave of foreign sympathy with the Palestinian people, and intimidating activists to prevent them from reaching the Palestinian villages that are being attacked by settlers, the number of which since October 7, 2023, until September 7, 2024, reached 2046 attacks that affected most of the villages and towns of the West Bank and occupied al-Quds.

September 17-23, 2024

Over the past seven days, the occupation forces murdered 213 Palestinians in both the Gaza Strip and the West Bank. The OIC Media Observatory on Israeli Crimes against Palestinians monitored the wounding of 647 Palestinians during the period between September 3-9, 2024, bringing the number of murdered since October 7, 2023 to 41,680 and the number of wounded to 100,525.

The occupation forces continue to restrict the polio vaccination campaign in the Gaza Strip, as they prevented, for the fifth time in a row, convoys from the United Nations and the World Health Organization from delivering medicines and fuel needed for the polio campaign and for therapeutic purposes in the Strip. On the other hand, the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) said that formal education is not available in any of its 200 schools in the Gaza Strip, as many of them are used as shelters



for the displaced, and that more than 600,000 students are deprived of formal education for another year. In the context of its hysterical military campaign in the West Bank camps, the Israeli occupation forces murdered 11 Palestinians over the period covered by the observatory's report, and arrested 188 others, while the occupation forces besieged, over the days that were monitored, the government hospital, Al-Israa Hospital, and other hospitals, and obstructed the movement of ambulances in each of the Nur Shams, Tulkarm, and Jenin camps. It also continued the systematic destruction of infrastructure, streets, shops, and service vehicles in the Nur Shams and Tulkarm camps in Tulkarm city and Balata in Nablus, in addition to Al-Far'a camp in Tubas, and the Burqin camp and Jenin camp in Jenin governorate.

The occupation forces stormed the Student Council headquarters at Birzeit University in Ramallah Governorate, and prevented worshippers from reaching the Ibrahimi Mosque in the Old City of Hebron in order to enable settlers to celebrate and perform Talmudic rituals inside the mosque.

Last week, the occupation forces demolished 11 houses in the governorates of Salfit, Jenin, Nablus, Tulkarm and Hebron, in addition to 4 apartments in Beit Hanina in occupied al-Quds. They also destroyed 7 agricultural pens in Nablus, Jericho and Hebron, burned two houses in Jenin and Tulkarm, and destroyed a number of houses built of brick and tin in Khirbet Qalqas in Hebron. Additionally, they destroyed two water wells in the town of Adh Dhahiriya in Hebron, confiscated 3 cars in the city and siezed 16 gas cylinders at the Tayasir checkpoint in Jericho.

The number of settler raids on Palestinian villages in the West Bank this week reached 46, which included burning agricultural lands in the villages of Al-Lubban Al-Sharqiya and Burqa in Nablus Governorate, and an olive farm in the town of Hizma in al-Quds, in addition to burning agricultural lands in villages in Qalqilya and Tulkarm Governorates. Settlers also burned a number of cars in the town of Deir Diwan in Ramallah Governorate, and a car in the village of Khirbet Abu Falah in Ramallah Governorate. Settlers cut down a number of olive and grape trees in the town of Yatta in Hebron Governorate, and damaged and stole the irrigation network and agricultural water tanks. They also attacked agricultural lands in Nablus, cut down a number of olive trees in the village of Khalayel Al-Loz, while others released their sheep on Palestinian lands in the town of Sinjil in Ramallah Governorate with the intention of destroying crops.

The number of settlement activities during the past week reached 7 activities represented in extending water lines on Palestinian lands in the village of Iskaka and establishing rooms, mobile homes and tents in the towns of Qusra and Al-Khader in addition to the summit of Jabal Al-Matl and Jabal Al-Qarantul. The settlers also continued their attempts to seize the Ma'in Beita water well in Hebron. Additionally, settlers forced two Palestinian families to leave the Wadi Al-Faw area in the northern Jordan Valley in Tubas, while another group bulldozed a plot of land in the village of Jinsafut with the aim of seizing it and annexing it to the "Emmanuel" settlement.

In total, the number of crimes, violations and attacks carried out by the Israeli army and settlers over the past week reached 1899 crimes and violations.

## **A Bloody Week Witnesses the Massacres of “Al-Mawasi” and “Al-Jaouni” and 250 Murdered in 7 Days**

### **184,293 Israeli Crimes since October 7 in Gaza, the West Bank and Al-Quds Jeddah, 17 September 2024**

The number of Palestinian murdered by Israel since October 7, 2023 - September 19, 2024, reached 41,931, while the number of those wounded stands at 101,113. In the Gaza strip alone, the Israeli occupation has murdered 41,226 Palestinians during the same period, with 95,413 wounded. The total number of crimes and violations by the Israeli occupation recorded by the Media Observatory of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation for Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians from October 7, 2023, until September 15, 2024, amounts to approximately 184,293 crimes.

The OIC’s observatory documented the total number of crimes against facilities from October 7, 2023, to September 15, 2024, including the demolition of 255 commercial facilities and 572 homes in the occupied West Bank and Al-Quds, while the number of attacks and confiscation of Palestinian property in the West Bank and Al-Quds amounted to 1231 times, including the confiscation of heavy vehicles and sums of money from individuals.

Between September 10-16, 2024, the OIC’s observatory documented 21 Israeli massacres in the Gaza Strip, resulting in the murder of 238 Palestinians, while the total number of Palestinian injured reached 621.

Notable incidents during the monitored week, include the Al-Mawasi massacre, in which 40 Palestinians were murdered and 60 wounded, following the bombing of a camp for displaced persons near the British Hospital in Khan Younis. Another significant event was the Al-Jaouni School massacre, affiliated with the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA), the fifth of its kind, on the school that shelters displaced persons in the Strip, in which 18 people were murdered by an Israeli attack. While UNRWA stated that, six of its employees were among those killed in the bombing.

While students in the Gaza Strip continue their second year without education, students in the West Bank face harassment and prevention by the Israeli authorities and settlers. The occupation forces closed the junction of the Al-Jiftlik village school in the Jericho governorate, and an armed settler in the Al-Ma’arjat area west of Jericho blocked the road leading to the Bedouin Al-Ka’abneh School in front of students. Settlers in the Imreiha area, located south of the town of Ya’bad in Jenin, assaulted a number of students, while the Israeli forces in the town of Al-Khader in Bethlehem stormed the That Al-Nitaqayn Girls’ School and defaced its walls with racist slogans. The occupation forces also raided the mosque in the village of Burin and detained a number of female students from a Quran memorization course.

In the West Bank, the OIC’s Observatory recorded the murdering of 12 Palestinians during the past week, in addition to the arrest of 195 others. The occupation forces continued their siege of hospitals and obstruction of ambulances in Tulkarm and Tubas. They also blew up Al-Salam Mosque in Tulkarm camp, raided Al-Sahaba Mosque in Nour Shams camp, and continued to bulldoze the infrastructure in Tulkarm camp, in addition to agricultural land adjacent to the town of Zeita in Tulkarm, and another in the village of Umm Al-Safa, as well as, uprooting a number of olive trees in the village of Deir Nizam in Ramallah.

During the past seven days, the occupation forces demolished 13 houses in the West Bank, burned six houses in Tulkarm, and seized another house and converted it into a military barracks in the town of Ni’lin in Ramallah. The Israeli forces also demolished a car wash and a car showroom in the Shuafat neighborhood and the village of Issawiya in occupied Al-Quds, and demolished four commercial facilities in the West Bank. Settlers also seized the Petra Hotel in Al-Quds and threw its furniture outside. The Israeli occupation army demolished commercial warehouses in the town of Tarqumiya in Hebron, and confiscated a bulldozer in Bethlehem, and settlers stole a private car in the town of Diwan in Ramallah.

The number of settler attacks over the past week reached 39 times, where they uprooted, cut down and burned 101 olive trees in the town of Kafr ad-Dik in Salfit and in the village of Burin in Nablus. They also cut off branches of olive trees, demolished two agricultural rooms, damaged water tanks and stone chains in the town of Jaba and the village of Beit Imrin in Jenin, and burned olive trees in the village of Yatma in Nablus.

Settlers also killed 81 sheep by poisoning them in the area of Al-Ma’arjat in Jericho, and they also poisoned cows in the area of Ein al-Hilweh in Tubas, and stole camels and sheep in the villages of Yatta and Khirbet Zanouta in Hebron and the village of Shaqba in Ramallah.

In order to establish a security belt to protect the settlements of “Yisthar” and “Karmiel”, the Israeli forces confiscated areas of land in the Hebron Governorate, consisting of 17,897 dunums of land from the villages



of Madama, Asira al-Qibliya, and Burin, and 767 square meters in the town of Yatta. Settlement activities in the West Bank this week occurred four times, concentrated in occupied Al-Quds, Nablus, and Tubas. The number of crimes and violations committed by the Israeli occupation forces over the period of September 10 to 16, 2024 totaled 1,844 crimes across the Gaza Strip, the West Bank, and occupied Al-Quds.

## Israel increases its crimes against the displaced in the Gaza Strip and the number of martyrs reaches 229

September 24-30, 2024

The Israeli occupation forces have intensified the frequency of their deliberate attacks on shelters for the displaced in the Gaza Strip between September 17-23, 2024, and the number of martyrs monitored by the OIC Media Observatory on Israeli Crimes against Palestinians has reached 229 murdered, while the number of Palestinian wounded has reached 501. The number of Palestinian murdered from October 7, 2023 to September 22, 2024 has reached 42,147, while the number of the wounded has reached 101,568.

September 22, 2024 witnessed the 181<sup>st</sup> massacre targeting a shelter center in the Gaza Strip, after targeting Al-Falah School in Al-Zeitoun neighborhood, which murdered 20 Palestinians, including a fetus. Within 72 hours, the occupation forces committed 12 massacres, killing 119 Palestinians and wounding 209, in addition to blowing up residential blocks in Rafah. Eight Palestinians were also murdered in an Israeli raid targeting Ibn Al-Haytham School in Al-Shuja'iyya neighborhood, east of Gaza, in addition to other

massacres in Deir Al-Balah, Al-Daraj neighborhood, and homes in eastern Al-Bureih that were housing dozens of Palestinians.

On the living level, media reports stated that the Gaza Strip is facing the highest inflation rate in the world, making it the most expensive place in the world in light of the scarcity of food commodities in the affected areas. In the context of their declared war on the media with the aim to conceal the crimes of genocide they are committing in Palestine, the occupation forces closed the Al Jazeera office in the city of Ramallah on September 22, 2024 by military order for a period of 45 days and confiscated equipment and documents, after raiding it in a flagrant violation of the lands subject to Palestinian sovereignty, and of freedom of the media.

In occupied Jerusalem, the occupation forces began laying the foundations for an escalator 200 meters from the Buraq Wall towards the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque in order to facilitate the storming of the mosque's courtyards by Jewish extremists.

The report from the organization's office in Ramallah indicated that the number of those who stormed the courtyards of the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque between September 22-16, 2024 was about 1,794 assailants. The occupation forces also demolished two houses in the Al-Mabker neighborhood and the village of Al-Issawiya in occupied Jerusalem, in addition to demolishing a number of commercial and agricultural facilities in the village of Sur Baher, and settlers seized a residential apartment in the Al-Tur neighborhood in Jerusalem.

In the West Bank, the number of martyrs reached 12, while the occupation forces arrested 197 Palestinians and demolished 4 homes in each of Khirbet Jbara in Tulkarm, Qabatiya in Jenin, and the town of Beit Awa in Hebron, where they also demolished an agricultural barn for equipment and sheep with an area of 1000 square meters and two agricultural rooms, in addition to demolishing an agricultural room in Nablus and a water well in the town of Yatta in Hebron, besides bulldozing an area of 6 dunams planted with olive trees in the town of Nahalin and the village of Husan. They also besieged school students inside their schools in the town of Qabatiya in Jenin, where they destroyed parts of the infrastructure, causing damage to property, and attacked ambulance crews in Nablus.

On another note, the occupation forces issued 3 decisions to confiscate 732,719 dunams of land from the villages of Tayasir and Bardala, and 6,712 dunams of land from the city of Tubas for settlement projects in order to expand the "Maskoyot" colony, in addition to confiscating 2,791 dunams of Tubas lands for the construction of a road linking the "Nahal Petronot" settlement outpost with Line 90, and issued a military order to confiscate 7,739 dunams of land from the town of Beit Lid in Tulkarm.

During their raid on Al-Fawar camp in Hebron, the occupation forces confiscated two printing presses, an agricultural tractor, and a garbage truck in the town of Idhna in Hebron, in addition to a bulldozer in the village of Atouf in the Tubas governorate.

The number of settler raids on towns and villages in the West Bank reached 37 during which settlers stormed a school in the Kaabneh Bedouin community west of Jericho, and attacked students and teachers. Others robbed a construction materials store and stole some of its contents, set fire to lands planted with olive trees in the village of Al-Mughayyir in Ramallah, and cut down olive trees in the village of Bardala in Tubas and Khalayel Al-Lawz in Bethlehem, while other settlers poisoned 5 sheep east of Hebron.

The number of Israeli crimes throughout the Palestinian territories reached 1484 crimes of various types in one week.



**66% of Gaza is destroyed, and coverage of Israeli crimes in the Strip are nearly absent from the media scene**

**Occupation forces evacuate Ibrahimi Mosque to allow the performance of Talmudic rituals**



The Israeli occupation forces have continued to strike safe havens in the Gaza Strip, murdering dozens of Palestinians. The total number of Palestinians murdered from September 24 to 30, 2024, has reached 171, according to the Media Observatory of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation on Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians.

The number of Palestinians murdered from October 7, 2023, to September 30, 2024, has reached 42,334, with 102,109 injured.

During the past seven days, the occupation army has targeted the tents housing the displaced persons west of the city of Deir al-Balah, and homes in the city of Khan Yunis. The OIC Observatory also documented the clear targeting of the displaced at Al-Faluja School in Jabalia camp, as well as Umm Al-Fahm and Abu Jaafar schools in Beit Lahia. A number of others were murdered in an Israeli bombardment of the displaced people's tents around Al-Aqsa Martyrs Hospital in Deir Al-Balah.

Meanwhile, the United Nations Satellite Center issued an assessment of the demolished buildings in the Gaza Strip, which showed that two-thirds of all the buildings in the Strip were damaged, totaling about 66%, and included 163,778 buildings, according to images collected on September 3-6, 2024. The UN indicated that 52,564 buildings were completely destroyed, 18,913 buildings were severely damaged,

35,591 buildings were possibly damaged, and 56,710 buildings were moderately damaged. According to the images, the Gaza Governorate was the most affected by the destruction.

On the other hand, the UN Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA) stated that it was unable to make adequate preparations for the rainy season in the Gaza Strip, due to the obstacles imposed by the Israeli occupation forces. At the same time, reports indicated that more than 90% of the population of the Gaza Strip had already been displaced from their homes during the ongoing Israeli aggression on Gaza. On another note, the OIC's Observatory noted the near-disappearance of the coverage of Israeli crimes in the Gaza Strip from the media scene.

In the West Bank and occupied Al-Quds, two Palestinians were murdered in Hebron and Jenin over the past week, while the occupation forces arrested 231 Palestinians.

Jewish extremists continued to storm the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque in occupied Al-Quds. Meanwhile, the occupation forces prevented members of the diplomatic corps accredited to the State of Palestine from entering the Ibrahimi Mosque in Hebron in order to hide the crimes committed by Israel.

The Israeli occupation forces also evacuated worshipers from the mosque to make way for Jewish settlers to perform their Talmudic rituals. They also prevented the dawn call to prayer at the mosque for 16 consecutive days as of the writing this report.

The occupation forces demolished nine homes in Al-Quds, Jericho, Hebron, Jenin, and Tubas, burned a home in Jenin camp, removed ten barns in Jenin and Hebron, destroyed a blacksmith workshop and confiscated its equipment in Qalqilya, and confiscated the contents of a grocery store as well.

They demolished five water collection wells and damaged water tanks in the town of Beit Ula in Hebron.

The occupation forces bulldozed streets and destroyed infrastructure in Jenin, besieged the government and Ibn Sina hospitals in Jenin, and searched ambulances at the government hospital. They bulldozed streets and infrastructure and damaged other shops during their raid on the Balata camp in Nablus.

The occupation forces also bulldozed an area estimated at about 20 dunams planted with about 600 olive trees in Hebron.

In the same context, the occupation forces issued a military order to confiscate eight dunams of Palestinian land in the village of Fasayil, in order to expand a new security road linking the "Tomer" settlement to Line No. 90 in Jericho. They also confiscated a bulldozer and a truck in Jenin.

The number of times settlers raided Palestinian villages and towns during the period of September 24-30, 2024, was 48 times, during which they burned and broke tree branches. There were five instances of settlement activities in the Palestinian territories during the same period, including bulldozing operations and attempts to seize Palestinian lands in Salfit, Nablus, Hebron, Bethlehem, and Ramallah. The toll number of crimes and violations committed by the occupation forces during the aforementioned period reached 1,622 across the occupied Palestinian territories.

## **The occupation forces occupy 11 homes and target the olive harvest season in the West Bank**

### **Gaza has been living under the burden of ongoing genocide crimes for a whole year without pause**

Despite the enormity of the situation last October, which resulted in the death of 8,653 martyrs in just 25 days, the bleak picture today, after a whole year, confirms that the Israeli crimes, despite a relative decline in daily killings, have not changed, but rather have increased and are characterized by a continuity that increases the impact of the genocide crimes committed by Israel. Here lies the danger in the situation of the Gaza Strip from October 7, 2023 until October 7, 2024, as it reflects an Israeli practice that does not face any international accountability.

While some believe that the situation in October 2023 was worse than the same month in 2024, the residents of the Gaza Strip continue to suffer from the accumulation of killings, displacement and humanitarian crises that have been going on for a whole year, compounded by the pressure of the scarcity of humanitarian aid and the ongoing displacement.

According to statistics from the Media Observatory of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation for Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians, the number of Palestinian martyrs in the whole year reached 42,654 martyrs, while the number of wounded reached 103,053.

In one year, the occupation forces exterminated 5,738 Palestinian families in the Gaza Strip, which confirms



that they committed unprecedented crimes of genocide. Among these, the number of families that were completely exterminated and did not leave a single member of them was 902 families, while 1,364 families were exterminated, leaving behind only one surviving member, and the number of families that were erased from the civil records, leaving behind two surviving members, was 3,472 families.

During the period from 1-7 October 2024, the occupation forces committed 30 massacres that killed 294 Palestinians and wounded 973 others in the Gaza Strip. The occupation forces targeted the displaced in the Muscat School in the Tuffah neighborhood, the Amal Institute for Orphans in the Rimal neighborhood, and a rehabilitation center for the disabled in the Jabalia camp, in addition to a school housing displaced people in Deir al-Balah, and the Al-Aqsa Martyrs Mosque, where Palestinian paramedics who recovered the bodies of the martyrs said that the bodies of children arrived with their heads cut off and that hospital workers struggled to match dismembered body parts.

The West Bank and occupied Jerusalem witnessed a bloody week, during which 22 martyrs fell and 40 were wounded, while the occupation forces arrested 227 Palestinians. An Israeli raid on a café in Tulkarm killed 18 Palestinians, including an entire family. The occupation forces bulldozed streets and infrastructure in the Nur Shams and Tulkarm camps and attacked medical teams there. Israel demolished two houses in Ein al-Duyuk, and notified the owners of seven other houses that their houses would be demolished soon. It also demolished seven commercial establishments in the Shuafat neighborhood in Jerusalem, and three agricultural barns in Beit Jala in Bethlehem.

In terms of violations against places of worship, the occupation forces prevented the Friday prayer call from the minarets of the Ibrahimi Mosque in the Old City of Hebron, and obstructed worshipers from reaching it, forcing them to pray in its courtyards. It also prevented the dawn call to prayer from its minarets for the 23rd consecutive time. The occupation forces demolished a wooden church and seized its contents in the Makhroun area in Beit Jala in Bethlehem.

Among the crimes monitored by the OIC Media Observatory, the Israeli army occupied 11 houses in the villages of Anin, Dahr al-Abed, Nazlat Sheikh Zeid, Ya'bad, and Faqu'a in Jenin, the Irtah suburb in Tulkarm, the villages of Jayyus and Hajja in Qalqilya, and the village of Harsa in Hebron, and converted them all into military barracks. The occupation forces also confiscated a private vehicle in Ramallah and a bulldozer in Nablus.

The Israelis, through the occupation forces and settlers, are working to disrupt the olive harvest season. During the period from October 1-7, 2024, the Israelis targeted the season either by preventing Palestinians from harvesting their crops, burning or destroying olive trees, and bulldozing agricultural lands in 16 villages in the West Bank.

During the mentioned period, settlers raided 41 villages in the West Bank, while some of them carried out settlement activities in the town of Dura in Hebron, and paved a road in lands near the "Shavei Shomron" settlement.

Thus, the number of Israeli crimes over the past week reached 2,352 crimes, while the total for the entire year reached 188,346 crimes.

## **Gaza students are unable to access education due to the ongoing bombardment of their schools, which also serve as shelters**

The Israeli aggression against the Gaza Strip has severely disrupted the education of students for the second consecutive year. According to the OIC Media Observatory for Israeli Crimes against Palestinians, approximately 360,000 students in the Gaza Strip are unable to attend school due to the destruction of educational facilities, displacement, and the conversion of schools into shelters for the displaced. Additionally, around 88,000 university students are also unable to continue their education for similar reasons. Over the course of one year, from October 07, 2023, to October 07, 2024, a tragic total of 10,558 school students and 667 university students in Gaza, as well as 79 school students and 35 university students in the West Bank, were killed by Israel. Furthermore, the number of injured students in the Gaza Strip has reached 34,015. This ongoing conflict continues to have devastating consequences for the education and well-being of students.

As for the educational staff, it is notable that 425 individuals involved in school education and 117 individuals involved in university education in the Gaza Strip were killed by the Israeli occupation forces. Additionally, 3,700 school and university staff in the Strip were wounded.

The Israeli military offensive in the Gaza Strip resulted in the complete destruction of 62 government schools and significant damage to 124 others. Additionally, 126 government schools and 65 United Nations

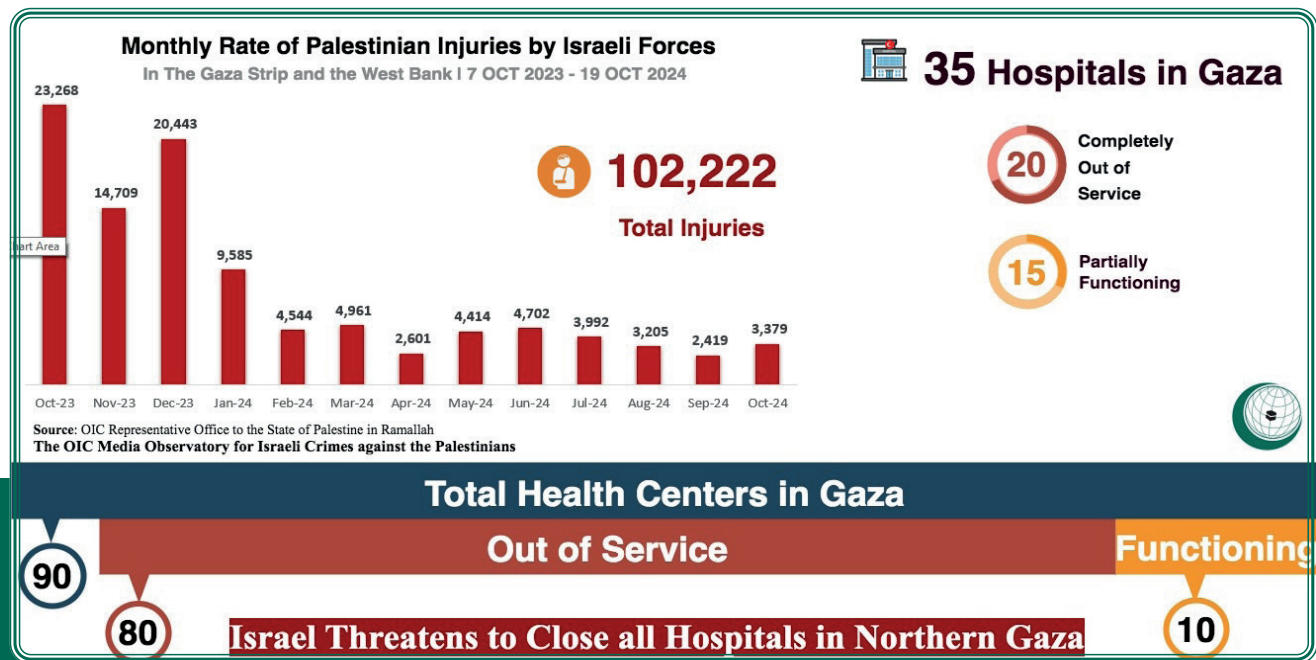
Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) schools were targeted. The attacks also led to the destruction of 35 university buildings, partial damage to 20 educational institutions, and harm to 57 university buildings.

During the specified period, 72 schools in the West Bank were subjected to vandalism, and 5 universities were forcefully entered by the Israeli occupying forces, leading to restrictions and interference with their academic activities. Additionally, the Israeli occupation forces, in collaboration with settlers, persist in obstructing access to schools in several Palestinian towns and villages, thereby targeting school students.

## Israel Targets olive harvest season in 46 villages in the West Bank and Al-Ibrahimi mosque is in the grip of settlers

## Israel isolates northern Gaza, threatens to evacuate hospitals, and begins a series of massacres and a starvation plan

Jeddah, October 15, 2024



Israel has intensified its crimes against civilians in the northern Gaza Strip, especially in the period between October 8-14, 2024. The Israeli occupation forces have isolated 400,000 Palestinians residing in the northern areas, preventing the entry of humanitarian aid to them and reinstated the Israeli starvation policy, as monitored by the Media Observatory of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation on Israeli crimes against the Palestinians.

This period coincided with intensive shelling of homes and tents, especially the burning of displaced people living in the vicinity of Al-Aqsa Martyrs Hospital in Deir al-Balah, which was targeted several times recently, in addition to Kamal Adwan Hospital in northern Gaza, which the occupation forces threatened to evacuate, along with the Indonesian Hospital and Al-Awda Hospital.

Jabalia camp was also subjected to siege and shelling, in addition to Rufaida School and the Girls' School in Jabalia, along with intensive shelling that targeted the remaining homes in those areas.

Palestinian sources in the Gaza Strip reported that there are 12,000 wounded people in need of urgent travel for treatment, 10,000 cancer patients facing the risk of death, and 3,000 patients with various chronic diseases who are deprived of treatment. Additionally, more than 1.5 million people are suffering from infectious diseases due to the conditions of displacement.

The health situation in the Gaza Strip is groaning under the weight of a full year of aggression, which has resulted in the closure of 20 hospitals (private and governmental) out of 35 hospitals, while the remaining 15 hospitals are operating partially, in addition to the exit of 80 health centers out of 90 from service. Furthermore, 130 ambulances were destroyed, in addition to the martyrdom of 1151 Palestinians, and the arrest of 310 others who work in the health sector according to statistics covering the period from October 7, 2023 to the end of September 2024.

The number of Palestinian martyrs over the period October 8-14, 2024, was 389 martyrs, while the number



of wounded was 1403, and the number of martyrs since October 7, 2023 - October 14, 2024, was 43043, and the wounded was 104934.

In the West Bank, the occupation forces arrested 245 Palestinians within a week, caused extensive damage to infrastructure and property in the Far'a camp in Tubas, demolished eight houses in Hebron and Salfit, occupied three others in Hebron and Tulkarm, and demolished five water pools in Nablus and Jenin.

The occupation authorities have ordered the confiscation of the land on which the headquarters of the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA) is located in the Sheikh Jarrah neighborhood, and converted it into a new settlement outpost comprising 1,440 housing units, in addition to lands belonging to the town of Kifl Haris. 10 dunums of agricultural land were bulldozed in Beit Ummar in Hebron.

Regarding the olive harvest season, the OIC Observatory documented that 46 Palestinian villages were subjected to continuous aggression by both the occupation forces and settlers, through preventing farmers from harvesting their crops and assaulting them, uprooting trees, cutting off their branches and burning them, stealing or destroying crops, stealing crop harvesting equipment, and blocking and bulldozing roads leading to agricultural lands.

The Observatory has documented raids on the villages of Jenin, Nablus, Qalqilya, Bethlehem, Salfit, Ramallah, Hebron and Tulkarm, while dozens of other attacks are taking place that are difficult to monitor due to their widespread nature across various villages in the West Bank.

In terms of crimes committed by settlers, the number of documented raids carried out by settlers during the past week amounted to 60 raids. Some of the incidents included settlers robbing a truck transporting goods and stealing its contents in Deir Dibwan in Ramallah, attacking a water tanker and pouring its water on the road while stealing its equipment, and stealing 17 heads of sheep in Ramallah. Settlers also damaged the water network in Bedouin communities in Al-Quds, and detained school students, preventing them from reaching Khan al-Ahmar School in Al-Quds.

While settlers storm the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque almost daily, the Ibrahimi Mosque in the city of Hebron has been suffering for more than a month from a ban on prayer in it in order to clear the place for settlers to perform their Talmudic rituals during the Jewish holidays.

Thus, the total number of Israeli crimes during the past week has reached 2841 crimes, affecting various Palestinian groups and regions.

## **The Occupation Forces Double their Frenzied Campaign against the Olive Harvest In the West Bank**

### **Israel Intensifies the Circle of Genocide in Gaza and Begins Displacing the Residents of Jabalia**

Israel tightened a closed circle of genocide in the northern Gaza Strip, which has already begun in the Jabalia camp that has been subjected to numerous massacres. Besides, the camp is currently subjected to a forced displacement process. During the period from October 15-to October 21, 2024, the OIC Media Observatory on Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians recorded 26 massacres, most of which were concentrated in the northern Gaza Strip, with 316 martyrs in addition to 1,155 wounded. The total number of martyrs from October 7, 2023 to October 20, 2024 amounted to (43,362) and the wounded to (106,045).

The mentioned period witnessed the concentration of Israeli crimes in Jabalia camp, where the occupation forces bombed Abu Hussein School causing it to burn down, and targeted Hafsa School which is affiliated with the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) and where displaced persons are housed. They further killed fifty Palestinians when they bombed the homes of the Hawajri family and ended up forcing the Palestinians to leave the camp at gunpoint.

In Beit Lahia, the occupation forces killed 73 Palestinians, and bombed and stormed the tents of the displaced people around the Indonesian Hospital, causing the hospital generators to burn down as part of a plan to further displace the displaced people hiding around it.

The occupation forces equally bombed a school in Al-Shati camp and burned Hamad School in the northern Gaza Strip in addition to an inhabited house in Tal Al-Hawa, which resulted in the martyrdom of 8 Palestinians.

In terms of violations against Palestinian sanctities, the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque was subjected to almost daily incursions during which the total number of intruders reached 3,522 extremists. During these incidents, the trumpet was blown twice inside the mosque compound in a blatant assault on the privacy of the noble

sanctuary, while the occupation forces closed the Ibrahimi Mosque to Palestinian worshippers in the city of Hebron to enable settlers to perform their Talmudic prayers there.

In the West Bank, the occupation forces killed 6 Palestinians during the week, injured 39 others, and arrested 146 Palestinians. They also demolished 5 homes in Jerusalem, Salfit, and Jericho, burned 3 homes in Nablus, and occupied 4 homes in Tulkarm and Jenin, turning them into military barracks.

The occupation forces also demolished a commercial facility in Jerusalem, a gas station in Nablus, and a sheep pen in Tubas, while settlers burned two poultry farms and a residential room in Yatta, Hebron. Moreover, the occupation forces confiscated 26,944 dunums of land from the village of Jaba by military order, to establish a buffer zone around the settlement of “Adam”.

As for the systematic Israeli campaign against the olive harvest season in the West Bank, the observatory recorded 37 Palestinian villages being subjected to 50 attacks by the occupation forces and settlers on farmers to prevent them from harvesting olives in addition to uprooting 27 olive trees in Deir Ballut in Salfit, breaking their branches and burning them in Burqa and Jalud in Nablus, and destroying agricultural lands in Nahhalin in Bethlehem.

The number of attacks on agricultural lands in the West Bank reached 70 attacks, including the theft of olive crops in 3 villages in Hebron and Nablus in addition to closing the roads leading to agricultural lands in Kafr al-Dik in Salfit. The total number of settler attacks on Palestinian villages during the mentioned period was 59 attacks, during which they stole 200 sheep, an electricity generator, a cow milking machine, and 3 horses in the villages of Qusra and Jalud in Nablus. The week also witnessed 4 settlement activities, most of which were in the form of setting up mobile homes and tents, and furrowing roads amidst Palestinian lands. The total number of Israeli crimes during the period from October 15 to 21, 2024 was (2450) crimes throughout the Palestinian territories.

## **The occupation disrupt olive harvest season for third consecutive week Israel is working to empty northern Gaza by killing and suppressing rescue attempts**

The Israeli occupation forces increased their shelling of Jabalia camp and Beit Lahia town during the week of October 22-28, 2024. This period witnessed one of the most heinous Israeli crimes represented by targeting hospitals in northern Gaza, forcefully evacuating them and stopping civil defense services. During this period, the number of martyrs in the Gaza Strip reached 421, while the number of wounded reached 1342. The total number of martyrs during the period from October 7, 2024 to October 28, 2024 was 43783, while the number of wounded for the same period was 107360.

Key incidents documented by the OIC Media Observatory on Israeli crimes against the Palestinians, during the week, include the targeting of the Asma School affiliated with the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) in Beit Lahia by the Israeli occupation forces, while the Israeli Knesset approved the ban on the agency’s work in the Palestinian territories.

45 Palestinians were martyred and dozens were injured in an Israeli bombardment that targeted several homes in the Beit Lahia project. Two children were also martyred in Kamal Adwan Hospital, whose fuel generators and oxygen equipment were hit, in addition to the evacuation of most of its workers. Israeli shells also killed 5 Palestinians in a deliberate targeting of the gate of Al-Yaman Al-Saeed Hospital in Jabalia. The Israeli occupation banned the work of civil defense teams in the northern Gaza Strip, where it became clear that the Israeli measures aimed to forcefully displace its residents to areas in the central Gaza Strip.

A report by the United Nations Development Program indicated that, 80,000 homes were destroyed in the Gaza Strip, which needs 80 years to rebuild, while its economy needs 350 years to recover to its faltering state before the Israeli aggression.

In the West Bank, Israeli forces killed 4 Palestinians in one week, 10 others were injured, and the occupation forces arrested 128. The number of settler attacks on Palestinian villages and towns reached about 62 attacks, most of which constituted a declared war on the olive harvest season, as settlers and occupation forces launched 41 attacks that included 36 villages, separately from dozens of attacks that were not documented. These attacks varied between preventing Palestinians from harvesting their crops in 26 villages, and cutting, burning and uprooting olive trees in 4 different villages, while 6 villages were subjected to looting and theft of olive crops and equipment used at the time. Among the Israeli crimes during the past week, which amounted to 2,590, the occupation soldiers stormed the Wadi Fukin School in Bethlehem, forcing the teaching staff to evacuate it, and the settlers of the “Kfar Tapuah” settlement opened fire on a transformer supplying electricity to the village of Yasuf in Salfit, which led to a complete power



outage, and the occupation forces prevented the repair of the transformer.

Settlers demolished 15 Palestinian homes and facilities in the village of Sa'ir in Hebron, and seized all their contents, including clothes, furniture, windows and doors, in addition to seizing and destroying about 20 solar energy units and their batteries.

During the week, the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque was subjected to daily incursions, and the occupation forces closed the doors of the Ibrahimi Mosque in Hebron to worshippers to enable settlers to perform their Talmudic rituals, and Israeli soldiers occupied 3 homes in the village of Faqqu'a in Jenin and the Shuweika suburb in Tulkarm and turned them into military barracks.

In terms of settlement activities, armed settlers, under the protection of the occupation forces, began establishing a new settlement outpost west of the village of Farkha in Salfit, where they transported building materials and mobile homes to the site.

## **The Israeli occupation and settlers continue throughout October the campaign to suppress the olive harvest season**

### **Israeli bombing reaches all areas of the Gaza Strip and the martyrs after a year: 44142**

The number of Palestinian martyrs in one week, October 29 - November 4, 2024, reached 359 martyrs, according to records of the Media Observatory of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation on Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians, while the number of wounded reached 1168. The majority of these casualties were concentrated in the Gaza Strip, where Israeli aggression affected almost all areas, especially the Jabalia, Nuseirat, Beit Lahia, Deir al-Balah, Rafah and Khan Yunis camps resulting in 29 massacres.

The Abu Nasr family massacre in Beit Lahia, which included forcibly displaced persons from Jabalia, was particularly highlighted during the week. In response, the Beit Lahia municipality declared a state of disaster. The occupation forces also continued to target the displaced in Deir al-Balah and the vicinity of al-Awda Hospital in al-Nuseirat.

The number of martyrs since October 7, 2023 until the date of this report has reached 44,142, while the number of wounded has reached 108,511. The United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) announced that the occupation forces killed 50 children in two consecutive days in northern Gaza. UNICEF also confirmed that it was unable to reach 15,000 Palestinian children under the age of ten in northern Gaza to administer the second dose of the polio vaccine.

In the West Bank, 5 Palestinians were killed by the occupation forces, 141 others were arrested, and 7 homes were demolished, most of them in neighborhoods of occupied Jerusalem. Also, Israelis occupied 5 homes in Tulkarm and Jenin and turned them into military barracks, and approved the confiscation of 64 dunums of Palestinian land in the village of Umm Tuba in al-Quds, which will lead to the evacuation of about 30 homes in which 139 Palestinians live. The occupation army also demolished the office of the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) in the Nour Shams camp in Tulkarm, bulldozing its outer walls, as well as demolishing an agricultural nursery and an agricultural room in Qalqilya and another agricultural room in al-Quds. During their storming of the Nour Shams camp, the occupation forces also bulldozed streets and infrastructure, causing a power outage in the camp.

Settlers launched 60 attacks on Palestinian villages and towns, where they burned 20 cars and the facade of a house during their raid on the city of Al-Bireh. They also placed toxic materials in the Nura spring, causing the death of 13 sheep.

The Israeli aggression on the olive season in the West Bank continued throughout October and early November. In just one week, 53 attacks were recorded, affecting 41 villages. These attacks, carried out by the occupation army alongside the settlers varied between preventing farmers from harvesting their crops, cutting and uprooting olive branches and trees, burning them, bulldozing agricultural lands, blocking the roads leading to the farms, and stealing olive crops.

The West Bank villages were subjected to six settlement activities, ranging from paving settlement roads in Tubas, to setting up mobile homes in the villages of Dura and Yatta in Hebron and Khalayel Al-Loz in Bethlehem, in addition to setting up barbed wire around a house in the Arab Al-Malihah community in preparation for its seizure.

In the city of Hebron, the occupation authorities prevented Palestinians from performing prayers at the Ibrahimi Mosque for two consecutive days to open it for the performance of Talmudic rituals by extremist settlers.

Finally, the Observatory's report recorded about 2457 crimes committed by the occupation forces and settlers, over a period of seven days, affecting the Gaza Strip, the West Bank and occupied al-Quds.

## 1855 Israeli Crimes and Settlers Carry out 53 Attacks in one Week Israel Intensifies Murdering, Starvation and Displacement of Palestinians in Northern Gaza and Prevents Aid



Israel's crimes have increased regularly and rapidly over the past week in the northern Gaza Strip, and it has returned to the policy of starvation, mass killing and forced displacement targeting the displaced.

The Organization of Islamic Cooperation, (OIC) Media Observatory for Israel's Crimes against the Palestinians monitored the number of murdered in the Gaza Strip, from November 5-11, 2024, at (242) murdered, while the number of injured reached (662). The OIC Observatory also recorded the occurrence of (00) massacres, most of which were concentrated in Northern and central Gaza.

The Israeli bombing focused on shelters in northern Gaza. It targeted the Hamada family and murdered women and children in the bombing of the Al-Daraj neighborhood in central Gaza. In addition, 12 Palestinians were murdered in an air strike that targeted the Shuhaibar School, which shelters displaced people and is affiliated with the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA).

The Israeli forces ordered the residents of North Beach, Al-Nasr, Abd al-Rahman, and the city of return and dignity, which is located West and Northwest of Gaza City, to move south.



The UN confirmed that 85% of attempts to coordinate the entry of aid convoys and humanitarian visits to northern Gaza are rejected or obstructed by Israel despite the harsh conditions the Gaza Strip is going through. In the West Bank and occupied al-Quds, the OIC Observatory recorded (12) murdered and (29) injuries, while the occupation forces arrested (189) others. The total number of Palestinian murdered since October 7, 2023 to November 11, 2024, reached (44,383), while the number of injured for the same period reached (109,179). The occupation forces demolished, burned, and occupied (22) homes within one week. It demolished 16 houses distributed across the West Bank and occupied al-Quds, burned another in Jenin camp, occupied a house in Ramallah, demolished a shop and burned another in Tulkarm camp, and settlers destroyed 4 caravans in the town of Sa'ir in Hebron and expelled its residents.

In the same context, the occupation forces bulldozed streets and destroyed infrastructure facilities in Al-Far'a camp, the town of Tamoun in Tubas, the town of Qabatiya in Jenin, and the Nur Shams camp in Tulkarm, in addition to bulldozing an agricultural area between the towns of Qarawa and Bani Hassan and the village of Sarta in Salfit. The OIC Observatory documented (53) attacks carried out by settlers against villages and towns in the West Bank and occupied al-Quds, while attacks on the olive harvest season continued, as 27 Palestinian villages were subjected to 38 aggressions that varied between preventing farm Palestinians owners from harvesting their crops, cutting, uprooting and burning olive trees, bulldozing agricultural lands, blocking roads leading to farms and stealing olive crops. The occupation forces participated in the looting and repression operations, while the attacks focused on the villages of Nablus Governorate.

Israeli extremists continued to storm the Al-Aqsa Mosque throughout most days of the week, and settlers also attacked worshipers during dawn in a mosque in the village of Burqa in Nablus and smashed the windows of a vehicle in front of the mosque. Settlers also burned a Palestinian car in the village of Kafr Malik in Ramallah, and killed an elderly Palestinian after spraying pepper gas in his face, which led to his suffocation. The OIC Observatory recorded (5) settlement activities during the mentioned period, the most prominent of which was the settlers seizing a plot of land and planting it with olive trees in the northern Jordan Valley. Others built a mobile home on land overlooking the village of Khalayel al-Loz in Bethlehem, in addition to the village of Jalud, with the aim of turning them into settlement outposts. Settles plowed lands and stole mobile homes in the village of Khalayel al-Loz, in preparation for seizing them.

The OIC Observatory documented (1855) Israeli crimes, between November 5 and 11, which also included the occupation forces storming the Church of Pater Noster located in the upper part of the Mount of Olives in al-Quds, which is run by France, coinciding with the arrival of the French Foreign Minister, in addition to numerous attacks on the education sector in Tubas Governorate, including the storming 2 schools.

## **After the Suppression of the Olive Harvest: Settlers Begin Their Attacks on Mosques in Al-Quds and the West Bank**

### **Israel Commits Scattered Massacres at a Wider Pace, Killing 323 Palestinians in One Week**

The Israeli occupation forces murdered and injured 1,304 Palestinians during the past seven days. Most of these casualties resulted from shelling that focused on the northern Gaza Strip and targeted scattered gatherings but at a wider pace. The occupation forces have recently escalated their tactics, carrying out mass killings of families in (31) separate massacres that targeted displaced person's tents, shelters and homes in Beit Lahia and Jabalia in northern Gaza and Deir al-Balah in the center, extending to many other areas. This included the bombing of a clinic affiliated with the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA). The occupation forces also bombed and burned UNRWA humanitarian aid trucks after allowing them to enter the Gaza Strip. UNRWA also revealed that Israel had launched (64) attacks on schools that were being used as shelters for the displaced persons.

The Media Observatory of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation for Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians documented the fall of (319) murdered in the Gaza Strip between November 12-18, 2024, and recorded (959) injuries. As of the writing of this report, the total number of murdered since October 7, 2023, stands at (44,706), and (110,148) wounded.

The Palestinian Ministry of Health stated that more than (2,000) murdered fell in the massacres committed by the occupation forces in the northern Gaza Strip in the past few weeks, with more than (6,000) others injured. In its assessment of the Israeli aggression, the US based Human Rights Watch organization condemned Israel's practices, stating that Israel committed war crimes through its direct practice of ethnic cleansing and forced displacement of Palestinians.

In terms of violations in occupied Al-Quds, the Israeli occupation forces allowed extremists settlers to storm the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque through the Mughrabi Gate to perform their Talmudic rituals. The storming of Al-Aqsa by extremists occurred almost daily throughout the past week. In addition, Israel restricted the entry of Palestinian worshipers to the mosque. It also confiscated a popular café in Al-Quds for the benefit of settlers.

With regard to targeting homes, the occupation forces demolished (8) homes, four of which were located in the occupied city of Al-Quds, and the rest in various cities of the West Bank. They also demolished a mosque, a guest house, and five mobile homes in the Bedouin community near Jaba' – Al-Quds.

Additionally, Israeli forces confiscated a mobile home in the Tubas Governorate, demolished a pond for collecting water for agricultural purposes in Beit Ummar in Hebron and destroyed a commercial kiosk in Bethlehem. They also occupied a home in Al-Jalboun in Jenin.

In the same context, the occupation forces ordered the confiscation of 546.42 dunums of land in the towns and villages of Salfit to expand a settlement road. It also announced a plan to confiscate 8,750 dunums of land in the town of Kafr ad-Dik, with the aim of expanding the “Beduel” settlement.

The number of settlement activities during the period from November 12 to 18, 2024, amounted to (5) activities represented by settlers setting up tents and mobile homes in the village of al-Jab'a, Khallet al-Khader and the Tel al-Rumaida neighborhood in Hebron with the aim of establishing new settlement outposts, in addition to setting up tents and building sheep pens in the town of al-Auja in Jericho for the same purpose.

A review of the ongoing Israeli attacks on the cities and villages of the West Bank shows that, in the past week, the Israeli occupation forces murdered five Palestinians, injured (22) and arrested (118) others.

The olive harvest season, which is in its final stages, witnessed (27) attacks against (25) villages by the occupation forces and settlers.

The villages of the West Bank witnessed (61) raids during the past week, during which settlers burned (6) cars in Nablus and Al-Quds, stole (13) sheep, stormed the Ibad al-Rahman Mosque in Dura, Hebron, climbed its minaret and danced on it, and another settler stormed the Salah al-Din Mosque in the town of Abu Dis and called for its demolition.

As a result, the total number of Israeli crimes across various Palestinian areas during the past week reached (2,128) crimes, ranging from massacres in the Gaza Strip, settler attacks, and deliberate targeting of mosques in Al-Quds and the West Bank.

## **Occupation Forces Demolished a Mosque, Close Al-Ibrahimi Mosque, and Continue Storming Al-Aqsa**

### **Israeli Shelling Worsens Winter Cold Amid Complete Closure of the Gaza Strip**

The Gaza Strip groans under the burden of daily Israeli shelling, starvation, and attacks on the health sector, with the arrival of winter exacerbating the suffering of the people of the Strip, most of whom are displaced and live in tents and under cloth tarps.

The OIC Media Observatory for Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians documented, between November 19 and 25, 2024, numerous Israeli bombings that targeted the tents of the displaced in Al-Mawasi, in the west, the residents of Al-Tuffah neighborhood in the eastern Gaza Strip, and the Jabalia and Al-Shati camps in the northern Gaza Strip. The occupation forces also bombed Kamal Adwan Hospital in the north, particularly the emergency and reception entrances, in addition to a residential complex next to the hospital, and injured the hospital director, Hussam Abu Safia, in the aggression. The OIC Observatory reported that, 23 massacres were committed by Israel over the past week.

In a related development, Dr. Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus, Director-General of the World Health Organization, stated that Israel had arbitrarily denied entry to 4 missions from the organization during the past days, preventing it from sending medical teams and supplies of fuel, food, water, and medicines to Kamal Adwan Hospital in the northern Gaza Strip. The number of murdered over seven days in the Gaza Strip alone reached (313), with (737) wounded. The number of Palestinian murdered since the beginning of the Israeli aggression on October 7, 2023, until November 25, 2024, reached (45,031), while the number of wounded reached (110,888).

All of this comes amidst warnings from the United Nations of the closure of dozens of bakeries inside the Strip due to the scarcity of flour. The Israeli blockade continues to prevent the entry of much needed humanitarian aid. The OIC Media Observatory pointed out that the worsening food situation in the Gaza Strip had been



compounded by several factors orchestrated by Israel, including preventing the entry of humanitarian aid or rationing it and allowing a limited list of materials, in addition to allowing settlers to destroy shipments on their way to the crossings, or allowing the aid to enter and then targeting the crowds searching for food or targeting the trucks themselves after entering the Gaza Strip. Others include, targeting the committees that work to organize the distribution of aid and the “tekiyat” that distribute ready-made meals, or targeting food and goods stores, or empowering criminals and thieves inside the Strip to steal aid shipments. The observatory also reported that heavy rain flooded the tents of displaced persons, but the civil defense’s ability to assist was hindered due to shortage of fuel, and also hindered their ability to solve the cold crisis alongside many humanitarian disasters that the Palestinians are experiencing in the Gaza Strip.

In occupied Al-Quds, Israeli extremists continued to storm the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque under the protection of the occupation police. Between November 18-24, a total of (1905) extremists were involved in the incursions.

The occupation forces also demolished the Al-Shiyah Mosque in the Jabal al-Mukaber neighborhood in Al-Quds, along with two houses in the Shuafat neighborhood, a garden, a hut, a studio, and a vegetable shop. The Israeli authorities approved the confiscation of 11 dunums of Palestinian land in the village of Beit Safafa, in favor of building 200 new settlement housing units.

In the West Bank, the occupation forces demolished two houses in Salfit and Hebron, occupied four houses in Jenin, Ramallah, and Kafr Aboush, and burned three houses completely in Jenin. They also demolished two agricultural rooms, retaining walls, stone chains, and beehives, uprooted 42 fruit trees in Nablus, and agricultural pens with an area of 350 square meters, and a water collection well. Other destructions included the uprooting of a number of trees in Hebron, and destruction of parts of the municipal stadium camp in Jenin, bulldozing of streets, destruction of parts of the infrastructure, and damage to Palestinian property in the Jenin camp. The occupation forces confiscated 520 dunums of agricultural land in the village of Afqiqis for the expansion of the “Negohuat” settlement.

The Israeli occupation also confiscated a truck, a bulldozer, a farming tractor, and a concrete pump in Jenin, Tulkarm, and Qalqilya, and fertilizers in Hebron, and 5 generators for pumping water, 3 electrical transformers, and 30 solar panels for generating electricity in the northern Jordan Valley in Tubas.

The occupation forces stormed Al-Maleh Elementary School in the northern Jordan Valley, assaulted the school staff, and also stormed Al-Mughayer Secondary School in Ramallah.

With regard to suppressing the olive harvest season in the West Bank, settlers and occupation forces committed (13) attacks that affected (13) different villages. The attacks included preventing Palestinians from harvesting their crops, uprooting and breaking the branches of more than 170 olive trees in each of the villages of Hajja, Yasuf, and Al-Lubban Al-Sharqiya, in addition to stealing olive crops and bulldozing agricultural lands.

The occupation forces in the West Bank murdered (13) Palestinians, wounded (46) others, and arrested (118) during the period between November 19-25, 2024. The settlers also launched (33) attacks on towns and villages in the West Bank, during which they burned two vehicles in Ramallah, while the extremist Minister of National Security, Itamar Ben Gvir, stormed the Ibrahim Mosque in the city of Hebron, which the occupation forces closed 3 days ago and is still doing so under the pretext of Jewish holidays.

The villages of the West Bank witnessed 3 settlement activities, as settlers in Tubas began rehabilitating a water spring in order to seize it, and the occupation authorities in the Wadi al-Rababa area in the Silwan neighborhood in the city of Jerusalem bulldozed an area of land and placed tombstones in the place, and settlers placed a mobile home on Palestinian land in the Masafer town of Yatta.

In total, between November 19-25, 2024, the OIC Media Observatory recorded 1,838 Israeli crimes across various Palestinian areas. Since the start of the Israeli aggression on October 7, 2023, the total number of recorded Israeli crimes stands at 204,505.

## **Settlers Raid 35 Villages in the West Bank, and Al-Aqsa is Subjected to Daily Raids 239 Palestinian Murdered in 7 Days and 206,294 Israeli Crimes in over a Year**

The Israeli occupation forces have intensified their massacres in the Gaza Strip, where the number of massacres reached 26 during the period between November 26 and December 2, 2024. Last Saturday alone, 100 Palestinians were murdered within 24 hours. The total number of Palestinians murdered in the Gaza Strip in the past week, according to the Media Observatory of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation on Israeli crimes against the Palestinians, reached 233, with 738 others injured, as a result of the Israeli bombing that targeted several areas, including a school housing displaced persons east of Gaza City, civilian homes in the Sheikh Radwan neighborhood in Gaza City, as well as the Nuseirat and Jabalia camps. The Israeli occupation also targeted the Baptist Hospital, which resulted in the murder of a journalist, bringing the total number of journalists murdered in the Israeli aggression on the Gaza Strip to 191.

In a separate massacre, the occupation forces also deliberately bombed a crew of the World Central Kitchen in Khan Yunis, resulting in the murder of 3 of its workers in an attack that is the second of its kind targeting the “World Kitchen” since the beginning of the Israeli aggression on the Gaza Strip.

The number of Palestinians murdered from October 7, 2023, until December 1, 2024, has reached 45,179, while the number of wounded reached 111,392.

In occupied al-Quds, extremist settlers continue to storm the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque on a daily basis, under the protection of the occupation authorities, who demolished a house in the Jabal al-Mukaber neighborhood, and two agricultural facilities.



Six Palestinians were murdered in the West Bank, where the occupation forces arrested 129 others, demolished four homes, occupied three others and turned them into military barracks. They also bulldozed streets and infrastructure in the Far'aah camp in Tubas and demolished two agricultural rooms in Ramallah. In Qalqilya, a commercial shop selling motorcycles was demolished after confiscating its contents. The Israeli occupation also bulldozed a scrap metal shop in Jenin, demolished a vehicle repair shop, and burned a vegetable shop in Ramallah.

The occupation forces also confiscated agricultural equipment in the northern Jordan Valley, a solar energy system and a trailer in Tubas, a private car in Ramallah, and burned another in Salfit.

In terms of the attack on the education sector, the occupation forces arrested four students from Birzeit University when they stormed near Ramallah, and settlers stormed the Bedouin al-Ka'abneh School in Jericho. In a related context, the number of attacks carried out by settlers over the past seven days reached 35, including the theft of two horses in a village near Tubas Governorate, and the destruction of corn crops over an area of dozens of dunams in the same governorate.

The settlers also carried out two settlement activities in the reviewed period, where they set up a number of mobile homes in an attempt to establish a new settlement outpost east of the town of Yatta in Hebron, and others entered the Al-Bayada area in the village of Jit in Nablus and stole construction equipment before setting up a tent near a house.

The attacks of the occupation forces and settlers on the olive harvest season continued into its final days, as the Israeli forces and settlers prevented Palestinians on four occasions from harvesting their crops. The attacks were concentrated in the villages of Nablus, where settlers cut the branches of dozens of trees and uprooted olive seedlings in the villages of Yasuf in Salfit, Qusra in Nablus, and Al-Deirat in Hebron.

The number of crimes committed by the Israelis between November 26 and December 2, 2024, amounted to 1,789 crimes that affected all Palestinian areas, while the total number of crimes committed by Israel, the occupying power, between October 7, 2023, and the time of writing of this report has reached 206,294 crimes.

## Israel Transfers Its War on UNRWA to Global Cities The Occupation Turns Northern Gaza into a Hell

The Israeli occupation forces have adopted a cumulative escalation policy since October 2023, aiming to make the Gaza Strip a hell unfit for living by destroying infrastructure and service centers, preventing the entry of humanitarian aid, bombing bakeries, disabling and evacuating hospitals, and committing various other war crimes. As a result of these crimes, nearly two million people, most of whom are displaced, are now crowded into an extremely narrow area, thus becoming a repellent area that pushes its residents to voluntary migration.

In the past seven days, December 3-9, 2024, the OIC Media Observatory for Israeli Crimes against Palestinians documented a large number of crimes committed by Israel, the occupying power. These include the bombing and storming of Kamal Adwan Hospital and forcing its medical staff, including Indonesian doctors to leave. The Israeli forces also besieged the Indonesian hospital and demolished its outer wall, while Al-Awda Hospital in Jabalia camp was subjected to artillery shelling, thus disabling all hospitals in the northern Gaza Strip in Jabalia, Beit Lahia and Beit Hanoun. The occupation forces also massacred Palestinians sheltering in Jabalia, Al-Bureij, Al-Nuseirat and Al-Mawasi. The occupation forces also dug up a cemetery in Jabalia in search of the bodies of Israeli prisoners, and evacuated areas in Beit Lahia.

During the mentioned period, the OIC Observatory recorded the murder of 293 Palestinians in the Gaza Strip, and seven others in the West Bank, in addition to wounding 800 Palestinians. The total number of massacres over the course of one week alone amounted to 24 massacres, while the number of murdered from October 7, 2023 to December 7, 2024 amounted to 45470 murdered and 112226 wounded.

On the other hand, Israel, the occupying power, extended its declared war on the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) beyond the Palestinian territories to several major cities around the world. This campaign involves misleading messages through paid advertisements in the public spaces of those cities aimed at tarnishing UNRWA's reputation, calling for its dismantling and accusing it of "terrorism". UNRWA has condemned these actions and demanded through its website for an end to the campaign and to hold those responsible for this misleading campaign accountable.

In occupied al-Quds, the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque was subjected to daily Israeli raids. The occupation



forces demolished three homes, a commercial store and four barns. In the West Bank, the occupation forces demolished seven homes in Bethlehem, three commercial establishments in Nablus, and three barns in Bethlehem. Settlers burned a house and a grocery store in Nablus, while the Israeli occupation forces burned a house and two vehicles in Nablus in an exchange of roles between the settlers and the occupation soldiers who occupied a home in Jenin.

In one week, the occupation forces arrested 185 Palestinians in the West Bank and occupied al-Quds, while the settlers launched 38 raids on cities, villages and towns in the West Bank and occupied al-Quds. The total number of settler attacks on the Palestinian territories over the period from October 7, 2023, to November 30, 2024, amounted to 2621 attacks, with the highest number of these attacks occurring in October 2023 with 343 attacks, followed by October 2024 with 251 attacks and May 2024 coming third with 225 attacks. The villages of Nablus city were the most exposed to these attacks with 602 attacks during the mentioned period, followed by the villages of Hebron with 592 attacks, and the villages of Ramallah third with 330 attacks. According to OIC Observatory's monitoring of the period between December 3-9, 2024, there were six settlement activities recorded during the period ranging from setting up mobile homes and tents on Palestinian lands in Ramallah and Nablus or plowing, planting and installing barbed wire around other lands with the aim of seizing them in Hebron, Tubas and Jericho.

With regard to the crimes of the occupation forces, they killed an elderly Palestinian after severely beating him and confiscating his car in Nablus. They also stormed two schools in the villages of Bardala and Barziq in Tubas and the Arab Specialized Hospital in Nablus, prevented Palestinian farmers from plowing their land, confiscated their agricultural equipment and cut the branches of 60 olive and grape trees.

Finally, the total number of crimes committed by Israel, the occupying power, over the past week amounted to 1989 crimes in the occupied Palestinian territory.

## **The occupation confiscates large areas in the West Bank and launches a campaign to close schools**

### **Israel intensifies targeting of displaced persons, 87% of Gaza Strip subjected to regional displacement**

The Organisation of Islamic Cooperation, (OIC) Media Observatory for Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians has monitored the Israeli occupation army's intensified targeting of schools housing displaced persons, especially in the northern Gaza Strip.

The OIC Observatory recorded, in an unprecedented manner, between December 10 and 16, 2024, the targeting of 7 schools, three of which were sheltering displaced persons (the A'ae;h al-Muqadassah, al-Majida Wasila, and Yafa) in Gaza City - north - as well as the bombing of Awidha School in Beit Hanoun, northeast of the Gaza Strip, and Ahmed Abdel Aziz School in Khan Yunis - center - and Abu Asi School affiliated with the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA), in addition to the bombing and burning of a school in Beit Lahia - north - and the eviction of the displaced from it.

The occupation forces also blew up buildings in northern Gaza, bombing municipality building in Deir al-Balah, and committed massacres in the Nuseirat camp and the tents of the displaced in Khan Yunis where the total number of massacres committed by Israeli occupation during the mentioned period amounted to (26) massacres.

Targeting of schools is aimed at terrorizing the displaced people in order to forcibly displace them from their places, at a time when Israel, the occupying power, has issued 66 orders for forced displacement for other areas in the Gaza Strip, covering 87% of Gaza, and including 150 residential neighborhoods, according to the United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs, (OCHA) which confirmed that 80% of the Gaza Strip is still subject to these orders.

In the context of concealing its crimes, the occupation forces murdered journalists Mohammed Ba'alousha and Ahmed Al-Louh, and had also murdered journalist Mamdouh Qunaita two weeks earlier.

The OIC Observatory recorded (272) murdered in the Gaza Strip over the past seven days, and (845) wounded, while the number of Palestinian murdered from October 7, 2023 to December 16, 2024, reached (45,840), and the number of wounded reached (113,212).

In the West Bank and occupied al-Quds, the occupation forces murdered 5 Palestinians during the past period, arrested (185) others, and issued orders to confiscate lands in the town of Abu Dis in al-Quds, and other areas behind the separation barrier in Salfit, in addition to confiscating 54.79 dunums of lands belonging to the towns of Qatanna and Biddu located behind the separation barrier. Israel, the occupying power also

confiscated lands for the expansion of a street extending from the “Gush Etzion” settlement, and other lands behind the separation barrier in the Khallet Semaan area to establish a bus station for Israeli settlers. The occupation forces demolished (12) houses in al-Quds, Hebron, Bethlehem and Nablus, while Israeli settlers seized a house in the town of Silwan in al-Quds. The occupation army destroyed two water wells, electricity network, 15 barns and a warehouse in Nablus, Salfit and al-Quds, bulldozed agricultural lands and crops and destroyed irrigation networks near Hebron, Nablus and Jericho, and confiscated a bulldozer and an agricultural tractor in Ramallah and a roller and a water tanker in Hebron.

The Israeli occupation forces surrounded Al-Arroub Secondary School for Boys, in Al-Arroub camp in Hebron, and prevented the school’s students from entering before evacuating its teaching staff. Israeli occupation also evacuated the administration of Awarta Secondary School for Boys, and raided Jaba’ Secondary School for Girls. It also raided the campuses of Hebron University and Polytechnic University during their raid on the city of Hebron.

Meanwhile, the number of settler attacks on West Bank villages reached (38) recorded attacks in one week, where they stormed the Jabaris area, set fire to a residential room, sealed a water well.

In continuation of settler attacks, a settler ran over a Palestinian child in his vehicle in Nablus, others uprooted trees and cut other branches in the villages of Yasuf and Qarawat Bani Hassan in Salfit, Samou in Hebron, and Beit Furik in Nablus. They stormed agricultural lands and stole agricultural equipment, as well as 25 cows in the northern Jordan Valley, 17 sheep near Nablus, and 40 beehives in Tubas.

The OIC Observatory recorded 5 settlement activities in one week ranged from setting up tents and mobile homes on the lands of Bethlehem and Ramallah to expand their settlement outposts, and bulldozing lands owned by Palestinians with the aim of paving settlement roads, as well as, seized lands by squatting in the town of Adh Dhahiriya. Thus, the number of crimes committed by Israelis over 7 days only (2018) amounted to a violation that included all Palestinian areas.

## **Settlement Activities, Attacks on Mosques, and Demolition of Homes in the West Bank The Israeli Occupation Continues its Criminality in “Kamal Adwan” and Displaces Residents of Al-Bureij and Al-Shuja’iyya**

Kamal Adwan Hospital in the northern Gaza Strip witnessed successive Israeli crimes that ended with the occupation forces ordering its evacuation after cutting off electricity, placing explosive robots near it, and blowing up residential buildings in its vicinity. At the same time, the hospital was exposed to Israeli fire between December 17-23, 2024, which also witnessed the targeting of Al-Awda Hospital.

The number of Palestinians murdered in the Gaza Strip over the mentioned period reached (289), while the number of injured reached (777), and the number of massacres reached (25). The OIC Media Observatory on Israeli crimes against the Palestinians documented (45912) Palestinians murdered from October 7, 2023, until December 18, 2024, while the number of injured reached (113494).

The Israeli occupation forces continued to bomb most areas of the Gaza Strip, and according to monitoring over the past seven days, they included residential apartments in central Gaza and Rafah, in addition to places in the Nuseirat camp, Jabalia, and Deir al-Balah. They besieged a camp for displaced persons in Nuseirat, and issued orders to evacuate four areas in al-Bureij, and ordered the residents of the Shuja’iyya neighborhood to move to areas near Gaza City.

In documenting the Israeli confessions, the Israeli newspaper Haaretz revealed testimonies of occupation soldiers who committed war crimes in Gaza, by murdering civilians. The Hebrew media also acknowledged that the occupation forces destroyed more than 70% of the buildings in Jabalia camp.

On the humanitarian level, UNICEF confirmed that most areas in the northern Gaza Strip are suffering from food scarcity due to the complete Israeli closure for 78 days. It also confirmed that 14,500 children were murdered by the occupation forces’ fire over the past 14 months. Last week, a child died in Al-Mawasi due to the severe cold, and UNICEF warned of the effects of the catastrophic conditions of cold, hunger, and disease on the children of Gaza.

In terms of Israeli crimes in the West Bank and occupied al-Quds, the OIC Observatory recorded (12) Palestinians murdered during the period 17-23 December 2024, while the occupation forces arrested (124) others during that period, and the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque was subjected to daily raids. The occupation forces demolished 5 houses and part of a house in the occupied city of al-Quds, demolished 4 houses in Bethlehem, Tubas and Hebron, occupied a house in Jenin, bombed Tulkarm camp with aircraft, and demolished two shops selling vegetables in Hebron, and 3 barns in Salfit, and agricultural greenhouses and



a water collection pool in the villages of Tulkarm, while settlers burned an agricultural room in Salfit.

In the same context, the number of settler attacks on Palestinian villages in the West Bank reached about (31) attacks, where they set fire to the Ber al-Walidain Mosque in the village of Marda in Salfit, and wrote insulting phrases against Islam and threats against the villagers, while others stole sheep feed and demolished the fences of agricultural lands, and other groups of settlers uprooted olive tree seedlings in several villages in the West Bank.

The number of settlement activities over the past seven days reached (6) activities, represented by settlers plowing agricultural lands in the northern Jordan Valley in Tubas, while the occupation forces bulldozed hundreds of dunams in the villages of Iskaka and Yasuf to expand the “Neve Nehemia” settlement, and bulldozed other lands along the road leading to the “Ariel” settlement in the village of al-Sawiya in Nablus. Settlers paved a settlement road in the Wadi al-Shouk area in Ramallah, while others attempted to establish a new settlement outpost in the southeastern part of the Arab al-Malihah community in Jericho. Settlers in the village of Bardala in Tubas attempted to establish a cowshed in preparation for establishing a settlement outpost. Finally, the number of Israeli crimes over the course of a week reached (2004) crimes in various Palestinian areas.

## **Israeli Crimes Targeting Children in the West Bank and Attacks on Holy Sites Israel Injures 666 Palestinians and Deprives Them of Treatment by Targeting 5 Hospitals in One Week**

Israel, the occupying power, is working to eliminate any attempt to save the northern and central parts of the Gaza Strip by working to end the health sector services there in conjunction with a systematic bloody bombing operation that ultimately seeks to empty the North of the Gaza Strip of its Palestinian residents and seize control of it. The World Health Organization has declared Northern Gaza an area devoid of health facilities. The scene was catastrophic after Kamal Adwan Hospital was evacuated and stopped from operating following Israeli attack, in which it was burned and its staff was arrested. The remaining hospitals in Gaza City were also targeted, including the bombing of Al-Wafa Hospital in central Gaza and the Baptist Ahli Hospital, the destruction of equipment and supplies at the Indonesian Hospital, and the attack on Al-Awda Hospital, which claimed the lives of 5 journalists. This occurred during the period documented by the OIC Media Observatory on Israeli Crimes against Palestinians, from December 24-30, 2024. The monitored week witnessed the murdering of 225 Palestinians in 20 massacres, and 666 others were injured. The total number of Palestinians murdered from October 7, 2023, to December 29, 2024, reached 46,349 and the injured stood at 114,639.

Last week also witnessed warnings that the fate of 300 Palestinian families is unknown in Beit Hanoun, which has become the next target of the occupation forces' shells after attacks on Jabalia and Beit Lahia.

The American newspaper, The New York Times, revealed that the occupation forces had granted freedom to its mid-ranking officers to kill civilians freely with impunity, as part of their aggression against the Gaza Strip. This policy explains the almost constant numbers of murdered, and confirms that the occupation army has been deliberately murdering nearly the same number of people every day. The OIC Observatory also noted that the crimes committed by the Israeli occupation forces in the Gaza Strip or the West Bank are always similar, and often follow a repetitive pattern, with similar attacks occurring on the same day in multiple cities.

In the same context, the occupation forces demolished six houses in occupied al-Quds, Hebron, Qalqilya, and Tulkarm, They also destroyed a livestock farm, a commercial store, and a poultry farm in al-Quds, a 2000 square meter barn in Qalqilya, commercial stores and a warehouse in Tulkarm, a tourist resort and barns in Bethlehem. The occupation forces also stormed Tulkarm and Nour Shams camps in Tulkarm city, where they blew up and burned three houses, a warehouse, and electricity networks, and bulldozed a barn used for storing and selling agricultural fertilizers in Jenin. The occupation forces also bulldozed the entrance to Al-Salam Mosque in Tulkarm camp, and confiscated a bulldozer and a farming tractor in Nablus and Tubas.

In occupied al-Quds, the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque was exposed to daily raids during the past seven days, the most prominent of which was the storming by the extremist Israeli Minister of Security Itamar Ben Gvir at the head of a number of extremist settlers. The Israeli occupation authorities in the Old City of al-Quds installed a huge candlestick in Al-Buraq Square, and another candlestick on the building of the Arab Heritage Center clearly visible from the courtyards of Al-Aqsa Mosque, as part of the policy of changing the Islamic identity of the city. In Hebron, the Israeli forces attacked the director of the Ibrahim Mosque Administration.

During the monitored period, the Israeli occupation forces murdered 15 Palestinians and arrested 151 others across various villages and cities of the West Bank and occupied al-Quds.

On the other hand, the number of settler attacks on the villages of the West Bank and occupied al-Quds in one week reached 25 attacks, during which the settlers cut tree branches and stole goods from a gas station in Nablus. They also stormed the archaeological sites in Jericho, placed symbols, and performed Talmudic rituals there.

The settlers also stormed the Khalayel Al-Loz area and seized six tents and an agricultural room containing solar panels and equipment.

During the period from December 24 to 30, 2024, there were numerous attacks on children and adolescents in the cities and villages of the West Bank and occupied al-Quds. Among the incidents, a settler ran over two little sisters, in addition to the arrest of two children in al-Quds, and another child was murdered in an Israeli bombardment of the town of Tamoun, and the occupation forces arrested three other children in the town of Sinjil and Nablus.

The OIC Observatory also recorded five settlement activities during which settlers plowed Palestinian lands in the village of Khalayel Al-Loz and the area of Nabaa Ghazal with the aim of seizing them. Settlers also built a settlement outpost in the village of Bardala and another in the town of Al-Auja and set up arbors in the town of Yatta.

Over the past seven days, the OIC Observatory documented 1,659 different crimes committed by the Israeli occupation army and settlers in various cities and villages of the Gaza Strip, the West Bank, and occupied al-Quds.

## **69,017 Israeli extremists stormed the Al-Aqsa Courtyards since October 7 Israel Diversifies its Methods to Deprive Gaza Palestinians of Aid and Treatment**

The period between December 31, 2024 and January 6, 2025 witnessed bloody events in the Gaza Strip, the West Bank and occupied al-Quds, while the beginning of the new year (2025) saw a continuation of the Israeli aggression, the intensity of which was no less than in previous years and manifested in ongoing crimes of genocide in the Gaza Strip.

The Media Observatory of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) for Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians documented the murder of 320 Palestinians during this period, and the wounding of 840 others, while the Israeli occupation forces arrested 143 Palestinians in the cities of the West Bank and occupied al-Quds. The number of Palestinians murdered since October 7, 2023, until January 6, 2025, has exceeded 46,692, while the number of injured during the same period of time has reached 115,839. The total number of Israeli crimes during the past week alone have reached 2,166 crimes, spread across the Gaza Strip, the West Bank and occupied al-Quds.

The Israeli bombings during the past seven days focused on the city of Khan Yunis, and reached the vicinity of Halima al-Saadia School in Jabalia Camp, in addition to areas in the north of Gaza City, Nuseirat and Deir al-Balah.

The occupation army also opened fire on a convoy belonging to the United Nations World Food Program further diversifying its methods to prevent the arrival of humanitarian aid to Palestinians in the Gaza Strip. Israeli occupation army also targeted a police station in Khan Yunis and murdered five of its members in a similar attempt to spread chaos and expose aid to theft. Palestinians monitored groups suspected of being Israeli soldiers burning Palestinian homes that survived the bombing in northern Gaza. On the other hand, the Israeli occupation threatened to bomb Al-Awda Hospital after ordering its evacuation, besieged the Indonesian Hospital in Beit Lahia, and bombed the entrance to Al-Shifa Hospital, while the number of newborns who died due to the severe cold has reached seven.

On another note, the occupation forces murdered a journalist and a photojournalist in the Gaza Strip, bringing the total number of journalists murdered since the beginning of the Israeli aggression on the Strip to 202.

In occupied al-Quds and the West Bank, the occupation forces demolished 10 homes, seven of which are in al-Quds, where the number of home demolitions and land leveling operations since October 7, 2023, until the end of 2024, amounted to 439 operations. Additionally, the Israeli occupation demolished a commercial store in Bethlehem, several barns in the villages of Ramallah, and three water collection wells in Nablus and Jericho. They also confiscated five cars in Ramallah, Nablus, and Qalqilya.



Regarding attacks on the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque, the OIC Observatory recorded the entry of 69,017 Israeli extremists into the courtyards of the mosque from October 7, 2023 until the end of 2024, where settlers recently lit the Hanukkah menorah in the Old City in front of one of the gates of Al-Aqsa.

Meanwhile, settlers conducted 41 raids in one week in the villages and towns of occupied al-Quds and the West Bank, during which they stole a vegetable stand in Tubas and the contents of a car after assaulting its owner in Salfit. They burned seven vehicles in the village of Al-Mughayyir and between the villages of Silwad and Yabroud in Ramallah, cut down 19 olive and apple trees, and held Talmudic prayers in a number of religious shrines in Salfit.

The number of settlement activities during the period from December 31, 2024 to January 6, 2025, amounted to six. These included placing a fence around an archaeological site in the town of Al-Auja with the aim of seizing it, allowing settlers to storm the archaeological site of Abu Al-Alaiq Hills and conducted excavations inside it. They also established two settlement outposts near the villages of Qaryut and Al-Jab'a, and plowed lands in al-Quds and Hebron in preparation for planting and confiscating them, in addition to settlers seizing an area of land from the town of Yatta and bulldozing it with the aim of planting it.

## **Complete Destruction of Jabalia, Beit Lahia, and Beit Hanoun; Demolition Affects Dozens of Buildings in the West Bank**

### **The Israeli Occupation Continues to Paralyze the Health Sector and Civil Defense in Gaza and Kills 238 Palestinians in One Week**

Israeli attacks varied in various Palestinian areas, where 21 massacres were committed, during which the Israeli occupation forces murdered 238 Palestinians and injured 623 others, during the period between January 7-13, 2025. According to the Media Observatory of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation for Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians, the total number of Palestinians murdered from October 7, 2023, to January 12, 2025, reached 47,410 Palestinians, while the number of injured for the same period reached 116,360 wounded.

In the Gaza Strip, the Israeli occupation forces assassinated journalist Saed Nabhan at a camp in Nuseirat. The Israeli bombardment - in one week - extended to all areas of northern and central Gaza, where the occupation army bombed three schools; (Arbikan, Zainab Al-Wazir and Salah Al-Din) in Jabalia and west of Gaza City, and murdered an entire family in Al-Nuseirat camp, and targeted civilians several times in Jabalia, Al-Shuja'iyya neighborhood, Deir Al-Balah, and Al-Firdous area in Al-Mawasi.

The occupation forces also continued to blow up buildings around Kamal Adwan Hospital and in the Beit Lahia project and infrastructure and buildings in Deir Al-Balah at a time when most of the buildings in Jabalia, Beit Hanoun, and Beit Lahia were completely destroyed, and many tents of the displaced in the Gaza Strip were flooded due to heavy rains.

The hospitals in the Gaza Strip issued an urgent appeal to provide them with more fuel. At the same time, the occupation forces evacuated the Indonesian Hospital, and besieged and bombed Al-Awda Hospital.

On the other hand, the Palestinian Civil Defense announced the breakdown of many of its mechanisms, in addition to the cessation of its services in many areas of the Gaza Strip, while the Ministry of Health announced that the Israeli bombing of Palestinian civilians is concentrated at night, making it difficult to send rescue teams. The Israeli Navy continued to pursue Palestinian fishermen in the Deir al-Balah Sea during the past week and arrested a number of them.

In the West Bank and occupied al-Quds, the town of Tamoun was bombed by a drone, during which three Palestinians were murdered, including two children. The occupation army also demolished six houses in occupied al-Quds, Qalqilya, and Salfit, blew up another in Tulkarm, and occupied a house in Ramallah. The occupation forces and settlers also destroyed and burned dozens of barns for various uses and tents in Nablus, al-Quds, Ramallah, and Bethlehem. The occupation forces bulldozed agricultural lands and uprooted trees in Nablus and Bethlehem, while preventing farmers from plowing their lands in Jericho. They also confiscated a bulldozer in Salfit.

In the same context, the occupation authorities confiscated an area of 262 dunums of land from the towns of al-Ram and Kafr Aqab and the villages of Mikhmas and Jaba, in favor of expanding the settlement Road 45. The number of settlement activities during one week reached five activities during which the occupation authorities in al-Quds announced the start of implementing the "Silicon Valley" settlement project in the Wadi al-Joz neighborhood in Jerusalem, which threatens to demolish about 200 Palestinian facilities and confiscate 2,000 dunums of Palestinian land. The settlers plowed Palestinian agricultural lands in the

villages of Jenin and Tubas in preparation for cultivating and seizing them.

The settlers also began paving a new settlement road between Khirbet Tana, located east of the town of Beit Furik in the Nablus Governorate, and the central Awar area. Other settlers placed caravans on Palestinian lands near the “Baq’ot” settlement, east of the town of Tamoun, in an attempt to establish a new settlement outpost.

The number of attacks carried out by settlers on West Bank villages over the past seven days reached 56, where some of them robbed a truck in Nablus and seized both the truck and its load of livestock. Others attacked Palestinian homes on various occasions, smashing windows and burning cars in Tulkarm and Nablus, and other groups bulldozed Palestinian lands under the pretext of vandalism in the villages of Bethlehem.

The education sector was not spared from Israeli attacks, as settlers accompanied by occupation forces stormed the Bardala village school in Tubas, under the pretext that a settler was stoned, and attacked those in the school, which resulted in bruises for two students. On another day, occupation forces stormed the Kisan village school, assaulted teachers and students, and fired tear gas canisters at the school, bringing the number of Israeli crimes in one week to 2,401 crimes.

## The OIC Media Observatory for Crimes against Palestinians Monitors Israel’s Ambitions for Jericho’s Antiquities

**Silicon Valley**

The occupation authorities in Al-Quds announced the start of implementing the “Silicon Valley” settlement project in the Wadi al-Joz neighborhood in Al-Quds, which threatens to demolish about 200 Palestinian facilities and confiscate 2,000 dunums of Palestinian land.

517,407 Settlers inhabit 176 settlements and 186 outposts, constituting 42% of the occupied West Bank.

The extremist settlers, most of whom believe in religious Zionism, have illegally settled on the Palestinian land occupied in 1967 (the West Bank).

**OIC Media Observatory on Israeli Crimes against Palestinians**

The Organization of Islamic Cooperation’s Media Observatory for Israel’s Crimes against Palestinians has noted an increase in settler incursions into archaeological sites in a number of areas in the West Bank, especially in the last week of December 2024. During this period, settlers performed Talmudic rituals coinciding with what is known as the “Festival of Lights” in the archaeological areas in the Jericho and Jordan Valley Governorate, which ranks second among the Palestinian governorates that are subject to Israeli control and seizure of their lands after occupied al-Quds.

On December 26, 2024, settlers entered the Herod’s Palace area in Jericho and set fire to the archaeological site near the palace, under the pretext of performing “Talmudic” rituals. The following day 27<sup>th</sup> of December 2024, other settlers entered the Tel Ma’in archaeological site east of the town of Yatta in Hebron, and installed a “candelabra” and performed their “Talmudic” rituals, while others installed a “Hanukkah candle” or “candelabrum” on the Diokos (Al-Hawtah) archaeological fortress at the top of Mount Qarantul in



Jericho. On August 14, 2024, the Israeli occupation authorities intensified their raids on the Al-Masoudiya archaeological area near Nablus.

Most recently, on January 10, 2025, the Israeli occupation forces prevented Palestinian farmers from plowing their lands in the Umm al-Quba plain in the northern Jordan Valley, as part of the occupation's plans to control those areas and impose an economic siege on the Palestinians.

In a report by the Palestinian Ministry of Tourism and Antiquities, which was provided specifically to the OIC Media Observatory, Israel, the occupying power, has begun to employ antiquities in the Palestinian territories to claim ownership of the land in the West Bank and expand the construction of its settlements there, while its projects and plans to control antiquities in the West Bank can be added to its efforts to annex it.

According to the ministry's report, the Israeli effort to control Palestinian antiquities dates back to 1967, and Israeli excavations focused on the Abu al-Alaiq hills in Jericho, the "Herod's Winter Palaces" and Tel al-Furaidis east of Bethlehem, and the Qumran ruins, Khan al-Ahmar, and Mount Gerizim in Nablus.

A legislative proposal by Likud Knesset member Amit Halevi, called for amendments to the Israeli Antiquities Authority Law under the title "Amendment to the Israeli Antiquities Authority in Judea and Samaria 2023". The proposed amendment seek to apply Israeli antiquities laws to the West Bank so that they become the responsibility of the Israeli Antiquities Authority. On July 7, 2024, a ministerial committee in the Israeli government approved Halevi's proposals, and the decision was later transformed into a military order to seize Palestinian archaeological sites in the town of Sebastia. The decision was made under the pretext that "the alleged Jewish antiquities in the West Bank are being vandalized by the Palestinians".

The Palestinian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Expatriates had warned on July 15, 2023, about an Israeli plan to control Palestinian archaeological sites, and called on the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) to assume its responsibilities towards this. Palestinian archaeological sites are usually seized by Zionist settlement organizations, which consequently prevent Palestinians from entering those sites.

It is worth noting that Jericho, the southern Jordan Valley, eastern Tubas in the northern Jordan Valley, and the Dead Sea area are among the historical areas targeted by Israel.

Israeli control over archaeological areas has extended to religious demands, as the Israeli occupation seeks to include religious sites on Palestinian lands in the Jewish heritage, while they are included under the Israeli nature protection authority under the pretext of protecting nature, or placing military watchtowers, as was done in the case of the shrine of the Prophet Yaqeen in Bani Naim.

On the other hand, the settlement project in Jericho is different from other settlement projects in the rest of the Palestinian areas due to its economic, agricultural and touristic importance, and because it is relatively far from the separation wall and its strategic location on the border with Jordan, which makes it a strategic security target such that it is made an eastern buffer zone. Israel also views the historical dimension of Jericho as important, which explains its frantic pursuit of controlling the archaeological areas there.

Observers believe that Israel is targeting Jericho due to the low Palestinian population density in the city, which makes it an easy target for Israel, while 53,000 Palestinians live in 12 communities in various areas of Jericho. In contrast, there are 16 major Israeli settlements and five settlement outposts in the Palestinian governorate, inhabited by 8,500 settlers.

## **Retaliatory Settlement Operations and the Impact on the Palestinian Economy in the West Bank**

### **Israel Doubles its Crimes in the Final Week Before the Ceasefire and 47,896 Murdered Since October 7**

On the final day before the ceasefire agreement in the Gaza Strip alone, the Israeli occupation forces killed 60 Palestinians in Gaza, 2 Palestinians in the West Bank, and wounded 348 others. During the monitored period from January 14-20, 2025, the Media Observatory of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) for Israel's crimes against the Palestinians documented the murder of 466 Palestinians by the Israeli occupation and the wounding of 1,470 others. The bodies of 62 Palestinians were recovered as a result of the Israeli aggression on Gaza Strip. The total number of Palestinians murdered from October 7, 2023, to January 20, 2025, reached 47,896, with 117,791 others wounded.

During this period, the Israeli occupation aircraft raided the vicinity of Al-Farouq Mosque in Jabalia and Deir al-Balah, bombed civilian targets in the Tuffah neighborhood, besieged the Indonesian hospital, booby-trapped and blew up houses in Rafah, bombed the Nuseirat camp, assassinated journalists Ahmed Abu al-Rus and Ahlam al-Taluli, and wounded journalist Bashir Abu Shaar.

The Observatory also documented the severe flooding of displaced person's tents in the Gaza Strip due to heavy rains, with the Khan Yunis Municipality issuing warning about environmental and health disaster.

On January 15, 2025, the occupation forces demanded that the Palestinians in "Block D5 in Jabalia al-Balad" evacuate it, hours before the ceasefire agreement was concluded. The Jabalia al-Balad was inhabited by 200,000 Palestinians before the Israeli aggression on the Gaza Strip.

In the West Bank and occupied Al-Quds, the occupation forces arrested 169 Palestinians in one week, killed 15 others, demolished a house in Al-Quds, bombed and blew up two houses in Jenin camp, burned another, and destroyed another house in Qalqilya.

In terms of striking the Palestinian economic nerve, the occupation forces demolished a carpentry shop, a restaurant, and an aluminum shop in Al-Quds, demolished four shops in Jenin and Qalqilya, and demolished and burned four agricultural facilities in Qalqilya, Ramallah, and Bethlehem. They also bulldozed agricultural lands in Tubas, Nablus, and Salfit, and filled in two artesian wells in Jenin.

During the mentioned period, the occupation forces confiscated 7.5 dunums of Palestinian land in the Al-Haraiq area of the village of Husan, adjacent to the "Beitar Illit" settlement, and confiscated a cement mixer and pump in Salfit. Settlement activities reached three activities over the past week, during which settlers bulldozed lands in the Khirbet Humsa area in the northern Jordan Valley, and in the village of Naqoura in Nablus to expand and establish settlement outposts and a park. The Israeli occupation forces also began paving a 5 km settlement road in Palestinian agricultural lands in the village of Al-Jab'a, connecting to the villages of Wadi Fukin and Husan.

In terms of attacks on the education sector, the Israeli occupation forces fired tear gas canisters at Al-Khader Girls' Elementary School during their storming of the town of Al-Khader and surrounded the school, forcing its administration to evacuate its students. Settlers also stormed Al-Ka'abneh Elementary School and toured its courtyards in the Al-Mu'arjat area northwest of the city of Jericho.

During that period, the OIC Observatory also documented 72 settler attacks that reached their peak on the eve of and after the conclusion of the ceasefire agreement in the Gaza Strip. Most of them were characterized by acts of revenge, such as settlers burning vehicles, assaulting and vandalizing others on the Ramallah-Nablus road and in the town of Sinjil. They also set fire to a vehicle, a house, and farmers' lands in the villages of Nablus and Ramallah, and burned a bulldozer in Tulkarm. Settlers also assaulted many Palestinians in various villages in the West Bank, cut down 300 olive trees and seedlings, and broke the branches of 50 trees in Bethlehem, Salfit, Ramallah, and other trees in Nablus. They bulldozed agricultural lands under the pretext of vandalism in Ramallah and Jericho, released their livestock to graze on Palestinian lands in Ramallah, and burned agricultural lands in Qalqilya.

As for the looting that the settlers are usually known for, they stole three donkeys in the village of Al-Minya, 53 sheep from the Arab Al-Malihah community in Jericho, and a locomotive in the village of Jourat Al-Sham'a in Bethlehem. This brought the total number of Israeli crimes over the seven day period to 3063 crimes in various Palestinian areas.



## Israel Sets Up 898 Military Checkpoints in the West Bank to Paralyze Movement 104 Palestinians Murdered and 174 Wounded after the Ceasefire



The Media Observatory of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) for Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians recorded, between January 21-27, 2025, the recovery of 23 bodies of Palestinians murdered in the Gaza Strip. During this period, 104 Palestinians were murdered by bullets and shells of the occupation forces in Gaza, the West Bank and occupied Al-Quds. More than 174 Palestinians were wounded in various Palestinian areas. As of January 23, 2025, the total number of Palestinian murdered since October 7, 2023, had risen to 48,156, while the number of wounded reached 118,172.

In the Gaza Strip, it became clear that 95% of Palestinian homes in Beit Lahia had been destroyed and became uninhabitable, in light of the return of displaced Palestinians from the central and southern areas of the Gaza Strip to its destroyed northern area.

In this context, the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) reaffirmed its continued support for Palestinian refugees despite the significant challenges facing the agency, the latest of which was the closure of the Indian Corner Clinic in the Bab al-Sahira area in Al-Quds due to the Israeli ban imposed on UNRWA operations. It is worth noting that the clinic, which was established in 1948, was part of the healthcare network for Palestinian refugees.

In the West Bank, the city of Jenin and its refugee camp were subjected to continuous Israeli aggression. The occupation forces bulldozed a street and several commercial stalls in the vicinity of the roundabout in the center of the city. Israeli helicopters fired machine guns at Palestinians, and drones bombed an empty vehicle and gatherings of individuals in the camp. The Israeli occupation forces also surrounded the government hospital with earth mounds, and bulldozed the entrances to the towns of Yamoun and Silah al-Harithiya, in addition to bulldozing Jaffa Street, which connects the city of Jenin and its western villages.

The OIC Observatory recorded the arrest of 253 Palestinians by the Israeli occupation forces in the West Bank and occupied Al-Quds, while the occupation forces set up 898 checkpoints and obstacles to movement in all areas of the West Bank. This situation mimics the closures implemented during the period between 2002-2005, through which the occupation forces deliberately prevent direct access between Palestinian cities and villages and eight main roads passing through the West Bank in a plan aimed at paralyzing the movement within the West Bank. The occupation authorities also completely separated occupied Al-Quds from the West Bank.

On the other hand, the occupation army demolished 12 homes and 6 shops in Al-Quds, Nablus, and Jenin, burned a house in Jenin camp, and demolished an agricultural room and two water wells in Nablus. The occupation forces delivered a notice to close the shops in Al-Funduq village from Monday last week until January 30, 2025, in preparation for the demolition of a number of shops.

On another front, the occupation authorities issued a decision to confiscate 15 dunums of Palestinian land in the vicinity of the Al-Zaim checkpoint in Al-Quds. In Salfit Governorate, the Israeli occupation confiscated a truck, and a bulldozer, while a private car was confiscated in Tulkarm. The occupation forces also bulldozed a plot of agricultural land measuring about 30 dunams in the northern mountain of the village of Jit.

With regard to settlement activities, last week witnessed two settlement activities, where settlers bulldozed land and placed a number of mobile homes and arbors, in an attempt to establish a new settlement outpost. Others near the Ain road in the village of Qaryut established settlement pastoral and agricultural projects that include a pen for cows and sheep, in addition to planting olive seedlings on an area of about 20 dunams. They also brought an agricultural tractor and other agricultural equipment to the site.

The number of settler attacks on Palestinian towns and villages reached about 51 attacks, during this period. Settlers stormed the villages of Jinsafut and Al-Funduq in Nablus, attacked Palestinian homes, set fire to vehicles, a bulldozer, parts of homes, a nursery, and a carpentry shop on the main Qalqilya-Nablus road. They also burned a vehicle in Hebron, and severely beat several Palestinians. In the town of Nahalin, settlers cut the branches of about 50 fruitful olive trees, while others released dogs to attack Palestinians in the village of Kisan in Bethlehem. Others stormed the Khalayel al-Loz area and released a flock of sheep on agricultural land, destroying about 5,000 cauliflower seedlings. Settlers stole more than 103 heads of sheep in Jericho and Salfit, while other settlers released their sheep on Palestinian land to devour their crops.

Thus, the number of crimes committed by Israelis during the period between January 21-27, 2025, reached 1,630 crimes in various Palestinian areas.

## **In one week: Israeli Occupation Attacks Target 3 Mosques and 2,433 Settlers Storm Al-Aqsa**

### **226 Palestinians Murdered and Israel Destroys 57 Homes in the West Bank**

The Israeli occupation forces killed 25 Palestinians in the West Bank, and 12 others in the Gaza Strip, while rescue teams in the Strip recovered the bodies of 188 Palestinians murdered as a result of the Israeli aggression on Gaza, which lasted for more than a year. The Media Observatory of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) for Israeli Crimes against Palestinians documented a total of 226 Palestinians murdered and 170 wounded during the period from January 28 - February 3, 2025.

The number of Palestinians murdered from October 7, 2023, to February 3, 2025, reached 48,426, while the number of wounded Palestinians for the same period reached 118,299.

During the past seven days, the occupation forces bombed, murdered, and wounded Palestinians in the town of Qabatiya, the city and camp of Jenin, the Nour Shams camp in Tulkarm, the Fara'a camp, the town of Tamoun in Tubas, and the Arroub camp in Hebron.

The Israeli occupation forces destroyed infrastructure and facilities in several streets, in Tulkarm city and its camp, and in the town of Tamoun in Tubas.

The occupation forces continued their violations against the Palestinian health sector, especially in Tulkarm, where they stormed the Red Crescent Hospital and the emergency department at Thabet Thabet Hospital, and began a siege around Al-Israa Specialized Hospital while subjecting its employees to searches, and detained an ambulance in its vicinity and abused its crew. Their siege also reached the government hospital in Tulkarm. In occupied Al-Quds, the occupation forces stormed Al-Maqased Charitable Hospital.

In terms of Israeli attacks on mosques, the number of Israeli settlers who stormed the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque reached 2,433 in seven days, as part of the almost daily storming of Al-Aqsa.

The occupation forces demolished the Hamza Mosque in Jenin camp, and the Al-Taqwa prayer hall in the village of Sur Baher in Al-Quds, and settlers burned a mosque in Jericho.

The occupation forces also stormed the Riyadh Al-Aqsa schools in the Old City of Al-Quds, arrested a member of the teaching staff, and confiscated a group of schoolbooks.

The occupation forces arrested 246 Palestinians in the cities, camps, and villages of the West Bank, and demolished 57 homes in Jenin, Al-Quds, Tulkarm, Jericho, Hebron, Salfit, and Qalqilya. They also



demolished and destroyed two restaurants in Bethlehem and Tulkarm, demolished a commercial store, closed a library in Al-Quds, an industrial facility and commercial warehouses in Nablus, and blew up a gas cylinder store in Tulkarm camp.

The Israeli forces also bulldozed agricultural lands, uprooted olive trees in the Takwira area in Salfit, and burned and destroyed two vehicles in Al-Quds and Jenin.

With regard to settlement activities, which numbered six activities in one week, the occupation forces carried out bulldozing and road-building works west of the “Rotem” settlement in the northern Jordan Valley, with the aim of expanding it. The occupation forces also began paving a settlement dirt road in Jericho, in addition to another road east of the town of Yatta in Hebron, and settlers placed mobile homes on the lands of the town of Adh Dhahiriya under the protection of the occupation forces. Settlers expanded the settlement outpost that was established near the village of Bardala in the northern Jordan Valley, after placing new mobile homes and hangars. Settlers also plowed dozens of dunams of agricultural land near the “Sidi Boaz” settlement outpost west of the town of Al Khader in Bethlehem, in preparation for planting them. In the same context, settlers carried out 27 attacks during the period from January 28 to February 3, 2025, targeting Palestinian lands. These attacks varied between destroying an agricultural room, to grazing their sheep on Palestinian lands, stealing six sheep from Palestinians in Salfit, and pumping stagnant water from the “Abi Hanahel” settlement outpost into the agricultural lands of the Palestinian village of Kisan to prevent their reclamation and cultivation. Settlers also released their livestock on Palestinian agricultural lands to graze in the town of Sinjil in Ramallah.

In the Gaza Strip, the Israeli occupation army admitted to opening fire in several areas of the Gaza Strip despite the ceasefire agreement, claiming that Palestinians were approaching the locations of occupation soldiers. This happened while the occupation authorities continued to restrict the entry of the much-needed aid to the stricken sector, especially medical supplies.

The total number of Israeli crimes in the past one week reached about 1,737 crimes that varied throughout the Palestinian territories.

OIC Media Observatory on Israeli Crimes against Palestinians

The Media Observatory of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) for Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians recorded the killing of 695 Palestinian, during the period from February 4 to 10, 2025, 18 of whom were murdered in the Gaza Strip by the fire of the occupation forces, and 5 were murdered in the West Bank as a result of the continuous Israeli bombing on Palestinian camps. In addition to the recovery of 99 bodies from under the rubble in the Gaza Strip, and the documentation of the killing of 572 others during the Israeli aggression on the Strip before the ceasefire was announced. The OIC Observatory also documented a total of 49,119 Palestinians murdered and 118,371 wounded from October 7, 2023, to February 10, 2025.

The aforementioned monitoring period witnessed a clear international rejection of US President Donald Trump’s call to forcibly displace Palestinians from the Gaza Strip, amid Israeli reports about designating the Ramon Airport crossings in the Negev and the Ashdod Port as points of displacement for Palestinians from Gaza. These developments came amid a severe shortage of basic requirements for the residents of the destroyed Jabalia camp, and the people of Gaza in general, while the occupation army forced the residents of Gaza to return to its north on foot while continuing to ban Palestinians from approaching the Rafah crossing in the south.

The World Health Organization stated that 14,000 sick and injured Palestinians need medical evacuation from the Strip, including 5,000 children.

However, it became clear that Israel, the occupying power, despite the ceasefire, was keen to perpetuate its crimes by continuing to prevent the entry of all aid and the catastrophic consequences of its crimes on the people of the Gaza Strip. In addition to Gaza, Israel continues its crimes in the West Bank and occupied Al-



Quds, where the occupation forces forcibly displaced 3,000 Palestinians from the Far'a camp, in addition to the previous displacement that included 90% of the residents of the Jenin camp and displacement operations that included the Tulkarm camps, just as it did in Jabalia and Beit Lahia in the Gaza Strip. Israeli drones bombed Palestinian homes and individuals in the town of Tamoun three times over the past few days, and the occupation forces bulldozed streets and destroyed the infrastructure in the Far'a camp in Tubas, Balata in Nablus, and in the city of Nablus itself. The occupation forces damaged the water network in the Al-Ashreen area in Tubas, blew up the water tank gate in the northern neighborhood of Al-Far'a camp, and filled in two wells used to collect water in Hebron. They also cut off electricity to the town of Tamoun after shooting at the electrical transformer that supplies the town, in a clear indication that Israel is using the same criminal methods to strike the infrastructure and public services as a collective punishment against the Palestinian people.

With regard to the attacks on the health sector, the Israeli forces detained two ambulances belonging to the Red Crescent and subjected them to inspection, prevented a third one from passing in the town of Aqraba, crashed another in Al-Far'a camp, detained an ambulance in Tulkarm, and shot at the fifth one in the town of Tamoun and arrested its crew. The occupation forces continued their siege of the following hospitals: "Governmental Hospital", "Thabet Thabet Hospital", and "Al-Isra Hospital" in Tulkarm.

In terms of attacks on the education sector during the mentioned period, the occupation forces stormed the Faculty of Engineering at Al-Quds University, while settlers stormed the Arab Al-Kaabneh School and cut off its electricity. They also demolished the wall of the Tamoun Elementary Boys School.

During the period from February 4 to 10, 2025, the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque was subjected to almost daily raids, during which two Palestinians were forcibly removed from the Mosque. The occupation forces also raided and searched the Hudhayfah and Abu Bakr Al-Siddiq mosques in the town of Tamoun.

The Israeli forces destroyed and blew up nearly fifty homes of Palestinians in Al-Quds, Jenin, Hebron, Tulkarm, Salfit, and Nablus, and burned another in Jenin. The occupation authorities also demolished 14 agricultural barns in Tubas, Salfit, Hebron, and Jericho, and arrested 216 Palestinians.

The Israeli occupation forces also carried out four settlement activities by bulldozing and paving a settlement road with the aim of expanding the "Vir Yeriho" settlement in Jericho, expanding a settlement outpost near the village of Al-Jiftlik, and erecting arbors near the Tayasir checkpoint and in the northern Jordan Valley. These actions were accompanied by 27 attacks by Israeli settlers, during which they committed acts of theft, looting, vandalism, and destruction of fodder and water tanks in Jericho, in addition to stealing 20 sheep in Ramallah, cutting off olive tree branches in the village of Duma in Nablus, and attacking vehicles in Hebron and Ramallah.

In total, these crimes, including the crimes committed by the occupation forces, accounted for a total of 1,848 crimes in seven days across the West Bank, occupied Al-Quds, and the Gaza Strip.

## **19 Homes Demolished, 216 Palestinians Arrested and Gaza Suffers from Restricted Aid Entry**

### **In One Week: Israel Intensifies its Settlement Activity in the West Bank**

The Israeli occupation forces have intensified their expansionist plans in the West Bank through a clear increase in decisions to confiscate Palestinian lands, along with an increase in settlement activities in the West Bank.

Accordingly, the OIC Media Observatory on Israeli Crimes against Palestinians documented, during the period from 11-17 February 2025, five decisions to confiscate an area of 17,868 dunums of Palestinian land. This land includes areas in Al-Hadidiya, Al-Mufayya, Al-Buqay'a, Umm Ashish, and Al-Far'a village in Tubas, and the villages of Kafr Malik and Deir Jarir in Ramallah, and the town of Deir Ballut and the village of Al-Luban Al-Gharbi in Salfit, and to allocate them as pastoral areas for settlers.

The number of settlement activities during this period reached 10. These activities involved settlers and occupation forces bulldozing Palestinian agricultural lands to expand and pave roads in the village of Rojib, the Za'tara Junction checkpoint in Nablus, and the village of Yasuf in Salfit. Additionally, they paved a 3-kilometer-long settlement road and placed a barbed wire fence around several thousand meters of other land that was cultivated in an attempt to seize it in the villages of Tubas. The occupation forces began building a new settlement in Bethlehem and the village of Shuqba, while the Israeli extremist Itamar Ben Gvir and a group of settlers attacked Palestinian lands in the villages of Bethlehem, during which they

planted olive trees in preparation for seizing those lands. The settlers repeated the same activity in the town of Yatta in Hebron on two different occasions over the past seven days.

In the same context, the settlers launched 36 attacks on towns and villages in the West Bank, during which they set fire to agricultural lands and tents in the village of Burin, the town of Yatta, and in Jericho. They also stole 50 sheep in the town of Aqraba in Nablus and killed 25 others by poisoning the lands in Bani Naim in Hebron.

Over the past period, the settlers carried out various attacks, including beatings, vandalism, smashing and burning vehicle windows, and closing roads. These crimes come at a time when Israel, the occupying power, murdered 19 Palestinians in the West Bank and the Gaza Strip between February 11 and 17, 2025, where rescue teams recovered the bodies of 64 Palestinians from under the rubble, as a result of the Israeli aggression that partially stopped on January 18, 2025. The occupation forces also wounded 97 Palestinians in the West Bank and the Gaza Strip, and arrested 216 others in the cities and villages of the West Bank.

According to the OIC observatory on Israeli crimes, the total number of Palestinians murdered from October 7, 2023, to February 17, 2025, has reached 49,270, and the number of injured reached 118,490.

The Israeli occupation forces also demolished 16 homes in various villages and cities across the West Bank and Al-Quds. In addition, they bombed and burned three vehicles and a poultry farm in Jenin, bulldozed a street and parts of the infrastructure in the Nour Shams camp in Tulkarm, and bulldozed an area of land in the village of Safa in Ramallah. It also bulldozed an agricultural land of about 400 square meters after destroying the surrounding retaining wall in the village of Al-Funduq in Qalqilya. Other acts of destructions carried out by the Israeli occupation included the demolition of three caves, a water collection well, electricity and water networks, and two agricultural rooms. The occupation forces bulldozed trees and crops surrounding the houses, uprooted 10 trees around the rooms, destroyed agricultural crops, smashed solar panels, uprooted crops and fruit trees, and destroyed nurseries over an area of 1000 meters. It also destroyed 200 kilograms of dried yogurt in various areas around the town of Yatta.

In terms of attacks on mosques, the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque was subjected to daily raids, and the occupation forces closed the Ibrahim Mosque in the Old City of Hebron, after expelling the director of the mosque from inside it and prevented Palestinians from entering. In the context of their crimes, which amounted to 1371 crimes in one week, the Israeli occupation forces raided the health clinic of the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) in Al-Aroub camp, broke its doors and contents, and turned it into a field investigation center. They also stormed the Al-Tur neighborhood school in occupied Al-Quds, confiscated its books, and imposed the Israeli curriculum on it.

Regarding the humanitarian situation in the Gaza Strip, only 30% of the aid convoys stipulated in the ceasefire agreement have entered so far, while hospitals are facing a deficit due to a lack of oxygen, while medical sources in the Gaza Strip confirmed that 40% of kidney dialysis patients have died as a result of the shortage of medical supplies.

## **Israel Targets the Palestinian Economy:**

### **793 Checkpoints, 51% Unemployment and \$797 Million Deducted from the Budget by Israel**

The Palestinian economic has been experiencing a catastrophic collapse since the Israeli assault on the Gaza Strip on October 7, 2023, and its repercussions on the West Bank. According to the latest estimates of the Palestinian Center for Statistics, the Palestinian economy has contracted by a third compared to its pre-war status. The policy of the occupying power is fundamentally based on imposing a new reality through methods of genocide and scorched-earth tactics to eliminate Palestinian existence across all occupied territories and establish a Greater Israel on its ruins.

According to the OIC Media Observatory for Israel's Crimes Against the Palestinians, One of the key methods employed in this strategy is the economic suffocation of Palestinians, plunging their economy into successive crises to weaken and ultimately dismantle it. Among the most prominent tactics are the deliberate delays in transferring tax revenues to the Palestinian Authority, rendering it unable to pay public sector salaries. Additionally, Israel has revoked work permits for Palestinian laborers, replacing them with foreign workers, while tightening trade restrictions and imposing severe movement restrictions through checkpoints and the apartheid wall.



## General Economic Conditions

According to a World Bank report published in December last year, the crises experienced by vital sectors led to an economic contraction of 23% in the West Bank, during the first half of 2024, compared to the same period of the previous year. During this period, the trade and services sectors, considered the main catalysts for growth in the West Bank, declined by 22% and 23%, respectively. As for the construction and manufacturing sectors, they suffered the biggest declines, with a recession of 42% and 30%, respectively. On the other hand, and according to data from the Palestinian Ministry of Finance, Israeli deductions from compensation funds, under the name of allocations to the Gaza Strip, amounted to 2.83 billion shekels (US\$797 million), since the beginning of the war on the Gaza Strip on October 7, 2023, and until August 2024, with an average of 257 million shekels per month (US\$72 million). Indeed, Israel is deducting these funds as a punitive measure for the Palestinian National Authority's refusal to suspend the payment of allowances to the Gaza Strip, particularly the salaries of government employees, primarily health and education workers. In total, approximately 7 billion shekels (US\$1.97 billion) in compensation funds are being withheld by the occupying Power. These funds consist of tax revenues, duties and customs fees imposed on goods and merchandise imported into Palestine, or through Israel, crossings and borders, in accordance with the Oslo Agreement, and which are collected monthly by the staff of the Israeli Ministry of Finance on behalf of the Palestinian Authority, before being transferred to the Ministry of Finance and the Palestinian Treasury.

## Economic Reality for Palestinian Workers

With regard to the situation of the Palestinian labor force in Israel, the occupying power has begun to impose retaliatory measures since the outbreak of the aggression, significantly reducing the total number of Palestinian workers from 177,000 to just 27,000, according to the World Bank report. This has resulted in an unemployment rate of 80% in Gaza and 35% in the West Bank, bringing the total unemployment rate in Palestine to an unprecedented 51%, as per the Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics.

Palestinian Minister of Labor Dr. Enas Al-Attari stated that the dismissals of Palestinian workers from the Israeli labor market had a negative impact on the Palestinian economy, resulting in a monthly financial loss of approximately 1.5 billion shekels (\$423 million).

In another context, the Palestinian Policy Network published a report entitled: "Israel's Exploitation of Palestinian Labor: A Strategy to Erase Existence," identified four key strategies used by Israel to enforce Palestinian labor dependency. First, Palestinian workers are employed in low-wage jobs exclusively when needed to fill workforce gaps in Israel. Second, the focus on hiring Palestinians in agriculture, industrial, and construction ensures a severe labor shortage in these sectors within Palestine, hindering economic self-sufficiency. Third, continued expansion of illegal settlements in the West Bank fosters Israeli economic growth while simultaneously shrinking the Palestinian economy through land confiscation. Fourth, Israel arbitrarily revokes work permits when Palestinian labor is no longer needed or as a form of collective punishment, forcing workers back into the already weakened Palestinian job market and replacing them with foreign laborers.

## Israeli Checkpoints

Israeli collective sanctions have not been limited to the direct damage caused to the Palestinian economy. According to the report of the Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA), there are 793 checkpoints and obstacles that control the movement of Palestinians in the West Bank. These obstacles include 89 checkpoints with 24-hour security personnel; 149 checkpoints partially manned by security personnel (46 of which have barriers); 158 earth piles; 196 roadblocks (of which 122 are usually closed); 104 concrete blocks and 97 closures of one or more roads, such as roadblocks, earth walls and ditches. At least 40% (316 out of 793) of these barriers directly obstruct access between Palestinian towns and villages, averaging nearly one closure per kilometer. These obstacles divert Palestinian traffic to longer secondary road networks, disrupting the movement of hundreds of thousands of Palestinians and negatively affecting their daily lives.

It is worth mentioning that 85% of the separation wall passes inside the West Bank, which hinders access to occupied Al-Quds and the so-called "seam zone" between the wall and the 1949 armistice line. The impact on agriculture has been severe, with 150 Palestinian communities owning land isolated by the wall, which was previously accessible through 69 Israeli-controlled agricultural gates. However, since October 2023,

these gates have been largely closed, preventing farmers from tending to their land, leading to significant income losses, particularly from olive groves and seasonal crops.

Thus, it is evident that Israel, the occupying power, is trying to liquidate the Palestinian presence by all means, by practicing the scorched earth policy, this aligns with the findings of Francesca Albanese, the UN Special Rapporteur on the situation of human rights in the occupied Palestinian territories. In her October 2024 report to the UN General Assembly, she stated: “The State of Israel is predicated on the goal of Palestinian erasure; its entire political system is directed towards this goal.”

## **Israel Demolishes 74 Palestinian Buildings and Builds 1,047 New Settlement Units in the West Bank**

### **The Occupation Evacuates 3 Camps and Kills Nearly 50,000 Palestinians Since October 7**

The Israeli occupation forces expelled residents of three camps in Jenin and Tulkarm in the West Bank during their ongoing aggression on the northern areas and as part of a declared plan to fragment the West Bank in order to control it and annex parts of it. The occupation forces bulldozed streets and destroyed infrastructure during their storming of the town of Qabatiya in Jenin, and created an opening in the facade of the Bank of Jordan. They also bulldozed the main street from the entrance to the village of Shuhada to the town and uprooted dozens of olive and almond seedlings in the Al-Kabarat area located west of the town of Nahalin in Bethlehem.

The OIC Media Observatory on Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians documented, during the period from 18 to 24 February 2025, the murder of 69 Palestinians, seven of whom were murdered by the fire of the occupation forces in Jenin, Tulkarm, and Hebron, and 10 in the Gaza Strip in the context of Israeli violations of the ceasefire agreement. In addition, 52 others were recovered from under the rubble in the Gaza Strip. The number of injured Palestinians reached 73, and the number of detainees in the West Bank reached 198 Palestinians, and the



number of Palestinians murdered by the Israeli occupation from October 7, 2023 until February 24, 2025, reached 49,269, and the injured 118,464.

The storming of the courtyards of the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque by Israeli extremists has become a daily occurrence. The occupation forces also violated the sanctity of a mosque in the village of Burqa in Nablus, stopped the afternoon prayer and conducted a field investigation with the worshipers, raided and searched the Salah al-Din Mosque in the village of Abu Dis in Al-Quds, and settlers stormed the Abu al-Auf shrine in the town of Sinjil.

In terms of attacks on the education sector, the occupation forces prevented teachers and students of the Ibrahimiyya School in the Old City of Hebron from entering the school for several consecutive days. They also raided five schools affiliated with the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA), detained and forced teaching staff to evacuate students, and closed them in the implementation of the ban on the agency's activities. The Israeli troops raided the Qalandia Vocational Training Institute affiliated with UNRWA in the Qalandia camp, and issued an order to evacuate it within days. They also raided the Arab al-Malihah School in Jericho, and detained 4 Palestinians while they were installing surveillance cameras for the school.

Regarding the confiscation of Palestinian lands and properties, the occupation forces delivered a military order to confiscate half a dunum of land from the town of Sebastia and the village of Deir Sharaf, in order to pave a settlement road for a new pastoral settlement outpost in the area. Israeli authorities also confiscated an agricultural tractor in Qalqilya, a bulldozer in Nablus, a cement mixer and pump in Salfit, and two private vehicles in each of Nablus and Ramallah. In the same context, the settlers damaged a bulldozer and an agricultural tractor in the town of Kafr Qaddum in Qalqilya, and burned a vehicle in Hebron, as well as heavy equipment and light vehicles.

The OIC's Observatory recorded the occupation forces' demolition of 41 homes in Jerusalem, Salfit, Tulkarm, Hebron and Nablus, and the burning of five homes in Tulkarm, Jenin and Al-Quds. The occupation forces also warned of the demolition of 25 agricultural rooms in the village of Duma in Nablus, while the Israelis demolished and burned more than 7 barns and rooms in each of Hebron and Kufr Qaddum in Qalqilya and Al-Quds. In addition, they demolished a commercial store in Nablus and bulldozed lands and stone chains, which reflects the escalation of Israeli crimes over the course of only seven days, which amounted to 1315 crimes in all areas of the occupied Palestinian territory, and also included settlement activities and settler raids. During this period, the number of settlement activities reached eight, during which the Supreme Planning Council affiliated with the occupation authorities announced a detailed plan to expand the "Etz Ephraim" settlement, by seizing lands from the village of "Masha" with an area of 21 dunams in order to build 73 new settlement units. The occupation authorities also began procedures to build 974 additional settlement units on an area of 644 dunams to establish a new neighborhood that will expand the settlement of "Efrat" built on Bethlehem Palestinian lands.

Settlers also worked to rehabilitate a dirt road after preventing Palestinians from reaching the Ein al-Sakut area in the northern Jordan Valley, and others set up mobile homes in the northern Jordan Valley and Hebron with the aim of building settlement outposts. Settlers also prevented Palestinians from reaching their lands, in an attempt to seize them in an area belonging to the town of As-Samu in Hebron, and a number of them carried out construction work and bulldozed lands to expand the settlement outpost that was established near the Tayasir checkpoint. Settlers were also present in an abandoned military site in the village of Bardala in Tubas, in preparation for establishing a new settlement outpost in the place.

The number of settler raids on Palestinian towns and villages in one week reached 42 raids. During these raids, settler herds burned 4 water pumps feeding 2000 dunams, destroyed an agricultural greenhouse, and others stole more than 554 sheep and horses in Ramallah, Tubas, and Jericho, burned two cars in Hebron and Al-Quds, stole money and gold jewelry from the Kaabneh Bedouins in Ramallah, damaged two bulldozers, and cut off olive tree branches in Qalqilya. In addition, settlers also stole antiquities from the archaeological ruins around the town of Sinjil in Ramallah. A settler from the "Bnei Hefer" settlement in Hebron demolished a cowshed, and seized a generator, agricultural equipment, and digging tools. Other settlers chased a car carrying two Palestinians, causing it to overturn and injuring the occupants. A Palestinian was also murdered after his car collided with a speeding Israeli military jeep. Settlers were present on a road between Jericho and Ramallah and attacked a driver after his vehicle skidded on the road due to the rain.

## **The Occupation Forces' Attacks on Mosques in the West Bank Reach Their Peak A Week of Israeli Crimes: 10 Palestinians Murdered in Gaza and Aid Prevented from Entering**

Israel, the occupying power, continues its policy of collective punishment against the Palestinian people. After forcibly evacuating residents of three camps in the West Bank, it proceeded to prevent the entry of aid into the Gaza Strip in a flagrant violation of international law and the Geneva Conventions.

The latest Israeli decision came after the United Nations acknowledged the already existing difficulties in allowing the entry of aid and basic necessities into the Gaza Strip, especially with the beginning of the holy month of Ramadan. The UN had described the situation as catastrophic in light of the severe shortage of basic necessities.

The Media Observatory of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation on Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians documented the catastrophic conditions experienced by the people of Gaza, the most prominent of which was the death of six children due to the severe cold after sleeping in the open. The OIC Observatory recorded the murdering of 10 Palestinians in Gaza by the Israeli occupation forces during the period between February 25 and March 3, 2025, despite the ceasefire agreement that witnessed numerous Israeli violations. Rescue teams recovered 43 bodies from under the rubble during the mentioned period, bringing the total number of Palestinian killed, including the murdering of four of them in the West Bank, to 57 during the past seven days. In addition, 106 other Palestinians were injured during the same period.

The OIC Observatory documented the murder of 49,325 Palestinians from October 7, 2023, until March 3, 2025, while the number of Palestinians wounded during the same period reached 118,512.

According to the OIC Observatory, Israeli crimes and violations against mosques in the West Bank, especially Al-Aqsa Mosque, have reached a record level during the past week. The Observatory recorded daily incursions into Al-Aqsa Mosque by Israeli extremists, and the occupation forces prevented the call to prayer at the Ibrahimi Mosque "44" times. The occupation forces also continued their attacks on the mosque and its employees, expelling some of them, along with the ongoing threat to remove archaeological landmarks from the Mosque. They also prevented Muslim worshipers from performing the Isha and Tarawih prayers in the Mosque.

Israeli attacks on mosques in the West Bank from October 7, 2023, to March 3, 2025, totaled 47 times, including two crimes that occurred last week when the occupation forces raided and searched a mosque in the village of Zawata and Imam Ali Mosque in the city of Nablus.

In the West Bank, the occupation forces arrested 190 Palestinians, bulldozed a street and destroyed the infrastructure opposite the Al-Sanaa School in Tulkarm. They bulldozed agricultural lands and retaining walls, uprooted trees, demolished retaining walls, house pillars, and a water collection well west of the town of Kafr al-Dik in Salfit, bulldozed agricultural land and uprooted olive trees in the village of Beit Ikra in Al-Quds. They also forced a Palestinian family to evacuate their home in the Khirbet Abu al-Raish area in Salfit, and destroyed a number of vehicles in Jenin.

Between February 25 and March 3, 2025, the occupation forces destroyed 19 houses across various cities of the West Bank, set fire to four others, and demolished 28 multi-use barns and tents. They also demolished a livestock farm in Al-Quds, a supermarket, a rest house, part of a date factory, a restaurant, and a football field in Jericho.

Meanwhile, the occupation forces issued a military order to confiscate 8,438 dunums of land located adjacent to the "Karmiel" settlement east of the town of Yatta in Hebron, and issued another order to confiscate 5,217 dunums of land from the town of Tamoun in Tubas, for the benefit of settlement projects.

The occupation forces also confiscated a private vehicle during a raid on the town of Sa'ir in Hebron, and an amount of 3,500 shekels, personal belongings, a (cell) phone, and personal computers in Beit Ummar in Hebron as well. They also confiscated a bulldozer in Salfit, and two vehicles in the Jalazone camp in Al-Quds. The number of attacks carried out by settlers against Palestinians during the past week alone amounted to 31 attacks. This is represented by their demolition of an agricultural pen in the town of Kafr Qaddum in Qalqilya, and the theft of flocks of sheep in the villages of Duma and Aqraba in Nablus and the town of Al-Auja in Jericho, where they also slaughtered sheep, while settlers grazed their sheep on Palestinian agricultural lands in the Al-Farisiya area in Tubas, and the village of Deir Diwan in Ramallah. Settlers also stole tents and water tanks in the northern Jordan Valley in Tubas, and destroyed property and smashed the windows of six cars in each of the town of Khallet Al-Khader in Tubas, the village of Burqin in Salfit, and Yatta in Hebron.



The number of settlement activities witnessed in the West Bank reached three activities, during which settlers paved a settlement road in Jericho, and set up two tents in the areas of Tina and Hajjar in Bethlehem, and others placed two mobile homes near the Taybeh area where an occupation forces camp is located. This is in an attempt to establish a new settlement outpost on the lands of the town of Beit Kahil in Hebron.

The total number of Israeli crimes and violations within seven days reached 1401 crimes distributed between the Gaza Strip, the West Bank, and occupied Al-Quds.

## **Increase in Crimes against Al-Aqsa, Restricting Access to Al-Ibrahimi, Burning a Mosque, and 75 Palestinians Murdered**

### **23 Israeli violations Against 12 Mosques in the West Bank with the Advent of the Holy Month of Ramadan**



#### **THE OIC RESOLUTION TO ADDRESS THE ISRAELI AGGRESSION AGAINST THE PALESTINIAN PEOPLE AND THE SCHEMES FOR THEIR DISPLACEMENT FROM THEIR LAND AND ANNEXATION THEREOF**

Stresses the importance of supporting the Legal Monitoring Unit and the Media Unit at the OIC General Secretariat, in implementation of the resolutions emanating from the Extraordinary Joint Arab and Islamic Summit, and assigns the Secretary General to submit a report on their activities aimed at documenting and exposing Israeli crimes and violations, as well as contributing to the preparation of legal arguments on all violations of international law and international humanitarian law committed by Israel, the occupying power, against the Palestinian people in the Gaza Strip and the rest of the Occupied Palestinian Territory, including East Al-Quds.

The Israeli occupation forces have increased their attacks on mosques in the West Bank, in a clear violation of the sanctity of the holy month of Ramadan. In the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque, the occupation forces confiscated loudspeakers from the Qibli prayer hall. Throughout the past week, the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque has been subjected to incursions by Israeli extremists, with the total number of intruders reaching 9017 in February 2025. During the period documented by the OIC Media Observatory on Israeli Crimes against the Palestinians between March 4-10, 2025, the number of violations against the mosque reached 8, a significant increase compared to previous periods. The occupation forces prevented worshippers from performing I'tikaf in Al-Aqsa on the first Friday night of Ramadan. They also imposed strict restrictions on the entry of worshippers coming from the rest of the cities and villages of the West Bank to Jerusalem to perform the first Friday prayer of Ramadan in Al-Aqsa, and only allowed men over 55 years old, women over 50 years old, and children under 12 years old to pray in the mosque.

The occupation authorities refused to hand over the Ibrahimi Mosque in Hebron, including all its halls, spaces, and facilities to the Waqf Administration, as is customary on Fridays during Ramadan every year,

in preparation for opening it completely to worshippers on Fridays.

The occupation forces also raided the Abu Bakr Al-Siddiq Mosque, detained the imam of the mosque in the town of Burqin, raided and searched 6 other mosques, burned the Al-Nasr Mosque among them, and prevented the Fajr prayer in the Old City of Nablus. They raided the Al-Salam Mosque and destroyed its contents in the town of Beit Kahil in Hebron.

In terms of settler attacks on mosques, settlers stormed the courtyard of the Kisan village mosque in Bethlehem, and provoked worshippers by dancing and singing. Others hung a poster on the door of the Beit Furik town mosque in Nablus that read “No Future in Palestine”, while other settlers surrounded the village mosque during the evening and Tarawih prayers.

In terms of attacks on the education sector, the occupation forces raided and searched the Burqin Girls’ School, and stormed a school affiliated with the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) in the Shuafat camp.

As for attacks on medical staff and hospitals, the occupation forces raided the courtyards of the government hospital in Jenin, fired sound bombs at the patients, and searched Palestinian vehicles parked in the hospital courtyard. They stopped an ambulance at the Hamra checkpoint in Jericho carrying a doctor, a man, and his wife, and released the latter two, while detaining the doctor and the ambulance driver. They raided the Ahli Hospital, and confiscated its surveillance camera recordings during the storming of Hebron.

The OIC Observatory recorded the murder of 75 Palestinians during the period from March 4-10, 2025, 28 of whom were murdered by Israeli occupation forces in the Gaza Strip, and 4 were murdered in the West Bank, with 43 Palestinians murdered being pulled out from under the rubble of the destruction in Gaza. The total number of Palestinians murdered by Israeli occupation forces from October 7, 2023, until March 10, 2025, stands at 49,337, and the number of wounded has reached 118,535.

Israel, the occupying power, announced a complete power outage in the Gaza Strip, despite having already cut off its power supply since October 7, 2023. This action reflects Israel’s emphasis on the ongoing policy of collective punishment practiced by the occupation authorities by preventing the entry of humanitarian aid and basic needs into Gaza Strip during the holy month of Ramadan.

In the West Bank, the occupation forces arrested 225 Palestinians, and demolished 17 homes in Jerusalem, Hebron, Nablus, Jenin, and Tubas. They also demolished residential tents, shops, industrial facilities, and huts. They destroyed an electricity network on the outskirts of Hebron, in addition to burning a number of homes in Jenin camp.

The occupation forces issued an order to confiscate 300 dunums of land in the village of Al-Arqa in Jenin, adjacent to the racist separation wall.

On the other hand, settlers attacked Palestinian towns and villages 36 times in the last seven days. They uprooted 100 olive trees in the village of Haris in Salfit, stole agricultural equipment, water tanks, and wooden tools in Salfit and Bethlehem, and stole two flocks of sheep in an armed robbery in the town of Al-Auja. They also cut electricity poles, which led to a power outage in a number of homes near the town of Yatta in Hebron.

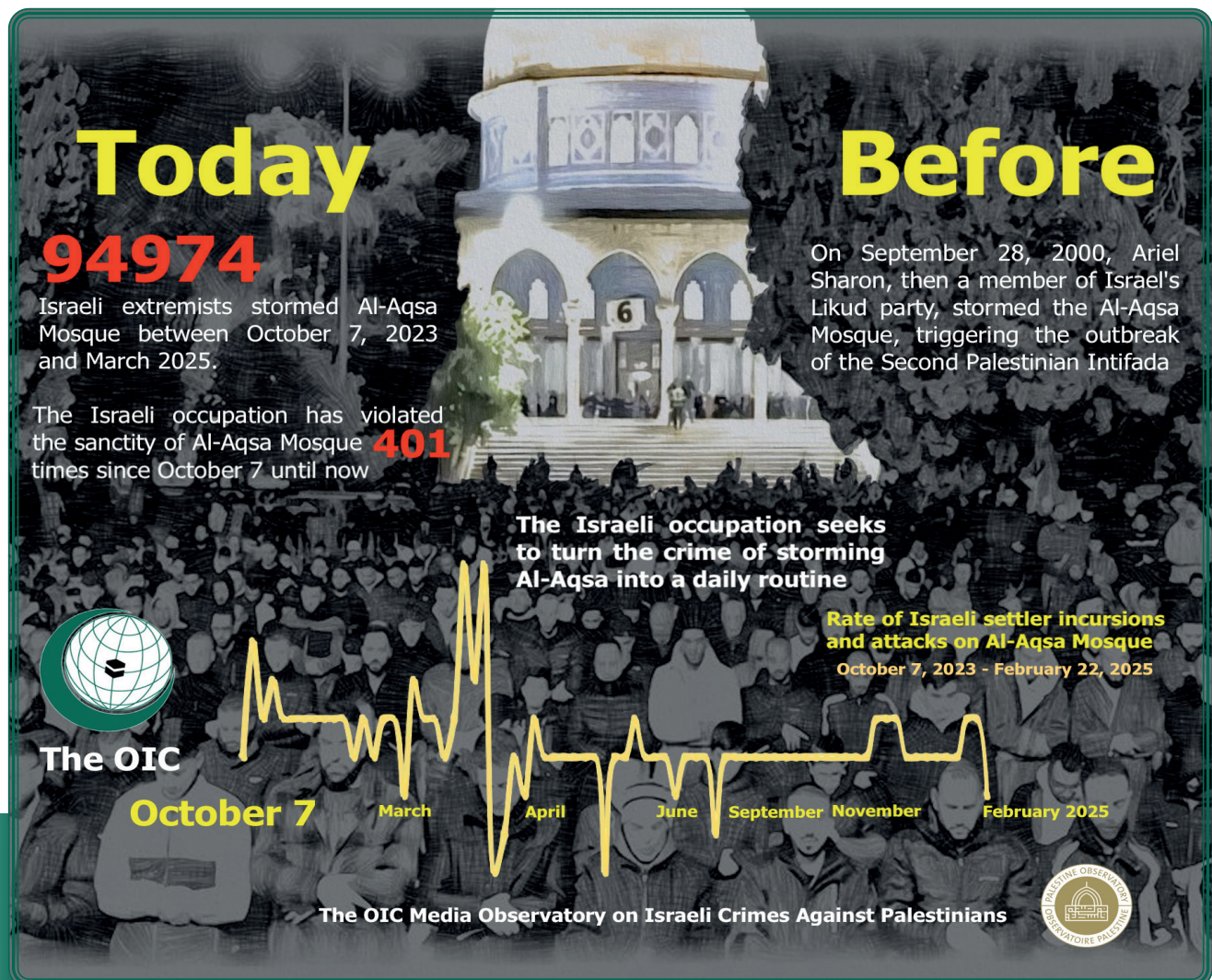
Settlers cut down a number of olive trees east of the village of Rojib, and others attacked cars and damaged them in the village of Al-Lubban Al-Sharqiya in Nablus and the village of Al-Funduq in Qalqilya. They attacked Palestinian vehicles with stones in the village of Al-Lubban Ash-Sharqiya in Nablus and Kafr Laqif in Qalqilya, smashing the windows of those vehicles. Finally, settlers set up two tents in the village of Jaba in Ramallah in an attempt to seize the land.

In total, the number of crimes committed by Israelis over the past 7 days has reached 1310 crimes in various parts of the Palestinian territories.



## The Israeli Occupation Violates the Sanctity of Ramadan with Massacres, Attacks on Mosques, and Bans on Prayers

### A Bloody Week Before Israel's Reversal of the Ceasefire Agreement in Gaza



The period between March 11 and 17, 2025, just one day before the Israeli occupation forces ended the ceasefire agreement, witnessed violations that paved the way for Israel's reversal of the agreement. The most notable of these violations was the targeting of a charity in Beit Lahia, where nine Palestinians were murdered. The OIC Media Observatory on Israeli Crimes against Palestinians monitored the last seven days before the ferocious return of Israeli aggression against the Gaza Strip. During that period, the OIC Observatory recorded 116 Palestinians murdered, including 79 bodies recovered from under the rubble, and 149 others injured. The number of Palestinians murdered from October 7, 2023, to March 17, 2025, has reached 49,517, and 118,741 were wounded. This is in addition to what the OIC Observatory recorded today, Tuesday, 18 March 2025, of over 330 Palestinians murdered, most of them women and children, and over 440 others injured in one of the most horrific Israeli genocidal attacks on the Gaza Strip.

For weeks, the Israeli occupation forces have completely prevented the entry of aid into the Gaza Strip and attempted to control the distribution of aid while pushing to enable an American company to carry out the mission before resuming its military aggression on Gaza. This resumption of genocidal attacks has returned the situation in Gaza to the catastrophic conditions that ended on January 19, 2025, the date the ceasefire agreement entered into force. The occupation forces, in their aggression against the Gaza Strip, disregarded the sanctity of the holy month of Ramadan and continued their systematic aggression against mosques in the West Bank as well. They stormed the courtyards of the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque and evacuated its worshippers on the second Friday night of Ramadan. They continued to impose strict restrictions on the entry of worshippers to Al-Aqsa from within the cities and villages of the West Bank or from occupied Al-Quds itself. For the second week in a row, they also refused to hand over the Ibrahimi Mosque in the Old City of Hebron to the Palestinian Waqf administration, as is customary on Fridays during Ramadan

every year. The occupation forces also blew up the main gate of Al-Nasr Mosque in the Nur Shams camp in Tulkarm and subsequently searched it.

During the monitored period, the number of people arrested by the occupation authorities in the West Bank reached 206 detainees in one week. The week also witnessed 40 attacks by settlers on West Bank villages. Settlers burned five cars in the village of Duma in Nablus and the village of Umm Safa in Ramallah. Others stole a water tank, raided tents, and damaged the electricity and internet networks in the northern Jordan Valley in Tubas. Another group of settlers stole 13 heads of sheep in the town of Yatta in Hebron, while another group grazed their sheep on Palestinian lands in the northern Jordan Valley. Settlers, protected by occupation forces, stormed the archaeological site of “Banat Ya’qub” on the outskirts of Tulkarm and toured its interior.

The number of settlement activities during the period from March 11 to 17, 2025, reached 7, the most prominent of which was the occupation forces’ legalization of the settlement outpost; “Edorim,” built on Palestinian land in Dura, which has now been transformed into a settlement. Meanwhile, settlers established a new settlement outpost on the summit of Mount Ras Zeid, which is affiliated with the town of Hawara. Settlers bulldozed areas of land south of the village of Qaryut in Nablus, in an attempt to seize them for settlement projects, as well as five more dunams of land north of the village of Iskaka in Salfit, next to the “Nove Nehemiah” settlement outpost. They bulldozed approximately 70 dunams of land, uprooted 80 almond olive trees, and demolished stone walls and a well for collecting rainwater in the town of Bidya in Salfit. Meanwhile, the occupation forces bulldozed Palestinian land to pave a new settlement road leading to the pastoral settlement outpost. They also uprooted 40 olive trees, and settlers set up their tents near the village of Raboud in Hebron.

Regarding demolitions of buildings and land confiscations, the occupation forces demolished and blew up seven homes in Tulkarm, Jericho, and Qalqilya, in addition to burning six apartments in Tulkarm. They also demolished fruit and vegetable stalls in the town of Anata in Al-Quds, demolished two car showrooms in Ramallah, blew up a café in the Nur Shams refugee camp, a warehouse in Tulkarm, and an agricultural facility in Ramallah. They also bulldozed land planted with olive trees in the village of Madama. Meanwhile, the occupation forces issued a military order confiscating approximately 1,200 square meters of land in the eastern part of Qalqilya. They also confiscated a water tanker in Tubas, three bulldozers in Tulkarm, Ramallah, and Salfit, a crane and equipment belonging to the Southern Electricity Company’s maintenance crew in the town of Yatta, and a Tractor, and recreational motorcycle, in the village of Halhul in Hebron.

Regarding attacks on medical personnel, the occupation forces detained a medical team of the Palestinian Red Crescent, and assaulted a paramedic while he was on duty in Tulkarm camp. They also severely beat an ambulance crew, which resulted in bruises among its members. The crew was subsequently transferred to the hospital for treatment in the village of Odala in Nablus.

In just seven days, the total number of diverse Israeli crimes and violations reached 1613, ranging from mass massacres to sheep theft, and affecting various Palestinian areas.
